PM interacts with women Self Help Groups in 'Atmanirbhar Narishakti se Samvad'

Lauds Self-Help Groups of women for their unprecedented services during the Corona period

New Delhi, Aug. 12 (PIB)

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi participated in 'Atmanirbhar Narishakti se Samvad' and interacted with women Self Help Group (SHG) members/ community resource persons promoted under the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM) today via video conferencing. During the event, a compendium of success stories of women SHG members from all across the country, along with a handbook on universalization of farm livelihoods was released by the Prime Minister.

The Prime Minister also



released capitalization support funds to the tune of Rs. 1625 Crore to over 4 lakh SHGs. In addition, he released Rs. 25 crore as seed money for 7500 SHG members under the PMFME (PM Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises) Scheme of Ministry of Food Processing Industries and Rs. 4.13 crore as funds to 75 FPOs (Farmer Producer Organizations) being

promoted under the Mission. Speaking on the occasion, the Prime Minister lauded the Self-Help Groups of women for their unprecedented services during the Corona period. The Prime Minister recognized their unparalleled contribution in making masks and sanitizers and providing food to the needy and spreading awareness.

The Prime Minister said that to

increase the scope of entrepreneurship among women and for greater participation in the resolve of Aatmanirbhar Bharat, a major financial support has been given today to more than 4 lakh SHGs on the eve of Raksha Bandhan. He said that the Self Help Group and Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana have brought a new revolution in rural India. He added this movement of women self-help groups has intensified in the last 6-7 years. He said that today there are 70 lakh self help groups across the country which is more than three times the figure during 6-7 years. The Prime Minister recalled the time before this government when crores of the sisters did not have a bank account, they were

Financial assistance under Self Employment Programme of NULM PBMC invites application from urban poor for establishing self employment ventures

Port Blair, Aug. 12

Applications have been invited from urban poor for providing financial assistance under the Self Employment Programme (SEP)- a component of the National Urban Livelihood Mission (NULM) for various activities for the year 2021-22 viz. Tea Shop, Ice Cream Vendor, Milk Vendors, Rickshaw Pulling, Fruit Vegetable

Vendors, Fish Vending, Laundry Work, Repairing of TV/Radio/ Refrigerator/Mobile Phone, Shoe repair, Book Binding, Carpentry Masonry, Manufacturing of Washing Powder, Agarbathi, Candle Making, General Merchant Shop, Building Material Shop, Readymade Garments & other Manufacturing, Servicing and Petty Businesses.

The unemployed urban poor who are residing within the Municipal area for the last three years are eligible to avail the scheme, which includes the individual enterprise project upto Rs.2,00,000/- and the maximum unit project cost for a group enterprise upto Rs.10,00,000/-. The prospective beneficiary should have attained the age of 18 years at the

time of applying for loan. Repayment schedule ranges from 5 to 7 years after initial moratorium of 6-18 months as decided by bank.

The application form can be obtained from Office of the City Mission Management Unit at CRC Building, Dairy Farm Jn. upto 20/09/2021 on any working day between 9 am & 5 pm. The application

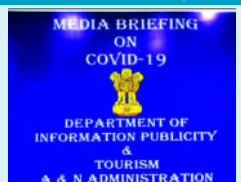

Media briefed on COVID-19

No corona positive case detected during test conducted on inter-island bound passengers: Director (IP&T)

Port Blair, Aug. 12

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar briefing the media persons on COVID-19 status in the Islands held in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening stated during the RT-PCR test conducted on 321 flight passengers, who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. RAT test was conducted on 265 passengers bound for North & Middle



Andaman at Ferrargunj and no positive case was found. Today, 2 flights with 450 passengers arrived here and the results of RT-PCR reports are awaited. RAT was conducted on 46 passengers proceeding to Swaraj Dweep by MV

Chouldari and all the test reports were negative. Similarly, RAT was conducted on 94 passengers coming from Swaraj Dweep to Port Blair and here too, all were found negative. 60 passengers were tested at Helipad and no positive cases were found. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, 138 passengers were tested and all were found negative.

3,13,490 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries in Isles so far

Port Blair, Aug. 12

The safety of the citizens is the foremost priority of the Administration, especially during this pandemic time. To shield its citizens from the corona virus, the vaccination of eligible beneficiaries is being initiated by the Administration in different parts of the Islands. Accordingly, the vaccination began with administering of COVISHIELD vaccine for Health Care Workers followed by frontline workers and vulnerable

population with co morbidities. Subsequently, the vaccination for 45 and above was initiated followed by 18 to 44 years which is currently underway.

