

UK PM Rishi Sunak fined by police for failing to wear seat belt

British police fined Prime Minister Rishi Sunak on Friday for failing to wear a seat belt while he filmed a social media clip in the back seat of a moving car, a potentially embarrassing blow as he tries to revive his party's fortunes.Sunak, apologised on Thursday for a "brief error of judgement", had uploaded the video to Instagram during a trip to northwest England. It was widely shared by other users who noticed that he had not buckled up.Local police had late on Friday that an offence had taken place.

It is the second penalty Sunak has received from police after last year they found he broke Covid-19 lockdown rules, along with then-prime minister Boris Johnson.

Sunak becomes the second prime minister after Johnson to have broken the law in such a manner.

Keeping in mind the historic significance of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands and to honour the memory of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose, Ross Islands was renamed as Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Dweep by the Prime Minister during his visit to the Island in 2018. Neil Island and Havelock Island were also renamed as Shaheed Dweep and Swaraj Dweep.

Giving due respect to the real-life heroes of the country has always been accorded highest priority by the Prime Minister. Going ahead with this spirit, it has now been decided to name the 21 unnamed Islands of the island group after 21 Param Vir Chakra awardees.

The largest unnamed island will be named after the first Param Vir Chakra awardee, the second largest unnamed island will be ary 24.

that presently the A&N Administration under the Social Security Schemes is paying Rs.2500 per month as Pension/Allowances to the Oldage, Widow, Destitute Women and Divyang persons in order to help them financially independent and survive. He mentioned that the Pension/Allowance has been last revised by the Administration during 2018.

He pointed out that

due to abnormally high cost of essential commodities in the Islands as compared to the mainland, the above mentioned categories of the persons are facing immense difficulties in sustaining their life.

The Member of Parliament mentioned that many Old-age, widow and Divyang persons live alone in these Islands and it has become impossible to survive with only a Rs. 2500 pension in present day.
