Denizens slam waste of precious forest wealth extracted from Forests in N&M

Port Blair, Nov With infrastructure build-up on in these islands on a scale like nev erbefore, demand for imber particularly hardwood has increased manifold over the hardwoodhas increased manifoldove r he past few y ears. But under-utilization of precious forest wealth is drawing sharp criticism for the Department of Erw inonment and Forest of the UT Administration.

Besides Chatham Saw Milland he one at Belapur in Middle Andaman, a number of Forest Div ision spread across the North and Middle Andaman region has been desirated as timber deposts from

been de signated as timber depots from where timber is issued to people as per indents. However, many of such Forest Range Offices or Beat Offices stand testimony to colossal waste of forest produce extracted from designated forest reserve areas. Timber logs of differen varieties can be easily noticed being left to rot along the roadside or near Forest offices for months.

"The Forest Department carries out "The Forest Department carries out extensive lumbering activities in reserve areas to cater to the demands of general public, building agencies as also government departments. For he purpose, the department utilises the services of tuskers and heavy machinery to carryout



transportthem to the nearest Forest Camp. But almost 1/3rd of such extracted fimber is wasted due to delayed or absolute no transportation to the mills. Kadamtala fo instance's one glaring example where one can find huge quantity of logs of superior hardwood left to decay near the forest camp, "saida villager of Rangat.

During the visit, he interacted with patients, villagers of the region, par-medical staffs and Doctors of both the PHCs to understand the challenges and difficulties faced

of both the PHCs to understand the challenges and difficulties faced by the patients and health care workers. It was informed to the Member of Parliament that the Generator set of PHC Baratang is out of order since a long time for which patients are suffering heavily. As the region faces frequent load-shedding, the admitted patients feel helpless during such power cuts. Even health care workers find it difficult to manage the patients during power cuts. During adverse weather, it becomes difficult to health workers to manage the hospital. It was also informed to Member of Parliament that there is a short age of para-medical staffs at PHC Baratang, which is ultimately affecting the treatment of patients. The patients also informed the Member of Parliament that most of the time the PHC Baratang are remains out of SNIL. patients. The patients also informed the Member of Parliamentthat most of the time the PHC Baratang area remains out of BSNL network coverage, hence in case of emergency and other requirements neither admitted patients can contact their relative nor family members can contact any admitted patients. Villagers of the area told the Member of Parliament that the X-Ray machine provided to the PHC Baratang is very old and othen remains out of order for which ultimately patients are suffering. AIPHC Kadantala talking to the Member of Parliament, the general public of the region demanded a new building for the PHC as the presentibuilding is very old and congested. The villagers of Kadamtala also demanded posting of a lady doctor for the region.

Grow and flourish

On November 8, fintech major Paytm's initial public offering (IPO) opened for subscriptions. At Rs 18,300 crore, this was India's largest ever IPO. The IPO comes on the heels of another startup, Zomato, tapping the public markets recently to raise capital. On Wednesday, Nykaa, the beauty startup, saw its market value almost double to over Rs 1 lakh crore on its stock market debut Ruward by the success. crore on its stock market debut. Buoved by the success crore on its stock market debut. Buoyed by the success of these companies in tapping the public markets, several such unicorns (startups valued at over \$1 billion) are in the process of firming up their IPO plans. This not only attests to the depth of the domestic capital markets, and the willingness of investors to back these startups, but is also a promiting time for the larger startup occursion. promising sign for the larger startup ecosystem, one of the most vibrant parts of the Indian economy at the moment. Reports of new unicorns being created are now

a regular feature. These unicorns exist not only in well known segments such as e-commerce and fintech, but also in other verticals such as logistics. An earlier report by Credit Suisse had traced their phenomenal rise to a confluence of factors, amongst which is the increasing ability to transact digitally. Platforms like the Unified Payments Interface have transformed the digital poyments ecosystem in India. The take the Onjide rayments interjace have transformed the digital payments ecosystem in India. The pandemic has only accelerated the pace of adoption of such modes of transaction — UPI recorded a staggering four billion transactions in October this year. This shift towards digital modes of transaction year. Ins Sinji towards auguat modes of transaction has been facilitated by the Aadhaar platform, which has greatly eased the verification process, and the sharp rise in internet users across the country. The latter has been driven by the phenomenal rise in mobile data usage owing to the collapse in data

mobile data usage owing to the collapse in data prices. Then there is also the concomitant improvement in physical infrastructure aiding economic activities — the report points out that road connectivity has improved significantly as have household electrification rates.

