

Use of single use plastic items to be banned from July 1

Carry bags made of virgin or recycled plastic should not be less than 120 microns in thickness with effect from Dec. 31

Port Blair, June 27
The Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change has issued notification G. S. R No.571 (E) dated 12th August, 2021 as Plastic Waste Management (Amendment) Rules-2021. As per Rule 4 (2) of PWM Rules, 2016 (as amended), the manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of single use plastic (SUP), including polystyrene and expanded polystyrene, commodities shall be prohibited with effect from the 1st July, 2022. The prohibited SUP are ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, plastic flags, candy sticks, ice cream sticks, polystyrene [Thermocol] for decoration, plates, cups, glasses, cutlery such as forks, spoons, knives, straw, trays, wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 micron, stirrers.

Single use plastic items to be completely banned from July 1, 2022

• Plastic flags, ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, candy sticks, ice cream sticks, polystyrene (Thermocol) for decoration, plates, cups, glasses, cutlery such as forks, spoons, knives, straw, trays, wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 micron, stirrers will be prohibited.



Plastic bags to be thicker

Carry bag made of virgin or recycled plastic shall not be less than one hundred twenty (120) microns in thickness with effect from 31st December, 2022.

All Producers, Stockiest, Retailers, Shopkeepers, E-Commerce Companies, Street Vendors, Commercial Establishments (Malls / Marketplace / Shopping Centers/ Cinema Houses/ Tourist Locations/ Schools/ Colleges/ Office Complexes/ Hospitals & other Institutions) and general public have been informed to stop production, stocking, distribution, sale and usage of identified SUP items as per the timelines specified in the said

As per Rule 4 (1) of PWM rules, 2016 (as amended), carry bag made of virgin or recycled plastic shall not be less than one hundred twenty (120) microns in thickness with effect from 31st December, 2022.

Further, as per the A&N Administration vide Notification No.186 dated 05.09.2019, the manufacture, storage, use, import, transportation, distribution and sale of single use plastic items has been banned in A&N Islands viz. PET Bottles- Water & Beverages, including alcohol, <2L (Less than 2 litres), plastic bodied cigarette lighters, sachets (shampoo, conditioners and similar personal care items, mouth-fresheners, pickle/jam/ sauces, spices, condiments, etc.), <15

mL (or equivalent in weight) and single-use, plastic bodied use & throw pens.

Similarly, as per the A&N Administration vide Notification No. 225 dated 24.09.2019, the use, manufacture and sale of plastic carry bags irrespective of its thickness, size, color and nature is banned in A&N Islands.

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands

6,83,512 beneficiaries above 18 years, 43248 between 15 & 18 years & 24326 between 12 & 14 years administered both doses of vaccine till date

Port Blair, June 27

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,83,512 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far, out of which, the number of beneficiaries vaccinated with first dose stands at 342481 while 341031 have been administered second dose. Similarly, 43248 cumulative beneficiaries in the age group of 15 to 18 years have been vaccinated with both doses of vaccine, out of which, 23,583 have been vaccinated with first dose while 19665 have been administered second dose.

In the age group of 12 to 14 years, cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated



with both doses of vaccine reaches 24326, out of which, 13,264 beneficiaries have been vaccinated with first dose

while 11062 have been administered second dose. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 27,277.

A total of 158 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 142 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 4 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 100.

16 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 7 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years, a press release from DHS said.

COVID-19 status in A & N Islands

Port Blair, June 27

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 196 incoming flight passengers who arrived here yesterday, three positive cases have been detected. Today, 12 flights with 1805 passengers arrived, out of which, 1569 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 188 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 54 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been

detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 74 passengers were tested with RAT and no positive case has been detected. RAT was conducted on 62 passengers at Mohanpura Bus Terminus, no positive case has been detected. At Helipad, 4 passengers were tested with RAT and the reports were negative. RT-PCR test was conducted on 8 passengers who arrived by the sailing of MV Campbell Bay from Chennai and the reports are awaited, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

of State PGI, 83-indicator based PGI for District (PGI-D) has been designed to grade the performance of all districts in school education. The data is filled by districts through online portal. The PGI-D is expected to help the State Education Departments to identify gaps at the district level and improve their performance in a decentralized manner. The indicator-wise PGI score shows the areas where a district needs to improve. The PGI-D will reflect the relative performance of all the districts in a uniform scale which encourages them to perform better.

The PGI-D structure comprises of total weightage of 600 points across 83 indicators, which are grouped under 6 categories viz., Outcomes, Effective Classroom Transaction, Infrastructure Facilities & Student's Entitlements, School Safety & Child Protection, Digital Learning and Governance Process. These categories are further divided into 12 domains, viz. Learning Outcomes and Quality (LO), Access Outcomes (AO), Teacher Availability and Professional Development Outcomes (TAPDO), Learning Management (LM), Learning Enrichment Activities (LEA), Infrastructure, Facilities, Student Entitlements (IF&SE), School Safety and Child Protection (SS&CP), Digital Learning (DL), Funds Convergence and Utilization (FCV), Enhancing CRCs Performance (CRCP), Attendance Monitoring Systems (AMS) and School Leadership Development (SLD).

PGI-D grades the districts into ten grades viz. Highest achievable Grade is Daksh, which is for Districts scoring more than 90% of the total points in that category or overall. The lowest grade in PGI-D is called Akanshi-3 which is for scores upto 10% of the total points. Ultimate objective of PGI-D is to help the districts to priorities areas for intervention in school education and thus improve to reach the highest grade.

The PGI-D 2020-21 is presently under compilation. PGI-D 2018-19 and 2019-20 provides insight into intra State comparison of progress of school education.

India beat Ireland by seven wickets in first T-20 International of two-match series at Dublin

Put into bat first, hosts Ireland posted 108 for the loss of four wickets in 12 overs riding on Harry Tector's unbeaten quick knock of 64 runs. For visitors, Yuzvendra Chahal, Bhuvneshwar Kumar, Hardik Pandya and Avesh



Khan picked a wicket each.

In reply, India overhauled the target losing three wickets in 9.2 overs with the help of opener Deepak Hooda's not out 47 and Ishan Kishan's 26 runs. For hosts, Craig Young picked up two wickets.

Earlier, skipper

Hardik Pandya, who was leading India for first time, elected to bowl first after winning the toss. For Men in Blue, Young pacer Umrang Malik received his maiden cap while for hosts, Conor Olphert made his debut. The second T20 will be played tomorrow at the same venue.
