

Polling to elect new Vice President of India to be held today

New Delhi, Aug. 5

The polling to elect the new Vice President of India will be held tomorrow (August 6). The polling will take place at the Parliament House between 10 a. m. and 5 p. m. Shri Jagdeep Dhankar is the NDA candidate, while Smt. Margaret Alva is the Opposition candidate for the Vice Presidential Election. The Vice President is elected by the members of the Electoral College consisting of the members of both Houses of Parliament in accordance with the system of proportional representation by means of the single transferable vote. The total number of electors are 788 Members of Parliament. It includes 543 elected Members of the Lok Sabha and 233 elected Members of the Rajya Sabha as well as 12 nominated members of the Rajya Sabha. The counting will take place at the Parliament House after the voting tomorrow. The term of Vice President Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu will be ending on 10th of this month. (Source:india.gov.in)

The first meeting of Executive Committee of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Rural Livelihood Mission, attached to the Directorate of RD, PRIs & ULBs, A&N Administration for the FY-2022-23 was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary (RD), Shri. Suneel Anchipaka today to review the overall progress of implementation of DAY-NRLM since inception of scheme up

to the 1st quarter of the FY 2022-23.

The meeting was attended by the Directors and Officials of Rural Development, Agriculture, Tribal Welfare, Industries, Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, Education Department, Health Services Department, NABARD, Lead Bank Manager, NGOs - ACANI, Community Resource Persons (CPRs) of GP Sippighat & Tushnabad and leaders of Anmol Block Level Federation

of Ferrargunj.

During the meeting detailed discussion about the progress under the scheme was done. The committee was informed that so far 1067 SHGs, 81 Village Organizations and 5 Block Level Federations have been formed under the scheme. 908 SHGs have received Revolving Fund of Rs.136.20 Lakh and 497 SHGs have received Community Investment Fund of Rs.440.80 Lakh. Nearly, 50% SHG members are involved

in Farm Livelihood activities and 8 Producer Groups have been formed so far. Nearly 20% SHG members are involved in the Non-Farm Livelihood activities. 40 SHG have been registered on GeM and selling their products through GeM and many more are under process of registration. 36 SHGs involved in food processing activities have received Seed Capital up to Rs.40,000 per SHG member

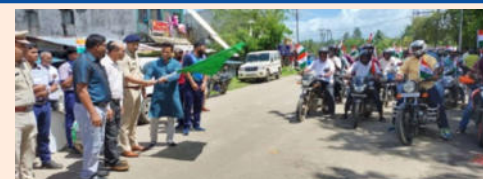

A meeting under the chairmanship of the District Magistrate (South Andaman), Shri Suneel Anchipaka was held in connection with preparedness and law and order arrangements for Ganesh Puja Celebrations- 2022 in South Andaman District, to be celebrated from 31st August 2022 concluding with immersion of Idols. The officials from line Departments including Additional District Magistrate (South Andaman), Superintendent of Police (South Andaman), representatives of Electricity, Fire, PBMC, IP&T and other Departments and the Presidents/Secretaries of



Ganesh Puja Committees were present during the meeting. The organizers were directed to follow the prevalent norms and guidelines with regard to fire safety, traffic arrangements, law and order clearances, electricity and cleanliness. They were also directed to adhere to present COVID protocols and to maintain peace and harmony and also obtain due permissions for all activities. Necessary directions were also given to line departments including Electricity, Fire Safety, Health & Police Department for ensuring peaceful conduct of the festival.

Commercial establishments & general public sensitized on SWM bye laws, plastic waste management, SUP ban by RD Deptt.

Port Blair, Aug. 5

An awareness programme on eradication of Single Use Plastic from the UT of A&N Islands on a mission mode was organized at Community Hall, Sippighat recently, to sensitize all commercial establishments and general public under South Andaman Jurisdiction in the presence of BDO (Ferrargunj & Prothrapur), Pradhan, Panchayat Secretary, Panchayat officials and Officials from Directorate of Rural Development.

The ban on manufacture, import, stocking, distribution,

sale and use of identified single use plastic has come into force across the country since 1st July 2022. Single use plastic is intended to be used 'only once' before being disposed off or recycled. The banned items include mostly plastic carry bags, ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, plastic straw, candy sticks, ice cream sticks, polystyrene (Thermocol) for decoration, plastic plates, cups, plastic glasses and plastic cutlery.

During the programme, participants were sensitized on different types of plastics, harmful effects of the Single Use Plastics, SWM

Bye laws 2019, alternatives of plastic etc. The Block Development Officer emphasized on intensifying the behavioural change in individual to reduce the demand of Single Use Plastic in everyday life that will result in supply of SUP at a minimal level.

Further, the Pradhan, Panchayat Secretary and officials from the Directorate of RD also encouraged the commercial establishments and stakeholders to abide by the SWM Bye laws 2019 and help in eradication of Single Use Plastic from everyday use, handling and operation, a press release from DC SA said.

