## Branches of giant trees at ANIIDCO premises posing life threat

Residents of Dairy Farm writes to General Manager for mincing of branches



Dairy Farm, 21<sup>st</sup> Jan, 2022: Giant old trees at the premises of ANIIDCO's Milk plant at Dairy Farm have become a nightmare of the residents around the boundary wall of the premises. Residents fear that it may fall on their houses causing damage to life and property. As the approach footpath for houses around the boundary wall is along

the wall, it may claim the life of commuters. As reported to this daily, the concern of residents is genuine and the condition of trees as well as branches is such that it may fall any time. Even a slight inclement weather may lead to disaster for families residing adjacent to the boundary wall of the ANIIDCO's milk treatment plant at dairy farm. The branches of giant old trees inside the boundary wall of the milk treatment plant are covering a vast aerial space outside the premises. Passing over the footpath and many houses, these branches may fall on commuters, residents and houses. The concern of people of the area is genuine and needs immediate Redressal. By according to priority, these branches need to be minced at the earliest. It is learnt that the residents of the space around the boundary wall of the ANIIDCO's milk treatment plant, Dairy Farm have approached the General Manager, ANIIDCO with the request of intervention and Redressal of their concerns.



## Vaccination drive continuing smoothly in isles

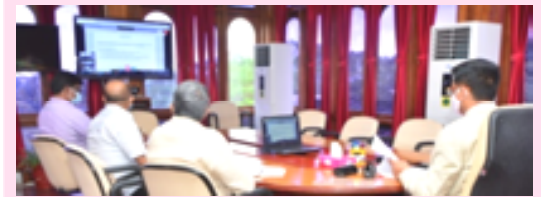
Port Blair, Jan 21: The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,02,502 beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above have been vaccinated so far in A&N Islands. Similarly, 18,811 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 years against the target beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 3814. A total of 694 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands yesterday. 527 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 49 beneficiaries were in the age group of 15-18 years, 61 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 225. 83 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 20 beneficiaries were in the age group of 15-18 years, 7 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 39. 84 beneficiaries were See... ## 'Matter of great sadness': Rahul Gandhi on Amar Jawan Jyoti issue

According to officials, the merger of flames will be done in an elaborate ceremony which is scheduled for 3:30pm today at India Gate.

Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Friday attacked the central government, accusing it of extinguishing the Amar Jawan Jyoti at India Gate in New Delhi. The former Congress president said that "some people cannot understand patriotism". This despite the government claiming that the eternal flame will not be extinguished but merged with the flame at the National War Memorial, 400-metres away from India Gate.



"It is a matter of great sadness that the immortal flame that used to burn for our brave soldiers will be extinguished today. Some people cannot understand patriotism and sacrifice - never mind. We will once again light the Amar Jawan Jyoti for our soldiers," Gandhi wrote on Twitter.

According to officials, the merger of flames will be done in an elaborate ceremony which is

scheduled for 3:30pm today at India Gate. The flame will be moved in a torch to the National War Memorial along with Guard Contingent and the two flames will be merged.

The India Gate memorial was built by the British government in memory of the British Indian Army soldiers who lost their lives between 1914-1921.

Congress leader Priyanka Gandhi Vadra served up a major surprise on Friday morning - that she could be her party's chief ministerial candidate for next month's Uttar Pradesh Assembly election. Ms. Gandhi Vadra, who was releasing a manifesto outlining job creation plans for the youth of UP, was asked about speculation over the Congress' chief ministerial candidate for this election, given the BJP will line up behind Yogi Adityanath and the Samajwadi Party is led by Akhilesh Yadav. "You can see my face every where, can't you?" Ms. Gandhi Vadra replied, sparking speculation that she - who has so far stayed away from

electoral politics, is now ready. When pressed, Ms. Gandhi Vadra, who is leading the Congress' campaign in Uttar Pradesh and is the party's face in all communications, just repeated: "You can see my face, can't you?" There is no confirmation, as yet, about Ms. Gandhi Vadra's poll debut, when asked that question she said: "Nothing has been decided yet, we will let you know when we do." It is important to note Ms. Gandhi Vadra does not have to win an Assembly seat to be Chief Minister. Neither Yogi Adityanath nor Akhilesh Yadav has ever contested a state election although See... ## A Colombian novelist and an untold story, real and magical

