#### FIRE SAFETY PRECAUT AGAINST ELECTRICITY

About 60% fire are of electric origin such as lectric short circuit, overheating, overloading, use of nonstandard appliances, illegal tapping of electrical wires, improper electrical wiring, carelessness and ignorance etc. It can lead to erious fire and fatal accidents, if proper nstructions are not followed. Such incidents can be minimized to a great extent if adequate fire recautions are observed. Electrical fires spread rapidly especially in building and cause loss of ves and property. It is therefore, necessary to act ast. Raise and alarm for help. Switch off power supply to de-energize the equipment. Use dry sand, CO2 or Dry chemical powder extinguishers.

Use ISI Certified appliance.

Use good quality fuses of correct rating, niniature circuit breakers and earth leakage ircuit breakers.

Use one socket for one appliance.

Switch off the electrical supply of the fire ffected areas.

Fuses and switches should be mounted on etallic cubicles for greater fire safety. Replace broken plugs and switches.

Keep the electrical wiring away from hot and et surfaces.

Switch off appliance after use and remove the lug from the socket.

Switch off the main switch when leaving home or a long duration.

Don't use sub standard fixtures, appliance.

Never have temporary or naked joint or wiring. Don't lay wires under carpets, mats or doorways


