MP for resuming dornier flight service for Carnic, C/Bay

Port Blair, Oct 7: The Member of Parliament, Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma on Thursday requested the Chief Secretary of A & N Administration to resume the Dornier Flight Service for Car Nicobar and Campbell Bay for Islanders.

In a letter addressed to the Chief Secretary, the Member of Parliament pointed out that on August 5th 2016, for the first time dornier

Govt opens India for foreigners; tourist visas from October 15

One-and-a-half years after India completely suspended tourist visas in the wake of the Covid-19 pandemic, the Centre on Thursday announced that it will begin issuing visas from October 15. However, for a month, tourists will be allowed entry into India only in chartered flights. Those wanting to visit India on scheduled commercial flights would have to wait till November 15, the government said.

After considering various inputs, the MHA (Ministry of Home Affairs) has decided to begin granting of fresh Tourist Visas for foreigners coming to India through

Robot police

For the lovers of efficient, consumerist authoritarianism, Singapore is indeed a paradise. The streets are clean, the restaurants swanky and the worldly cosmopolitanism is complemented by a "strong" state. There are no privacy laws to speak of, so the objections by some citizens to the 90,000 police cameras — set to double by 2030 — carry little bite. But cameras, jail time and crippling fines alone are not enough to perfect a well-ordered city-state Utopia. There is advanced facial recognition software on lampposts in addition to the cameras. And to perfect the panopticon, Singapore now has its very own Robocop.

Singapore has initiated a pilot programme in which robots on wheels, each outfitted with seven cameras and microphones, animated by advanced software, are patrolling residential areas and shopping complexes. The "Xavier" robocops blast warnings at denizens engaging in "socially undesirable behaviour". The list of prohibited acts that can lead to a tongue-lashing from an inanimate object include smoking in public, flouting Covid-19 norms and parking your bicycles improperly. For many, there is nothing disturbing about the imposition of discipline using robots — it usually takes a sci-fi fan to spot the impending machined apocalypse. And, the acts the Xavier robots are shouting at people for are similar to those that annoy the over-zealous office bearers of housing societies in urban India as well.

The point of surveillance, however, isn't really to catch a criminal in the act. It is, in fact, to make sure that people always act as if they are being watched. The robots, like the cameras and facial recognition software, aren't meant to make you afraid of the police. They are meant to place a policeman in your head. And, perhaps, in what is a sign of things to come, the Singapore government describes its surveillance ambitions as turning the city-state into a "smart nation".

DRDO IS OPENING ITS DOORS TO PRIVATE PLAYERS

India's premier defence research agency, DRDO, is opening its doors to private players by adopting the GOCO (Government-Owned Company Operated) model—where private industries will operate government-assets, sparing them of

the need to invest in land, machinery or other support systems. Upon the direction of the Prime Minister's Office, DRDO is opening the doors to its network of about 50 laboratories across the country. It is estimated that DRDO has over Rs 1

lakh crore worth of assets across the country.

"Through, this model, the DRDO is exploring the possibility to identify potential industry partners for its special facilities, infrastructures and related activities that can be operated

by industry partner," stated an internal note of DRDO, addressed to all of its laboratories. The note included detailed guidelines for choosing industry partners for the GOCO model.

The move could spare DRDO from routine, mundane and specialised activities, which will be delegated to the industry partners.

"It will lead to mutual benefit by increasing the efficiency of DRDO in research and development and provide more conducive environment for defence industries with enriched experience," read the note. The move will boost competitiveness among the private entities and pave the way towards new technologies, it added.

This move can help keep DRDO's prime focus on research and development, whilst also giving it an important role in bringing up the capabilities of industries by partnering them in its programmes and projects.

Selected industry partners (under GOCO) will perform operation and maintenance of DRDO's facilities, plants, equipment and

machinery. Any necessary knowledge transfer will be based on the project requirements.

"GOCO partner need not make investment in land, machinery and other support system," it clarified. The selected private industry partner will get enough independence in implementing the mission using their best practices.

The Modi government has taken several measures to boost the indigenous defence manufacturing sector, with initiatives like Aatma Nirbhar Bharat, which are aimed at improving self-reliance as well as accelerating India's defence exports. The Ministry of Defence (MoD) has set an ambitious defence exports target of Rs 35,000 crore by 2025.