DoT conducts EMF radiation awareness session at JNRM

Port Blair, Aug. 5

Faster expansion of telecom infrastructure in A&N Islands needs speedy deployment of towers. To materialise this goal, the DoT has planned to provide 4G mobile coverage by installing 128 towers for covering 85 uncovered villages and along NH-4 in A&N Islands. However, due to misconceptions and misinformation, public at some locations are apprehensive whenever a tower is proposed in the vicinity of residence etc.

The DoT A&N team conducted EMF radiation awareness session at JNRM recently to create awareness and dispel myths about concerning EMF emissions from mobile towers among students, faculty of JNRM which was inaugurated by Deputy Director General, DoT, Shri KP Mohan. In his presentation, the Director Telecom DoT, informed that Government of India has adopted very stringent norms by adopting 1/10th of the prescribed International EMF radiation limit. DoT has also created a mechanism to ensure



that radiation limits from telecom towers are maintained by all Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) within limits. All TSPs have to give periodic self certificates to this effect and DoT field offices have been mandated to audit 10% BTS every year. Apart from this, DoT has created a portal www.tarangsanchargov.in wherein there is a provision for the general public to see the radiation level of towers in their vicinity by entering their area postal PIN code.

Considering the mobile expansion plan for introduction of 5G,

the number of towers is to be increased from 333 to 520 within the next 2 years. Therefore, DoT A&N Port Blair has requested for co-operation among stakeholders including the general public to shed all misconceptions about mobile tower radiations and come forward to extend all possible support for faster roll out of telecom infrastructure to meet the unprecedented demand for telecom services and improve quality of telecom service in A&N Islands, a press release from Director Telecom, DoT A&N said.

under PMFME scheme for enhancement of the activity. During the discussion, the representative of Agriculture Department requested the ANIRLM to supply cow dung through SHGs registered on GeM Portal. The Departments such as Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, Agriculture and Industries have extended to provide livelihood training to the SHG members in their respective areas.

After detailed discussions to support the SHGs for marketing of their products, the Secretary (RD) issued direction to seek clarification from the MoRD, GoI regarding any kind of relaxations that could be given to SHGs for participation in the Mid Day Meal Tender or any other departmental tenders.

He also directed the representative of Department of Industries for release of Seed Capital to the eligible SHGs under PMFME Scheme. He requested the Department of Industries to provide training to the SHGs on packaging techniques of specific products produced by the SHG such as handicraft, virgin coconut oil, pickles, jams etc. He directed the ANIRLM team to coordinate with the Department of Food Safety to organize training on quality control/ check of food products made by the SHGs.

For the adoption of the SHGs formed by other institutions under the ambit of DAY-NRLM, the committee was informed that the Secretary, MoRD, GoI has issued direction to bring all SHGs under NRLM fold to know the present universe of SHGs and to avoid duplication of benefits provided by the Government. On this, Secretary (RD) requested the NGOs and the NABARD to explain the benefits of NRLM scheme to the SHGs formed by them & other institutions so that they may come under the ambit of NRLM and avail the benefits of the scheme. The representative of ACANI NGO informed that they are going to organize a programme for SHG leaders in their office at Lamba Line on 10th August, 2022 and the Secretary (RD) directed the ANIRLM Team and Lead Bank Manager to participate in the programme to brief about NRLM scheme.

The committee decided to organize SARAS Mela in convergence with all the Line Departments in the month of November/ December, 2022 to provide marketing opportunity to the SHGs and support them for their better livelihood, a press release from DCSA said.

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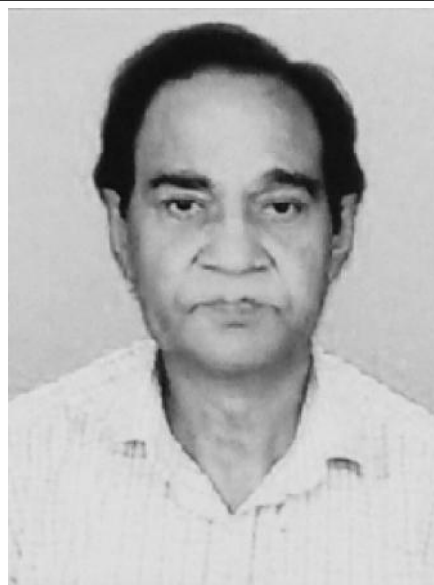

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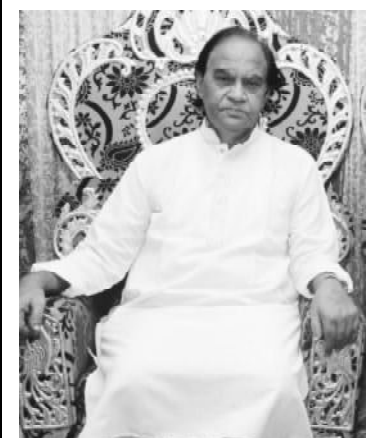
