

Union Minister of Home Affairs and Minister of Cooperation to chair 29th Meeting of the Southern Zonal Council at Tirupati today

New Delhi, Nov. 13 (PIB)

Union Minister of Home Affairs and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah will chair the 29th meeting of the Southern Zonal Council comprising of the States of Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Kerala, Telangana, and Union Territories of Puducherry, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Lakshadweep, scheduled to be held at Tirupati tomorrow (Nov. 14). Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has stressed on the need to leverage co-operative & competitive federalism to achieve all round growth. Zonal Councils provide the platform to foster such collaboration through a structured mechanism for dialogue and discussion on continuous basis on the issues affecting two or more States or the Centre and States, in the spirit that strong States make a strong nation.

Union Minister of Home Affairs and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah has given impetus to this vision of cooperative federalism to empower States and promote a better understanding between the Centre



and States in the policy framework. He has emphasised on using the platform of Zonal Council for dispute resolving and promoting cooperative federalism.

The Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh is the Vice Chairman and host. Other Chief Ministers from the States in the Zone along with 2

Ministers each are the Members. Chief Secretaries and senior officers from the State Governments and the Central Government will also attend the meeting.

The Zonal Councils take up issues involving Centre and States and one or many States falling in the Zone. The Zonal Councils, thus, provide a forum for resolving disputes and irritants between Centre and States and among many States in the Zone. The Zonal Councils discuss broad range of issues which include boundary related disputes, security, infrastructure related matters like road, transport, industries, water, and power etc., matters pertaining to forests & environment, housing, education, food security, tourism and transport etc.

Five Zonal Councils were set up in the year 1957 under Section 15-22 of the States Re-organization Act, 1956. Hon'ble Union Home Minister is the Chairman of each of these 5 Zonal Councils and Chief Ministers of the host State (to be chosen by rotation every year) is the Vice-Chairman. Two more Ministers from each State are nominated as Members by the Governor.



On the occasion of Children's Day, the 14th November, I extend my warm and best wishes to all the children of the Islands. Children are the most precious resource of our nation who carry the hopes for brighter tomorrow and the dreams of glorious future.

On this day, I also congratulate the teachers and parents for planting the seeds of compassion, humility and leadership in the hearts of children and play important role in moulding them into envoys of change.

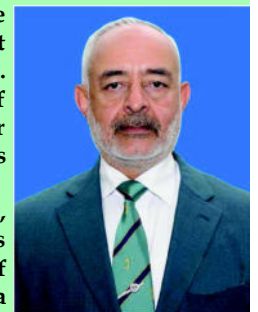

Primary Agriculture Credit Cooperative Societies (PACS) play an important role to cater to the credit needs of rural masses especially farmers in

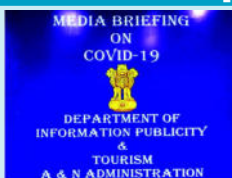

Media briefed on COVID-19

No COVID positive case admitted in GB Pant Hospital

Port Blair, Nov.13

The Director (IP&T), Shri Alok Kumar informing about COVID-19 status today stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 594 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 12 flights with 2057 passengers arrived, out of which, 1590 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 467 passengers and the



reports are awaited. RAT was conducted on 182 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 105 passengers and all were

found negative. At helipad, RAT was conducted on 3 passengers and all were found negative. Today, till 3 pm, 438 beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 401 were in the age group of 18-44.

The Director, ANIMS, Dr. AK Mandal informed that GB Pant Hospital is free from COVID patients and the two patients who were admitted have been discharged.

Safety Tips on Monsoon Preparedness (For Cyclone, Heavy Rain, Water Logging, Flash Flood etc.)