The Army has already adopted the Government-Owned Contractor Operated (GOCO) model for its base workshops and ordnance depots, in a bid to improve operational efficiency. This was following the recommendations of the Lt. Gen. DB Shekatkar (Retd.) committee to enhance combat capability and rebalance defence expenditure.

chartered flights with effect from October 15, 2021," he ministry said in a statement.

It added that foreign tourists entering India by flights other than chartered aircraft would be able to do so only with effect from November 15 on fresh Tourist Visas.

"All due protocols and norms relating to Covid-19 as notified by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare from time to time, shall be adhered to by the foreign tourists, carriers bringing them into India and all other stakeholders at landing stations," the statement said adding that with this, the restrictions placed on visa and international travel had eased given the present overall Covid-19 situation.

Sources said the decision was under deliberation by the government for over a month and the Ministry of Tourism had been pushing for the opening up of tourist

visas as the tourism and hotel sector had suffered the most during the pandemic. The decision is also informed by a high number of vaccinations achieved in the past couple of months and a significant dip in the number of infections being reported from large parts of the country. As on October 6, there were 22,431 new cases of coronavirus infections in the country.

"The Covid pressure has eased up considerably and so the government has decided to open up the economy further. However, we are taking one step at a time as we do not want an influx of tourists suddenly. So, initially chartered flights are being allowed. Tourists can book themselves or through a travel company and hire a chartered flight to visit India. Regular tourist operations will begin only from November 15," a home ministry official said.

Due to the pandemic, all visas granted to foreigners were suspended last year. Various other restrictions were also imposed on international travel by the Centre to arrest the spread of the pandemic. After considering the evolving Covid-19 situation, foreigners were later on allowed to travel to India via air. However, the MHA had been receiving representations from several state governments as well as various stakeholders in the tourism sector to start Tourist Visas also, to allow foreign tourists to come to India. Therefore, the MHA consulted all major stakeholders like the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Ministry of External Affairs, Ministry of Civil Aviation, Ministry of Tourism and various State Governments where foreign tourists are expected to arrive," the MHA statement said.

How to download your COVID-19 vaccine certificate

A COVID-19 Vaccine Certificate (CVC) issued by the Union Government is proof that you have been vaccinated in India. CVC provides information to the beneficiary on date and type of vaccine used, and the provisional certificate is useful for the next vaccination.

Producing CVC is required for certain kind of social interactions and foreign travel.

People who are fully vaccinated and want to travel abroad will have a CoWIN certificate with their full date of birth along with passport number.

The certificate issued by CoWIN has security features that can be digitally verified on the CoWIN portal.

You can download vaccination certificate from CoWIN portal or the Aarogya Setu

app through DigiLocker by using the same mobile number used at the time of registration.

Cowin portal is the official website for the vaccination in India. Visit <https://>



www.cowin.gov.in for downloading the certificate. Click on Covid Vaccine certificate and enter Beneficiary Reference ID to access the certificate.

Alternatively, you can find vaccination certificate in DigiLocker under the category of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.

You may download Corona Vaccination certificate from the DigiLocker app by following these steps.

First install DigiLocker app by downloading it from the Play store. Documents from Government departments can be found on DigiLocker app. You may also store your personal documents like Aadhar Card, Driving License on it.

After registration process using details like Name, date of birth, gender, Security Pin, Mobile number, Aadhar number, and email ID, you can get your Vaccine Certificate from the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW).

Click on the "Vaccine Certificate" and then enter your 13 Digit Reference ID. You will soon get your Covid Vaccine Certificate.

Two studies say immunity from the Pfizer vaccine wanes after two months

Two world studies, from Israel and from Qatar—published in the New England Journal of Medicine, have said that immunity against the coronavirus wanes two months after taking the Pfizer vaccine. The report comes a day after a study was published in the Lancet journal that said that the Pfizer vaccine against the coronavirus disease is highly effective at preventing hospitalisations from infections of all variants—including Delta—for at least six months after a person has been administered two doses of the shot.

