Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package Insurance Scheme for Health Workers fighting COVID-19 extended for a further period of 180 days

New Delhi, April 19 (PIB) The 'Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package (PMGKP), insurance scheme for Health Care Workers Fighting COVID-19' has been extended for a further period of 180 days from 19th April, 2022. It has been decided to extend the policy so as to continue to provide the safety net to the dependents of health workers who are deputed to take care of COVID-19 patients. A letter dt. 19th April, 2022 to this effect has been issued to the Additional Chief Secretaries (Health)/ Principal Secretaries (Health)/ Secretaries (Health) of all States/UTs for giving wide publicity amongst the health workers in their respective States/UTs. The PMGKP was launched on 30th March, 2020 to provide comprehensive personal accident cover of Rs. 50 Lakh to 22.12 lakh health care providers including community health workers and private health workers who may have been in direct contact and care of COVID-19 patients and may be at risk of being impacted by this. Further, on account of the unprecedented situation, private hospital staff/retired/ volunteer/ local urban bodies/ contract/daily wage/ ad-hoc/outsourced staff requisitioned by States/ Central hospitals/ autonomous hospitals of Central/States/UTs, AIIMS & Institute of National Importance (INI)/hospitals of Central Ministries specifically drafted for care of COVID-19 patients are also covered under the PMGKP. Since the launch of the scheme, so far, 1905 claims of Health workers who died while being deployed for COVID related duties have been settled.

Fire Service Week observance Nukkad Natak on Fire Safety organized at Corbyn's Cove & Flag Point

Port Blair, April 19 (Nukkad Natak) Together with the rest of the country, the A & N Police Fire Service is observing the Fire Service Week from April 14 to 20. To educate the general public about the necessity of minimizing losses due to fire, various community outreach activities are being conducted during the week long programme. India administers more than 186.72 crore COVID vaccine doses

New Delhi, April 19 More than 186 crore 72 lakh COVID vaccine doses have been administered in the country so far under Nationwide Vaccination Drive. Health Ministry said, more than 16 lakh 89 thousand doses were administered in the last 24 hours. During the same period, a total of one thousand 247 new cases were reported in the country. India's Active caseload currently stands at 11 thousand 860 and the active cases stand at 0.03 percent. The recovery rate is currently at 98.76 percent. A total of 928 people have recovered in the last 24 hours and total recoveries touched over four crore 25 lakh and 11 thousand. (Source: india.gov.in)

BASIC FIRE PRECAUTIONS IN RURAL AREAS

Every year many fire incidents occur in villages resulting in heavy losses, depletion of stock of the most valuable and vitally required harvested crops meant for protecting millions from starvation. In many cases, even lives are lost. Such incidents can be minimized if the following fire precautions are observed.

Do's

- ▶ Extinguish cigarette/bidi ends and matches sticks before disposal.
- ▶ Keep combustible materials such as fuel, wood, oil, paints spirits etc in a separate room.
- ▶ The dwellings and huts should be constructed as far as possible with non-combustible materials.
- ▶ Electric insulation should be carried out by a qualified electrician.
- ▶ Burning of waste materials, grass land, rubbish, suitable, stubble etc. should always be done away from the residents under proper supervision.
- ▶ Provide spark arrestors on tractor exhaust pipe.
- ▶ While building up hay stack ensure that - 1) a minimum distance of 20m from the stack to stack or stack to residents is maintained. 2) Height of the stack should not be more than 06m. 3) Limit one stack to maximum of 20 tonnes. 4) Keep water drum and few buckets near hay stack. 5) If possible, build up the stack near ponds, river or the other water sources.

Don'ts

- ▶ Don't be careless about disposal of cigarettes/ bidi ends.
- ▶ Naked lamp or kitchen fire should never be allowed to burn while retiring to bed.
- ▶ Electric wiring should not pass over hay stacks.
- ▶ Hay stacks should not be built up near roads.

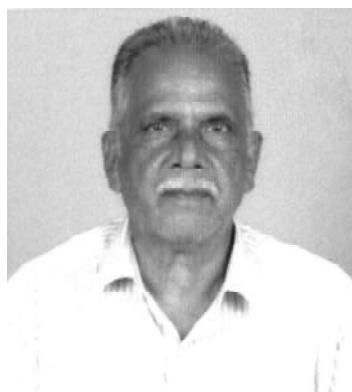
