## Prime Minister visits Odisha and reviews rescue and relief efforts after the tragic train accident

### Government stands with the bereaved family members who have lost their loved ones: PM

### No stone will be left unturned to provide all possible medical help to those injured



New Delhi/Balalore, June 3 (PIB)

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi visited Odisha and reviewed the rescue and relief efforts underway after the tragic train accident in Balalore. Prime Minister visited the railway accident site and the hospital

where the injured are undertaking treatment. Prime Minister said that people from various States who were travelling in the trains have been impacted by this monumental tragedy. While talking about the tragic loss of lives, Prime Minister said

that no stone will be left unturned to provide all possible medical help to those injured. He said that the Government stands with the bereaved family members who have lost their loved ones. Prime Minister said that instructions have been given to ensure

proper and speedy investigation of the tragedy, and to take prompt and stringent action against those found guilty. He commended the efforts of the Odisha Government, Local Administration and of the local people, especially youth, who worked through the

night to assist ongoing efforts. He also lauded the local citizens who turned up in large numbers for blood donation, to help those injured. He said that Railways is working to provide rescue and relief, as well as to ensure quick restoration of rail tracks. Interacting

with the local authorities, personnel from the disaster relief forces and railways officials, Prime Minister emphasised on 'Whole of Government' approach to mitigate the tragedy. Earlier, in Delhi, Prime Minister chaired a high level

meeting to review the situation in relation to the rail accident. It was attended by Union Home Minister, Shri Amit Shah, Cabinet Secretary, Shri Rajiv Gauba, Principal Secretary to the Prime Minister, Shri P K Mishra, Union Home Secretary, Shri Ajay Kumar Bhalla, NDRF

Chief, Shri S.N. Pradhan and other senior officials. The death toll in the train accident has risen to 261, and around 1000 are feared critically injured. Meanwhile, several special and express trains are being cancelled following the accident. (Source: PIB/india.gov.in)

### MISHTI - a Mangrove initiative to be launched on World Environment Day

### A&N Islands to join the initiative by conducting Mangrove Plantation drive at Kadakachang & Pokkadera

Port Blair, June 3 Mangrove Initiative for Shoreline Habitats & Tangible Incomes (MISHTI), a scheme to facilitate mangrove plantation along India's coastline and on salt pan lands is the innovative initiation of Government of India. This scheme aims at intensive afforestation of Mangroves with the involvement of Local Communities which in turn will improve the socio-economic

condition of the local communities through sustainable livelihood opportunities. Andaman and Nicobar Islands rank third in the area of Mangroves among the States and Union Territories of the country. But, with respect to the density and growth, Andaman and Nicobar Islands have probably the best Mangroves in the country. As per IFSR, 2021, Andaman and Nicobar Islands have

an area of 616 Sq. KM under Mangrove Forest Cover in which 399 Sq. Km are of very dense mangroves which is next to West Bengal in distribution of very dense Mangroves. Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change will be launching MISHTI programme on World Environment Day i.e. 5<sup>th</sup> June, 2023. Mangrove Plantation will be carried out in 75 identified locations in different parts of

Coastal States and Union Territories. Andaman and Nicobar Islands is also joining hands through Mangrove Plantation in two identified locations namely Kadakachang (South Andaman District) and Pokkadera (North and Middle Andaman District) on World Environment Day. ## Health Minister emphasizes need for global collaboration to face challenges and ensure vaccines to all in COVID pandemic like situations

No. 1-10/RD& LSG/2022 – In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India. read with the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/3/60-ANL dated 11<sup>th</sup> April, 1960 and in supersession of all notification issued to this effect, the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'C' post ofDaftary, Peon, Sweeper-Cum-Mali, Messenger-Cum-Rider, Chowkidar, Peon-Cum-Chowkidar and Safaiwala/Sweeper etc. re-designated as“Multi Tasking Staff” vide Order No. 989 dated 02.12.2013 borne in the Directorate of Rural Development and Panchayat, Andaman and Nicobar Administration, namely:-

**1. Short Title and Commencement:**  
(i) These rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration (Group 'C' Post of Multi Tasking Staff in the Rural Development and Panchayat Department)(Recruitment) Rules, 2023.  
(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

**2. Number of Posts, Classification, Pay Matrix Level:**  
The number of posts, classification and Pay Matrix Level attached thereto, shall be as specified in Sl.No. 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to.

**3. The method of Recruitment, Age Limit, Qualification etc.:**  
The method of recruitment to the post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in Sl. No. 5 to 14 of the Schedule aforesaid.

**4. Disqualification:** No person –  
(i) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or  
(ii) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.  
Provided that the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

**5. Power to Relax:**  
Where the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, he may , by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

**6. Saving:-**  
Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes and other specified categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