In March 1983, Malayalam novelist M Mukundan spotted a man on a rickshaw in Chandni Chowk who he thought was the Colombian writer, Gabriel Garcia Marquez. Marquez and his One Hundred Years of Solitude had become quite the rage among serious fiction readers by then. Mukundan almost called out to Gabo, but didn't, and walked away thinking that the previous year's Nobel winner was unlikely to be in Delhi in spring. The next morning's papers, however, reported that Marquez was in town, accompanying his friend and Cuban President, Fidel Castro, to the Non-Aligned (NAM) summit in Delhi. Indra Gandhi, the then prime minister, had asked Castro, who she met in Moscow some months before that, that he must bring Marquez when he visited India next. The story goes that the first thing Mrs Gandhi, who was at the airport to receive her "brother", Castro, asked his entourage was about Marquez, who had yet to disembark. Marquez reportedly told a Colombian diplomat that by the third day of the visit he felt as if "Indira had been born in Aracataca", his home town that became the prototype for Macondo of One Hundred Years. All stories about Marquez tend to have a touch of magical realism. In the latest, told by Colombian newspaper El Universal, and confirmed to Associated Press by two relatives of the writer, Marquez had a secret daughter, who he had named Indira, in memory of Mrs Gandhi. Indira Cato, whose mother, writer and journalist Susan Cato, had worked with Marquez on two movie scripts, lives in Mexico City and works as a documentary filmmaker. Apparently, Marquez's immediate family knew about Indira but kept it a secret out of respect for Mercedes Barcha, his wife, who died in 2020. Mrs Gandhi was assassinated the year after Marquez met her in Delhi. Though he had seen a fair amount of violence and written about it, Marquez was reportedly so disturbed about her violent death that he vowed never to visit India again. To the disappointment of thousands of his Indian admirers, he kept that promise.

that will change now, with Adityan standing from his bastion of Gorakhpur and Mr Yadav from the Karhal seat in central UP's Mainpuri, which elected his father, Mulayam Singh Yadav, to the Lok Sabha. Yet both became chief ministers and were later elected to the state's Legislative Council. Such an option remains open for Ms Gandhi Vadra, who also battled away fantasising questions about a post-poll alliance to ensure the BJP does not retain power in Uttar Pradesh. "If such circumstances arise we would be open to considering that if such a situation arises, we would want agenda

-for women and youth-to be fulfilled in any such dispensation," she said. In 2017 the Congress and the Samajwadi Party joined forces but the alliance tanked; the Congress won just seven seats and the SP 47 (down from the 224 it won in 2012). The Congress contested 105 seats and the SP hit back to elect Mr Yadav, who told NDTV he would not ally with his time. For its part, the Congress too has seemed set, so far, against an alliance with the Samajwadi Party. Back in 2019, ahead of the Lok Sabha election, Ms Gandhi Vadra told reporters she was ready to contest "if (my) party wants (me

to)". That was when she had been appointed as the party's in-charge for eastern Uttar Pradesh, leading to buzz she could contest from Rae Bareilly. But her reply to a follow-up was striking: "why not" she said when asked if she wanted to contest. That was the first time Ms Gandhi Vadra indicated she was open to fighting an election. UP votes in a seven-phase poll that begins February 10, with results due on March 10. The Congress and the Samajwadi Party are the ruling BJP's biggest challengers, although the latter is more widely seen as the only one seen as a serious threat to Yogi Adityan's government.

110 passengers (1 foreign traveller) and the reports are awaited. During RAT conducted on 33 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferraguri, one positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 33 passengers, one positive case has been

detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 2 passengers were tested with RAT and no positive case has been detected. At Helipad, 1 passenger was tested with RAT and was found negative. Till 3 pm, 142 eligible persons were vaccinated out of which 51 were in the age group of 18 years and above.

## Amar Jawan Jyoti To Be Put Out, "Merged" With War Memorial Torch



After burning for 50 years, the eternal flame of Amar Jawan Jyoti at the India Gate lawns will be extinguished forever. The torch will now be merged with the National War Memorial's torch at a programme today, days ahead of the Republic Day. The ceremony - scheduled to begin at 3.30 pm -

will be presided over by the Integrated Defence Staff chief, Air Marshal Balabhadra Radha Kishna, officials said. Sources said the decision was taken after it was found that the upkeep of two flames is becoming increasingly difficult. It has also been argued that since the National War Memorial has already been built for the martyrs of the country, why a separate flame should be lit at the India Gate, army sources said. The National War Memorial, army sources said, also has the names of the martyrs that are inscribed on the India Gate. The National War Memorial also has the names of all the Indian defence personnel who have lost their lives in different operations - from the 1947-48 war with Pakistan to the clash with Chinese troops at Galwan valley. The names of troops who lost lives in the counter-terrorist operations are also included on the walls of the memorial. The National War Memorial - built over 40 acres at a cost of ₹ 176 crore - was inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on February 2019. All military ceremonial events that took place at the India Gate were shifted here after the inauguration. At the War Memorial, the eternal flame is positioned below the central 15.5 m obelisk. There are four concentric circles - the "Amar Chakra", "Veera Chakra", "Tyag Chakra" and the "Rakshak Chakra", where the names of 25,942 soldiers are inscribed on granite tablets in golden letters. The memorial also includes six bronze murals depicting the famous battles fought by the Indian Army, Air Force and the Navy in a covered gallery in the Veera Chakra. The India Gate was built by the British government in the memory of the soldiers of the British Indian Army who died in the First World War between 1914 and 1921. In 1972, the Amar Jawan Jyoti was lit in memory of the Indian soldiers who died in the 1971 war with Pakistan.