As per data available, a total of 3, 13, 490 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries in A&N Islands so far, out of the target beneficiaries of 2, 81, 603 (approx.). A total of 5330 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. 3776 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South

Andaman District, out of which 3410 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 1542 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 1402 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. Twelve beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which 1 beneficiary was in the age group of 18-44 years. A total of 1,06,711 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.

and UT Administration training institutes including universities and institutes of higher learning can also implement the scheme. Organizations which would be eligible for applying for financial assistance under this scheme are Societies registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860; a public Trust registered under any law for the time being in force, a private limited non-profit company registered under Section 25 of the Indian Companies Act, 1956; Universities/ Institutions of higher learning recognized by University Grants Commission (UGC), Training institutes of Central and State Government/UT Administration including Panchayati Raj Training institutes and Duly registered Cooperative Societies of Women/ Self Help Groups.

The selected organization would have the responsibility to motivate, identify and select women to be trained in accordance with the criteria of the scheme from villages/urban localities having a substantial minority population. The organizations will involve Head of the Gram Panchayat/Municipal Body/ Local Authority for identification/ selection of women trainees.

The details of the trainees will be submitted by the organization before the start of training through the Online Application Management System (OAMS) for Nai Roshni, once the project is approved. Although there will be no annual income bar, a woman/parent or guardian of woman having annual income not exceeding Rs.2.50 lakh from all sources would be given preference in selection. They should be between the age group of 18 years to 65 years.

The proposal should be submitted in the prescribed format through Online Application Management System (OAMS). The link of OAMS is available on official website of Ministry of Minority Affairs i.e. www.minorityaffairs.gov.in. After filling up the complete proposal in the OAMS, a print of the same may be taken and submitted to the District Collector/ District Magistrate for their recommendation in the prescribed format. The detailed guidelines of the scheme are available on the website www.minorityaffairs.gov.in, a press release from Director (Social Welfare) said.

Coast Guard organizes Special Community Interaction progs. in Isles

Fishermen sensitized on effective usage of SAR Toll Free number 1554

Port Blair, Aug. 12

The Indian Coast Guard conducted Special Community Interaction programs to commemorate the 75th Independence Day celebrations 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav'. As part of the event, Coast Guard Units at Port Blair and other remote locations in the Isles including Mayabunder and Campbell Bay reached out to local populace along with representatives from Fisheries Department on Aug 10 & 11. The fishermen were made aware about search and

rescues set up in India, especially at A&N Islands and were explained about various precautionary measures to be followed while venturing out for fishing. The fishermen were also educated on effective usage of SAR toll free number 1554. Theoretical briefing was followed by practical demonstration on carriage and usage of safety equipment onboard the boat.

As a part of information campaign, fisherman community were also given live demonstration on

procedure for usage of life saving appliances such as Distress Alert Transponders, life jackets etc. In addition, a medical lecture was also imparted to augment basic knowledge on first aid. To promote the concept of fishermen being developed as eyes and ears for security agencies, the fisherfolk were appraised to report all suspicious activity or vessel. The fishermen were subsequently gifted life jackets by ICG Team, a press release from Coast Guard said.

miles away from the banking system. That is why the Government started the massive campaign to open Jan Dhan accounts, he said. He added that today there are more than 42 crore Jan Dhan accounts of which close to 55% of the accounts are of women. He said the bank accounts were opened to make it easy to take loans from banks.

The Prime Minister said that the amount of help the Government has provided for the sisters under the National Livelihood Mission is many times more than the previous Government. An unsecured loan of about Rs.4 lakh crore has also been made available to self-help groups. He said in the last 7 years self-help groups have also done a great job of repaying banks. There was a time when bank loans close to 9% became NPA. Now it has come down to 2-3 %. He lauded the honesty of the women in the Self Help Group.

The Prime Minister also announced that now the limit for loans available to self help groups without guarantee has been doubled to Rs 20 lakh. He said that the condition of linking your savings accounts with the loan account has also been done away with. He added that with many such efforts, you will now be able to move forward with more enthusiasm in the campaign of self-reliance.

The Prime Minister said this is the time of 75 years of independence. It is time to set new goals and move forward with new energy. The collective power of sisters also now has to move forward with new strength. The Government is constantly creating that environment and conditions from where all of you sisters can connect our villages with prosperity.
