Providing adequate & timely credit support to farmers

Rs. 29.48 crores disbursed by Banks under Kisan Credit Card scheme in A&N Islands

Port Blair, April 17

Under the 'Kisan Credit Card' scheme (KCC), different banks functioning in South Andaman has sanctioned loan to 8370 applicants upto 31st March, 2022. The maximum number of beneficiaries was covered by the State Bank of India, A&N State Co-operative Bank and Canara Bank (e-Syndicate) during the financial year 2021-22.

The highest number of applications were received in the Agriculture Sector of which loan was sanctioned to 7299 applicants amounting to

Rs. 23.95 crore. Similarly, in the Animal Husbandry Sector, loan was sanctioned to 461 applicants amounting to Rs. 2.58 crores while in Fisheries Sector, loan amount of Rs. 2.95 crores was sanctioned to 610 applicants.

The total amount disbursed as loan in KCC scheme stood at Rs. 29.48 crores in A&N Islands. Despite the COVID-19 pandemic, the Banks ensured timely disbursement of the loan amount to the applicants, Lead Bank sources informed.

The 'Kisan Credit Card' scheme aims at providing adequate and

timely credit support from the banking system under a single window with flexible and simplified procedure to the farmers for their allied farm activities which includes to meet the short term credit requirements for cultivation of crops; post-harvest expenses; produce marketing loan; consumption requirements of farmer household; working capital for maintenance of farm assets and activities allied to agriculture; investment credit requirement for agriculture and allied activities.

India objects to WHO's methodology to calculate COVID-19 death toll

New Delhi, April 17

India has objected to the World Health Organization (WHO) methodology for calculating COVID-19 death toll. In response to an article titled 'India Is Stalling the WHO's Efforts to Make Global COVID Death Toll Public' published by a US Daily, Union Health Ministry said, New Delhi has been in regular and in-depth technical exchange with the WHO on the issue of collecting and making public the COVID-19 death toll in the country. It said the analysis while uses mortality figures directly obtained from Tier -I set of countries, uses a mathematical modelling process for Tier II countries which includes India.

The Ministry added that India's basic objection has not been with the result but rather the methodology adopted for the same. It also said India has shared its concerns with the methodology along with the other Member States through a

series of formal communications including six letters issued to WHO.

During these exchanges, specific queries have been raised by India along with the other Member States regarding the methodology, and use of unofficial sets of data. The Ministry elaborated that the concern specifically includes on how the statistical model projects estimates for a country of geographical size and population of India and also fits in with other countries which have smaller population.

Such one size fit all approach and models which are true for smaller countries like Tunisia may not be applicable to India with a population of 1.3 billion. WHO is yet to share the confidence interval for the present statistical model across various countries. It also said the model gives two highly different sets of excess mortality estimates of when using the data from Tier I countries and when

using unverified data from 18 Indian States. Such wide variation in estimates raises concerns about validity and accuracy of such a modelling exercise. India has asserted that if the model is accurate and reliable, it should be authenticated by running it for all Tier I countries and if the result of such exercise may be shared with all Member States. The Health Ministry said, while India has remained open to collaborate with WHO as data sets like these will be helpful from the policy-making point of view, the country believes that in-depth clarity on methodology and clear proof of its validity are crucial for policymakers to feel confident about any use of such data.

It added that it is very surprising that while the newspaper purportedly could obtain the alleged figures of excess COVID-19 mortality in respect to India, it was unable to learn the estimates for other countries. (Source: india.gov.in)

FIRE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS AGAINST ELECTRICITY

About 60% fire are of electric origin such as electric short circuit, overheating, overloading, use of nonstandard appliances, illegal tapping of electrical wires, improper electrical wiring, carelessness and ignorance etc. It can lead to serious fire and fatal accidents, if proper instructions are not followed. Such incidents can be minimized to a great extent if adequate fire precautions are observed. Electrical fires spread rapidly especially in building and cause loss of lives and property. It is therefore, necessary to act fast. Raise and alarm for help. Switch off power supply to de-energize the equipment. Use dry sand, CO₂ or Dry chemical powder extinguishers.

Do's

- ▶ Use ISI Certified appliance.
- ▶ Use good quality fuses of correct rating, miniature circuit breakers and earth leakage circuit breakers.
- ▶ Use one socket for one appliance.
- ▶ Switch off the electrical supply of the fire affected areas.
- ▶ Fuses and switches should be mounted on metallic cubicles for greater fire safety.
- ▶ Replace broken plugs and switches.
- ▶ Keep the electrical wiring away from hot and wet surfaces.
- ▶ Switch off appliance after use and remove the plug from the socket.
- ▶ Switch off the main switch when leaving home for a long duration.

Don'ts

- ▶ Don't use sub standard fixtures, appliance.
- ▶ Never have temporary or naked joint or wiring.
- ▶ Don't lay wires under carpets, mats or doorways, they get crushed, resulting in short circuiting.
- ▶ Do not allow appliances cords to dangle.
- ▶ Don't place bare wire ends in a socket..

Over 186 crore 51 lakh doses of COVID vaccine have been administered in the country under the nationwide vaccination drive so far.

The Union Health and Family Welfare Ministry today said, more than 12 lakh 56 thousand COVID vaccine doses were administered to the eligible beneficiaries yesterday.

The country

reported over 11 hundred new COVID cases in the last 24 hours. Currently, India's active caseload stands at 11 thousand 558. In the last 24 hours, 954 COVID patients have recovered and the national recovery rate stands at 98.76 per cent.