## Delhi Government To Deploy 1500 E-Buses Under Delhi Transport Corporation

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Monday flagged off first e-bus of DTC being procured separately, and added that 300 more such buses will join the city's public transport system by April.

## MP requests CS to provide ship for Car Nicobar on priority

Port Blair, Jan 21: The Member of Parliament of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma has requested the Chief Secretary of Andaman and Nicobar Administration to provide a ship for the Car Nicobar Island as soon as possible, so that these stranded tribal people at Port Blair can reach Car Nicobar and other people who are stranded at Car Nicobar can return back to Port Blair. In a letter addressed to the Chief Secretary the Member of Parliament today mentioned that a large number of residents of Car Nicobar Island that they are stranded at Port Blair since the last several weeks due to unavailability of ships for Car Nicobar Island. He added that many tribal people from Car Nicobar, had come to Port Blair for various purposes like education, jobs, medical treatment and interview but now they are unable to return back to Car Nicobar Island due to unavailability of ships. The Member of Parliament pointed out that the residents of Car Nicobar Island have to pay a heavy amount for daily boarding and lodging facilities at Port Blair but, many Nicobari families are not financially very sound to afford to pay for boarding and lodging for such a long period. Considering the hardship being faced by the people of Car Nicobar Island, the Member of Parliament requested the Chief Secretary to direct the concerned departments to provide a ship for the Car Nicobar Island as soon as possible.

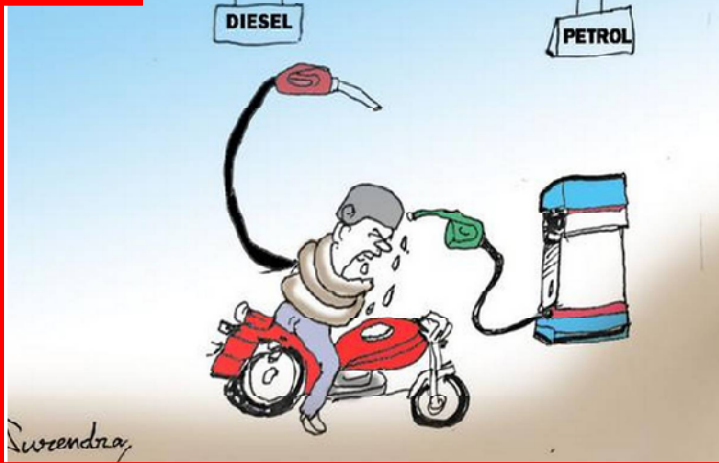

## Second Chargesheet In Lakhimpur Case, Farmers Named For Killing Of BJP Men

Several farmers have been accused of the murder of two BJP workers and the driver of the car that ploughed into a crowd on October 3, killing four farmers and a journalist.

New Delhi: A second chargesheet has been filed in the Lakhimpur Kheri case where an SUV - allegedly driven by the son of a Union Minister - ploughed into a crowd of protesters last year. While the first chargesheet named Ashish Mishra, son of Union Minister Ajay Mishra, over four farmers and a journalist who got run over, the second one involves the violence that followed, in which two BJP workers and the driver of the SUV were beaten to death. Seven farmers were arrested by the police during their investigations in this case, but it is not clear yet if all of them have been charged with murder. The second police case was filed after a complaint by one Sumit Jaiswal, a local BJP worker, against unnamed farmers, accusing them of instigating the violence.



In cellphone videos that were widely circulated, Sumit Jaiswal was seen running from one of the SUVs that hit the farmers. He was later arrested as a co-accused in the case naming Ashish Mishra, the son of Union Minister Ajay Mishra. Ashish Mishra and 12 others have been arrested and they face charges of murder and conspiracy. Earlier this month, the Special Investigation Team probing the Lakhimpur Kheri incident submitted a 5,000-page chargesheet against 14 people to a local court, saying Ashish Mishra was at the spot during the incident. Contrary to what the minister and his son claimed, Ashish Mishra was inside one of the SUVs involved in the attack on protesting farmers and the journalist, the chargesheet has claimed. The Special Investigation Team has bid the court that the killing of the farmers and the journalist was a "planned conspiracy" with intent to commit murder and not a case of death by negligence. With the minister's resignation, the Congress has accused the BJP-led government of protecting him and his son.

Eight people - including four farmers and a journalist - were killed on October 3 at Lakhimpur Kheri during a farmers' protest. An SUV going at a high speed - allegedly driven by Ashish Mishra - had rammed the protesters from behind. Violence broke out soon after, in which three others, two of them BJP workers, were killed.
