

## Landmark achievement by Administration - successfully completes Rutland Water Supply Project

### Water from Rutland reaches reservoir at Pongi Balu during trial run

### Chief Secretary directs APWD to further augment supply from Rutland to meet water demand of Port Blair for next 20 years

### Project fulfills long pending demand of public ensuring about 6.6 MLD of water per day even during summer

Port Blair, Dec. 9

The A&N Administration working with the commitment to fulfill the aspirations of the Islanders, has yet again achieved another landmark by making the long pending demand of the Islanders come true with the completion of Rutland water supply scheme. The project has successfully been completed with the water from Rutland reaching the reservoir at Pongi Balu.

The crucial Phase-II of the project, which involved laying of under-sea pipeline from Rutland to Pongi Balu has been successfully completed despite challenging circumstances with the active support and monitoring of Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain. The Chief

Secretary directed that another 4 to 5 kms of piping should be done to catch nearly 75% of the existing water from other water catchments and at low cost, increase the water supply to 75 %. Initial survey was done by three engineers and map and drawing should be completed by Dec. 31, 2021. The Chief Secretary also directed APWD to further augment supply from

Rutland so as to plan for the water demand of Port Blair for the next 20 years by tapping the other sources of water, which can be done at a low cost.

Despite lockdown and working in logistically very challenging conditions, all machineries and manpower were mobilised immediately. Work started in May 2021 with active support from all Departments. After successful completion of all testing, both ends of the pipeline were integrated with existing infrastructure at Rutland and Pongi Balu to start the flow of water from Rutland to Pongi Balu under gravity. Trial run of submarine pipe line started

## Intensive survey carried out in all Industrial Estate managed by Industries Department

### Based on findings of survey, allotment made to enterprises found non-functioning / misusing of plots / sheds cancelled

### Measures taken to ensure deserving entrepreneurs are benefitted

Port Blair, Dec. 9

Pursuant to the direction of Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A & N Islands and Chief Secretary, A & N Administration, an intensive survey was carried out by Senior Officers of A & N Administration and Officers of Industries Department in all Industrial Estate located at Garacharma, Dollygunj, Mithakhari, Little Andaman, Campbell Bay and Bakultala to ensure optimum utilisation of Industrial Plots / Sheds allotted to entrepreneurs and to identify the enterprises / industrial units not functioning, misusing and violating the terms of allotment.

The very purpose of setting up the Industrial Estate is to provide the assistance of availability of land to entrepreneurs, who wish to invest their talent in the manufacturing and service activities. Thus, this intensive survey will help the Industry Department to

organise the resources and policy guidelines to have optimum utilisation of these Industrial Estates.

Based on the findings of the survey, the Industries Department has cancelled allotment made to such enterprises which were found non-functioning, misusing the plots as residential, garden or hotel purpose or diverting the land use category for non-industrial purposes. Possession of some plots/sheds have already been taken by the Department while eviction proceedings have been initiated against other violators.

Further, notices are being issued to such units those were found violating the terms of allotment and action will be taken and penalized. Those cases which are pending in court, by those who have violated the law, are being defended, so that enough

Media briefed on COVID-19  
Three positive cases detected from inter-island: Director (IP&T)

Port Blair, Dec. 9

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar while giving information on COVID-19 status stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 339 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 12 flights with 2067 passengers arrived, out of which, 1651 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on

416 passengers (includes 9 international travellers) and the reports are awaited. During RAT conducted on 85 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 53 passengers and no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 59 passengers were tested with RAT and all were found negative. Apart from this, RT-PCR test was conducted on 43 crew members of MV Kalighat and the reports are awaited. Three positive cases were detected from inter-island yesterday. Today, till 3 pm, 240 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 218 were of 18 plus age group.

Forest Department under the office of Divisional Forest Officer, Middle Andaman by submitting a false affidavit wherein he had suppressed his actual date of birth. Nepal Singh had reduced his age by ten years in the said false affidavit sworn by him before the Executive Magistrate, Rangat and on the strength of such false affidavit he obtained employment as Regular Mazdoor in the Forest Department. The prosecution had exhibited the false affidavit submitted by the convict, Nepal Singh at the time of his initial appointment in the Forest Department and many other service related documents of the convict were produced before the court during trial. The court at the time of pronouncement of its judgment had observed that there were sufficient materials on record in the form of exhibited documents to establish the fact that the accused, Nepal Singh had manufactured a concocted document in the form of an affidavit with an intention to commit fraud upon the Government Department for gaining employment unlawfully by way of suppressing his actual date of birth. Nepal Singh was sentenced to undergo one year imprisonment and a fine amounting to Rs. 10000/- in total was imposed against him by the court. The prosecution case was conducted by Ld. APP, Shri Pradeep Ram, a press release from APP said.