However, their current valuations do raise eyebrows. The multiples being commanded may seem stretched. For instance, Zomato's net loss widened by 87 per cent to Rs 430 crore in the second quarter of the ongoing financial year. The company is valued at over Rs 1 lakh crore. Similarly, consolidated losses for One97 Communications (Payim) stood at Rs 381.9 core in the quarter ending June 2021. But the ability to raise such huge amounts of capital signals the presence of a large pool of risk capital available to Indian companies. Investors, both private and public, are increasingly willing to back disruptors, taking a longer view. Beijing so crackdown on China's tech sector is only likely to ouck disruption, taking a longer twee, Belfing s crackdown on China's tech sector is only likely to facilitate greater foreign capital flows towards such companies. Depression dissipated over Tamil Nadu, fresh system forming in Andaman sea

The depression over Tami Nadu dissipated to a well-marked low-pressure area centred over north Tamil Nadu on Friday morning. It will bring light to moderate rainfall, with heavy rainfall in some parts of Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, coastal Andhra Pradesh, Ravalaseema, and south interior Karnataka and Kerala, according to the India Meteorological Department. The system resulted in a significantamount of rainfall in the 24 hours fill Friday morning 8:30 am – Kavali in Andhra Pradesh witnessed 10 cm rainfall, Tamil Nadu's Nungambakkam and Dharampuri recorded 6cm rainfall each, and And hra's Machilip atnamand

Kalingapatram received 4 cm of rainfall.

This is less in comparison to the rainfall the regions received when the low-pressure area was moving towards the Indian landmass. Under the influence of the system, heavy

rainfall was recorded in stations across Chennai – Ennore portsaw 12 cm of rainfall in 24 hours till Thursday morning, Nungambakkam received 11.4 cm, MRC Nagar received 11.5 cm, and Taramani received 10.3 cm. A day before, Nagapatinam reported over 23 cm of rainfall and Thiruv arur received 20 cm. A fresh low-pressure area is likely to form

over the South Andaman sea tomorrow. It will move northwestwards and intensity further over the next 48 hours. The system will bring heavy rain and thunderstorm in parts of the Andaman

and Nicobar islands on Saturday and Sunday. The system will again lead to squally winds and rough sea conditions in the Andaman sea over the weekend and in the adjoining central Bay of Bengalon November 15 and 16.



Scientists have built a plant that can produce carbon-neutral liquid fuels from sunlight and air. The next goal will be to take this technology to industrial scale and achieve

In a paper published in the journal Nature, researchers from ETH Zurich and Potsdam describe how this novel solar reactor functions and outline a policy framework that would provide incentives to expand the production of "solar kerosene."

Carbon-neutral fuels are crucial for making aviation and maritime transport sustainable. "People's interest in meditation and mindfulness is outpacing what science can prove in terms of effects and benefits," said Jeff Lin, MSU psychology doctoral candidate and study co-author. "But it's amazing to me that we were able to see how one session of a guided meditation can produce changes to brain activity in non-meditators."

The findings suggest that different forms of meditation can have different neurocognitive effects and Lin explained that there is little research about how open monitoring affected how people detect and enhance the brain's ability to detect

"A certain neural signal occurs about halfa second after an error called the error positivity, which is linked to conscious error recognition. We found that the strength of this signal is increased

in the meditators relative to controls."

While the meditators didn't have immediate improvements to actual task performance, the researchers' findings offer a promising window into the potential of sustained meditation.

"These findings are a strong demonstration of what just 20 minutes of meditation can do to and pay attention to mistakes," Moser said. "It makes us feel more confident in what mindfulness meditation might really be capable of for performance and daily functioning right there in the

While meditation and mindfulness have gained mainsteam interestin recenty ears, Linis among arelatively small group of researchers that take a neuroscientific approach to assessing their psychological and performance effects. Looking ahead, Lin said that the next phase of research will be to include a broader group of participants, test different forms of meditation and determine whether changes in brain activity can translate to behavioral changes with more long-term practice