- Listen to radio or TV weather reports for warning & advice and be alert.
- Identify safe shelters in your area. These should be cyclone resistant and also find the closest and safe route to reach them.
- All your family members should know the safe routes to nearest shelter/raised pucca buildings.
- Keep your emergency kit and basic food supply, medicines, torch and batteries etc. ready in waterproof bags. Drink preferably boiled water. Keep your food items covered.
- Doors, windows, roof and walls should be strengthened/checked before the cyclone season through retrofitting and repairing. Store adequate food grains and water in safe places.
- If your area is flood-prone, consider suitable flood resistant building materials.
- Do not let children and pregnant woman remain empty stomach.
- Put furniture, clothing and valuable items etc. on a higher platform so that they can be shifted safely/easily.
- Do not use electrical appliances, which are in flood water.
- Do not go into water of unknown depth and current.
- Do not allow children to play in, or near flood water.
- Do not venture into the sea if so advised. Stay indoors under the strongest part of the house/ if not moved to the cyclone shelter.
- Remain indoors until informed that weather has improved.
- In case of cyclone alert, do not go out, till officially advised that it is safe. If evacuated, wait till advised to go back. Use the recommended route to return to your home. Do not rush/panic.
- Be careful of broken/uncovered power lines, damaged roads and houses, fallen trees etc.
- Be careful of snakes, as snake bites are common during floods.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check weather forecast before outdoor activities. • Keep ready an Emergency survival kit with important medication, dry foods etc. • Postpone outdoor activities and stay inside for at least 30 minutes after you last hear thunder or see lightning. • Avoid metal structures and get off elevated areas such as hills, mountains ridges or peaks. • If you are caught in an open area, act quickly to remove yourself from danger. • Got out of and away from ponds, lakes, and other water bodies. • If you are in open place, sit down by closing your ears properly with joint feet. • Rubber soled shoes and car tyres do not offer protection from lightning. • Keep away from all utility lines and objects that conduct electricity (telephone, power, metal fences, overhead wires, etc. tree and hilltops). • Unplug any all electrical/electronic equipment/appliances such as TV, computer, fans etc. and turn off Air Conditioner well before the storm arrives. • Use battery operated radio for news updates. • Find a house, building or a car with a solid roof. • Stay away from broken power lines and report them immediately. • Help people who may require special assistance such as infants, children, women and elderly. • Provide immediate medical treatment if someone near you have been struck. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not go outside during adverse weather especially for working in agriculture field, grazing cattle, fishing and plying boats. • Do not take shelter under electric or telephone poles or trees. • Do not use metallic items and stay away from bikes. • Never use mobile phones during lightning. • Do not use umbrellas with iron rods. • If you are in forest area, take shelter under small and dwarf trees. • Do not lie on concert/marble floors and do not lean against concert walls. • Avoid contact with electrical equipment or cords. • Avoid shower, take a bath, wash dishes or use any other water source. • Do not swim or be close to water bodies. • Do not go under or near tall trees. • Don't lie on the ground.

- In case of cyclone alert, do not go out, till officially advised that it is safe. If evacuated, wait till advised to go back. Use the recommended route to return to your home. Do not rush.
- Be careful of broken powers lines, damaged roads and house, fallen trees etc.
- Be careful of snakes, as snake bites are common during floods.

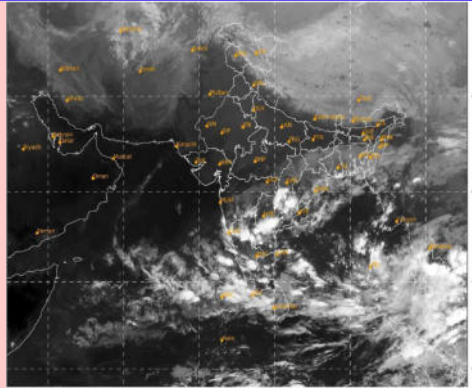
Heavy rain with thunderstorm & lightning likely to occur in Isles on Nov. 14 & 15

Fishermen advised not to venture into sea on both days

Heavy to very heavy rain (7-20 cm) with thunderstorm & lightning and gusty wind (speed reaching 30-40 kmph) is likely to occur at one or two places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands on Nov. 14. Heavy to very heavy rain (7-20 cm) with thunderstorm with lightning and gusty wind (speed reaching 40-50 kmph) is also likely to occur at one or two places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands on Nov. 15.

Due to the formation of a low pressure area over south Andaman Sea and adjoining Thailand Coast and its likely intensification,



fishermen have been advised not to venture into the South Andaman Sea and adjoining South East Bay of Bengal on Nov. 14 & 15.

