#### In the emerging post-pandemic new world order, India has to increase its role and develop itself at a fast pace

New Delhi, Mar. 17 (PIB) The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi addressed the Valedictory Function of 96<sup>th</sup> Common Foundation Course at Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration (LBSNAA) today via video conferencing. He also inaugurated the new sports complex and dedicated revamped Happy Valley Complex to the Nation.

"In all your years of service, these factors of service and duty should be the measure of your personal and professional success", he added. He said work is never a burden when done with a

sense of duty and purpose. He told the officers that they have come to the service with a sense of purpose and to be a part of a positive change in the context of the society and the country.

The Prime Minister emphasized the need to embrace the experience from the field as real feel of the issues of the file come from the field. He said that files do not contain just the numbers and statistics but they contain life and aspirations of the people. "You do not have to work for numbers but for the lives of the people", he said.


On the auspicious occasion of 'Holi', I extend my warm and best wishes to all the residents of A&N Islands.

Port Blair, Mar. 17 The commuters/general public have been informed that as per the special bulletin issued by India Meteorological Department, Port Blair low pressure area over central parts of South Bay of Bengal and it is likely to be intensified into a cyclonic storm by 21<sup>st</sup> March, 2022. Keeping in view the safety of the passengers and the vessel,

the announced sailing programme may get disrupted leading to suspension or cancelation of the vessels in the Mainland Island/ Foreshore/Inter Island Sector.

Similarly, in the adverse weather conditions, operation of Harbour/ Vehicle ferry services between Chatham, Bambooflat, Phoenix Bay, Dundas Point & Panigat

and vessels operating at out stations may also get disrupted/suspended in short notice depending upon the weather condition.

### COVID-19 status in A & N Islands

#### No positive case detected during RT-PCR test conducted on incoming flight passengers

Port Blair, Mar. 17

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 29 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 4 flights with 390 passengers arrived, out of which, 338 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test

was conducted on 41 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 37 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 36

passengers and no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 4 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected. At helipad, 3 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

Siren of Electronic Display Board installed at Police Control Room, State Control Room, Junglighat (Fisheries Dept.), Met Office, MRCC, JOC, INS Jarawa at Port Blair, Fisheries Dept. at Rangat, EOC at Mayabunder, MRCC at Diglipur, Fisheries Dept. at Hut Bay, EOC at Kamorta, EOC at Car Nicobar, and MRCC & EOC at Campbell Bay will also be blown in a similar manner at 1000 Hrs.

Therefore, the general public is hereby informed not to panic during the test of siren and requested to remain calm during test blast of siren on the date and time specified above.

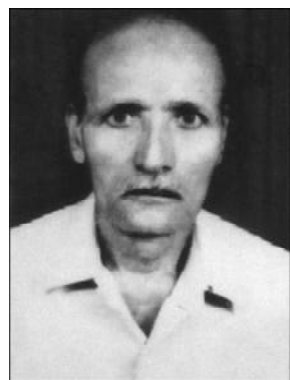

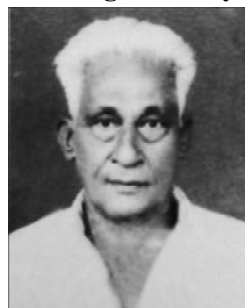
