

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 21863 beneficiaries in the age group of 15-18 years vaccinated so far

Port Blair, Jan. 24

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,03,236 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far in A&N Islands. Similarly, 21,863 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 years against the target beneficiaries of 23,000. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 4623.

A total of 3194 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 3091 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 2759 beneficiaries were in the age group of 15-18 years, 37 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 124.

Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana NFSA beneficiaries urged to draw entitled food grains for 2 months in one go

Port Blair, Jan. 24

The Govt. of India has announced the extension of PMGKAY foodgrains for its beneficiaries till March 2022. In pursuant to the direction of Government of India to maintain social/physical distancing and minimal movement of PDS beneficiaries, foodgrains shall be distributed in advance for 2 months for January 2022 to February 2022 in one go in the entire UT in the month of January 2022. All the ration card holders have been informed that they can purchase the foodgrains as per their entitlement for 2 months in January, 2022.

Further, all Priority House Hold (PHH) and Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) ration card holders covered under National Food Security Act residing South Andaman District, North & Middle Andaman District and Campbell Bay will be entitled for 5 kg food grains in the scale of 3.5 kg rice and 1.5 kg wheat per person per month free of cost. Since, the Tribal population is habitual rice eater and as per their request, PHH & AAY beneficiary of Car Nicobar and Nancowrie group of Islands will be entitled for 5 kg rice only per person per month free of cost under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PMGKAY). This is in addition to their regular entitlement under NFSA. All such ration card holders have been informed to draw the foodgrains as per their entitlement for 2 months in one go between 1st January, 2022 to 28th February, 2022 in addition to their regular PDS foodgrains. However, the Ration Card holders who are not able to lift ration in the month of January 2022 can also lift their foodgrains in the month of February 2022.

Further, the migrants of other States presently residing in this UT and are covered under NFSA (PHH & AAY) in their respective States/UTs can also receive food grains from any FPS of this UT under the One Nation One Ration Card Scheme. For any clarification, they can contact Toll Free No. 14445/18003453197.

The Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs has appealed to all beneficiaries to abide by COVID Appropriate Behaviour without fail, a press release from Directorate of CS& CA said.

Andaman & Nicobar Islands Marine Fishing Rules Fisheries Deptt. urges traders/fish vendors to register their firms for transportation of fish or fishery products

Port Blair, Jan. 24

In accordance with Rule 16(a) and (b) of Andaman and Nicobar Islands Marine Fishing Rules, 2004 and subsequent amendments dated the 7th November 2019 'Any person, Traders/Fish Vendors, Firms, Cooperative Societies, Self Help Groups, NGOs or any organizations engaged in transport of Fish or Fishery products/live fish seed/chilled/frozen fish from A & N Islands to mainland and mainland to A & N Islands' shall apply in the prescribed format along with Registration fee of Rs.500/- to the Authorized Officers of respective Districts Zonal Fisheries Offices for registration of the firm.

The authorized officer shall issue Registration Certificate which shall be valid for three years from the date of issue and shall be renewed thereafter for further periods of three years on payment of Rs.500/- on each occasion.

Traders who were registered prior to amendment of the Rules, 2017 and the new traders who are interested in transportation of Fish or Fishery products / live fish seed/ chilled/frozen fish have been requested to contact the Authorized Officers of the respective Zonal Fisheries Offices for registration of their units/ firms and for further details.

No transportation of Fish or Fishery products are allowed without Registration Certificate issued by the respective Authorized Officer, a press release from Directorate of Fisheries said.

Due to technical reasons, the services of Vehicle ferry vessel MV Pilobhabhi plying between Chatham - Bambooflat has been withdrawn w.e.f. Jan. 25. young age and had dedicated themselves for it" the Prime Minister noted.

COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 101 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 8 flights with 528 passengers arrived, out of which, 387 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 129 passengers (5 foreign travellers) and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 18 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 30 passengers, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 36 passengers were tested with RAT and one positive case has been detected. At Helipad, test was conducted on 11 passengers, no positive case has been detected. Today, till 3 pm, 73 eligible persons were vaccinated, out of which, 14 beneficiaries were 18 years and above, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.