T-20 World Cup: Australia to lock horns with New Zealand in summit clash today

Dubai, Nov. 13

The final of ICC Men's T-20 World Cup cricket will see the Trans-Tasman rivalry as Australia and New Zealand will battle it out in the summit clash tomorrow at the Dubai International Stadium. The match will begin at 7.30 pm.

Interestingly, neither of the two teams stepped into the tournament as favourites. However, they played some quality cricket and made a place in the finals.

Speaking of New Zealand's campaign, they didn't start off well and suffered a five-wicket defeat against Pakistan in the opening match. However, the Kiwis bounced back and comprehensively won their remaining games in the league



stage with some sensational batting. They met the mighty England side in the semi-finals and beat England by five wickets in the first Semi-Final at Abu Dhabi.

However, New Zealand will be without Wicketkeeper Devon Conway who broke his hand after punching his bat in frustration during the semi-final. Wicketkeeper Tim Seifert is the most likely candidate to replace him, although they could select allrounder Mark Chapman and use

Glenn Phillips behind the stumps.

As far as Australia are concerned, they also performed exceptionally well in the league stage besides an eight-wicket defeat against arch-rivals England. They met Pakistan in the semi-final and some quality cricket was on display. David Warner, Marcus Stoinis, and Matthew Wade particularly played delightful shots and took Aussies to a five-wicket win. The Australian team will likely go unchanged.

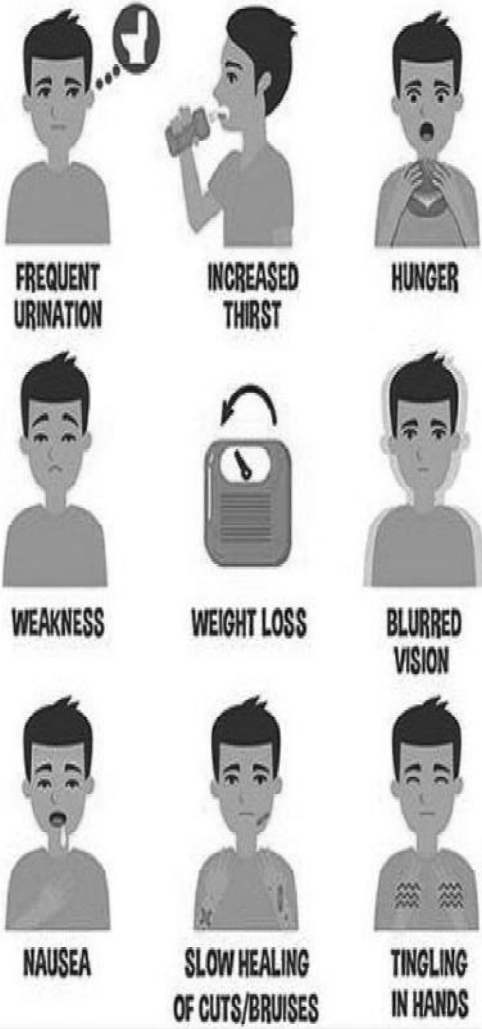

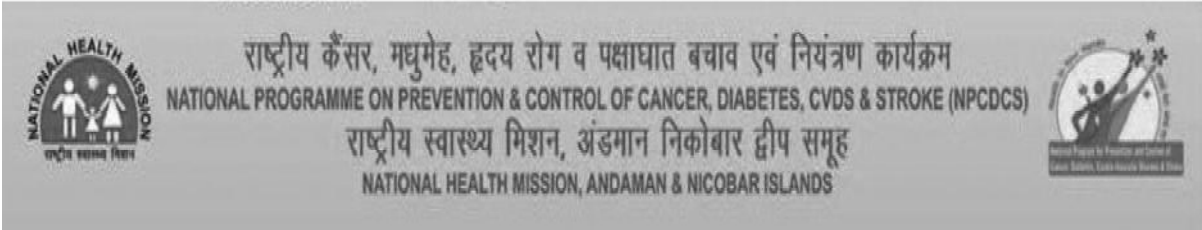


