deterioration and promote recovery.

The aim is to train all the residents of Rangat Sub Division, so that people are aware of basic life saving methods and during emergency, they can save life of an individual before the ambulance and trained medical personnel arrives. As part of this, the doctors of CHC Rangat imparted trainings to ASHA and Anganwadi Workers. This is a cascade model training wherein the person who got the training shall in turn impart BLS Training to other people.

Villagers of Rangat Tehsil like Sabari, Ullapara, Sitapur, Janakpur, Dasharathpur, Urmilapur, GSSS Sabari, GSSS Rangat, APWD Office were imparted training under Swasthya Doot campaign. ASHA and Anganwadi workers are also carrying this campaign forward and further imparting training to the villagers residing in remote areas.


