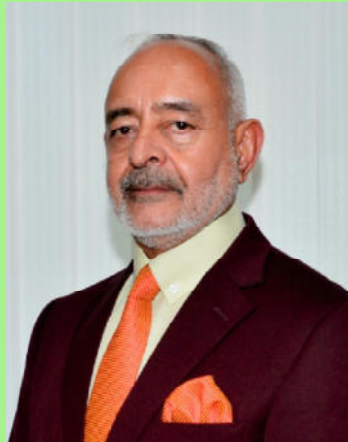
MESSAGE

This is India's second medal in

a track and field event at Hangzhou.

India received its first Gold in track and field athletics as Avinash Mukund Sable made the country proud by winning the Gold medal in men's 3000m steeplechase. Sable also set a new world record with a timing of 8:19:50s. Others who achieved the top honors for India today were ace shooter Kynan Darius Chenai and boxer, Nikhat Zareen.

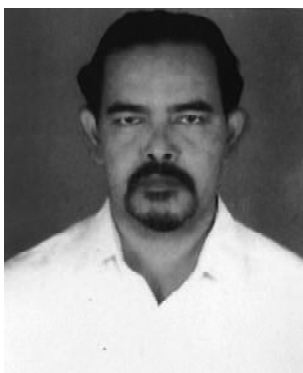