A study from Israel showed that antibodies in 4,800 healthcare workers waned rapidly after two doses of the vaccine, "especially among men, among persons 65 years of age or older, and among persons with immunosuppression." The study from Qatar looked at the vaccinated population of the Gulf nation, where most people received the Pfizer/Biontech vaccine. The Pfizer/Biontech vaccine is also known as BNT162b2. "BNT162b2-induced protection against infection builds rapidly after the first dose, peaks in the first month after the second dose, and then gradually wanes in subsequent months," said Laith Abu-Raddad of Weill Cornell Medicine-Qatar and colleagues wrote. "The waning appears to accelerate after the fourth month, to reach a low level of approximately 20% in subsequent months," they added, a CNN report reads.

"We found that a significant and rapid decrease in humoral response to the BNT162b2 vaccine was observed within months after vaccination," Dr Gil Regev-Yochay of Israel's Sheba Medical Centre wrote.

The Qatari scientists observed, that vaccinated people are likely to have more social contact than unvaccinated people and this behaviour could diminish the vaccine's real-world effectiveness relative to its biological effectiveness, which could explain why protection is waning.

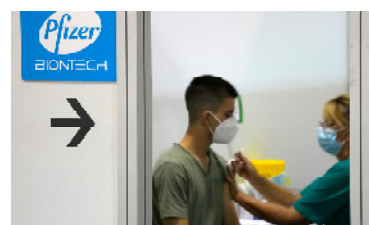
In the Lancet study validating the vaccine's effectiveness, researchers found that only the effectiveness of Pfizer vaccine did not decline significantly over the

study period, as opposed to that of other vaccines which declined against all SARS-CoV-2 variants within one month of the two doses being administered. The research team analysed 3,436,957 electronic health records from the Kaiser Permanente Southern California health system between December 4, 2020, and August 8, 2021, to assess vaccine effectiveness against SARS-CoV-2 infections and Covid-related hospitalisation.

During the study period, 5.4 per cent of people were infected with SARS-CoV-2. Among those who were infected, 6.6 per cent were hospitalised. Researchers did not observe a difference in waning between SAR-CoV-2 variant types.

However, they noted that because Delta became the dominant strain in the middle of the study period, analyses with longer follow-up measure the rate of waning for the variant compared to other strains are needed. "Our variant-specific

analysis clearly shows that the BNT162b2 vaccine is effective against all current variants of concern, including Delta," said Luis Jodar, senior vice-president and chief medical officer, Pfizer Vaccines.



Nobel Prize for Literature goes to Tanzanian Abdulrazak Gurnah

Tanzanian writer Abdulrazak Gurnah was awarded the Nobel Prize for Literature on Thursday for works that explore the legacies of imperialism on uprooted individuals. The Swedish Academy said the award was in recognition of his uncompromising and compassionate penetration of the effects of colonialism and the fate of the refugee in the gulf between cultures and continents. Born in Zanzibar in 1948 and based in England, Gurnah is a



professor at the University of Kent. He is the author of 10 novels, including Paradise, which was shortlisted for the Booker Prize in 1994.

Anders Olsson, chairman of the Nobel Committee for literature, called him one of the world's most prominent post-colonial writers. The prestigious award comes with a gold medal and 10 million Swedish kronor (over \$1.14 million). The prize money comes from a bequest left by the prize's creator, Swedish inventor Alfred Nobel, who died in 1895. "Glick was a popular choice after several years of controversy. In 2018 the award was postponed after sex abuse allegations rocked the Swedish Academy, the secretive body that chooses the winners. The awarding of the 2019 prize to Austrian writer Peter Handke caused protests because of his strong support for the Serbs during the 1990s Balkan wars. On Monday, the Nobel Committee awarded the prize in physiology or medicine to Americans David Julius and Ardem Patapoutian for their discoveries into how the human body perceives temperature and touch. The Nobel Prize in physics was awarded Tuesday to three scientists whose work found order in seeming disorder, helping to explain and predict complex forces of nature, including expanding our understanding of climate change. Benjamin List and David W.C. MacMillan were named as laureates of the Nobel Prize for chemistry Wednesday for finding an easier and environmentally cleaner way to build molecules that can be used to make compounds, including medicines and pesticides. Still to come are prizes for outstanding work in the fields of peace and economics.
