humanity, Germany has also invited other democracies such as Argentina, Indonesia, Senegal and South Africa to the G-7 Summit.

During the sessions of the summit, Shri Modi will be exchanging views with the G-7 countries, G-7 partner countries and guest International Organisations on topical issues such as environment, energy, climate, food security, health, counter-terrorism, gender equality and democracy. Shri Modi said, he is looking forward to meeting leaders of some of the participating G-7 and guest countries

on the sidelines of the summit.

Prime Minister said that he is also looking forward to meeting members of the Indian Diaspora from across Europe while in Germany, who are contributing

immensely to their local economies and also enriching India's relations with European countries.

## Production, stocking, distribution, sale & use of single use plastic items to be prohibited from July 1

Port Blair, June 25 The Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change has issued notification G. S. R No.571 (E) dated 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2021 as Plastic Waste Management (Amendment) Rules-2021. As per Rule 4(2) of PWM Rules, 2016 (as amended), the manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of single use plastic (SUP), including polystyrene and expanded polystyrene, commodities shall be prohibited with effect from the 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2022. The prohibited SUPs

are ear buds with [Thermocol] for plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, cups, glasses, cutlery plastic flags, candy sticks, ice cream sticks, polystyrene

## District Administration conducts arial survey to inspect earth cutting at Port Blair & Ferrargunj Tehsil

Permit holders directed to strictly adhere to the terms & conditions mentioned in Permit form

Port Blair, June 25

The District Administration upon the direction of Chief Secretary, Andaman & Nicobar Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain conducted an arial survey recently. The survey was conducted by Shri Hari K a l l i k k a t , Additional District Magistrate, Shri Dilkush Meena, Sub-Divisional Magistrate accompanied by Tehsildars of Port Blair and Ferrargunj Tehsils assisted by Survey and Settlement staff.

The objective of conducting arial survey was to verify



the physical status and technicalities of the sites permitted for extraction and dumping of earth. Various sites of Port Blair and Ferrargunj Tehsil where the earth cutting permissions were granted was inspected through arial survey in which at few places, it was observed that few violations were found

while earth cutting by few permit holders, which is in contradiction to the rules prescribed in the Mines and Minerals Rules.

All the permit holders who have been granted earth cutting permission have been directed to strictly adhere to the terms and conditions mentioned in the Permit in form "A"



issued by the Administration. Any violation of these rules mentioned in the permit will be viewed sternly and stringent action will be initiated against such violators.

The District Administration is committed to curb the violations related to earth cutting permits and shall now henceforth will only

issue permits through online mode so as to achieve transparency and accountability in this matter.

The general public have been requested to inform the District Control Room at 03192-238881/240127 and 1077 in case of any illegal earth cutting, a press release from Deputy Commissioner (SA) said.

Vaccination for pregnant women started at JNRM Vaccination Centre and the first jab of Covidshield vaccine was administered to an expectant mother on July 5, 2021. Since then, the A&N Administration has

taken up the vaccination drive for pregnant women in a vigorous manner and it's still continuing in these Islands.

As per the data received from the

DHS, so far 2,209 pregnant women have been administered the Covishield vaccine in Andaman Nicobar Islands. As per the District wise

## Vaccination drive in A&N Islands

### 13,257 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 years vaccinated so far

Port Blair, June 25

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,83,454 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,583 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 years and 13,257 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 12 to 14 years. The number of

beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 27,177.

A total of 153 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 118 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 6 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years, 11 beneficiaries were in the age group of 15 to 18 yrs, 8 beneficiaries were in

the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 38.

34 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 1 beneficiary was in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 35, a press release from DHS said.

common public purposes, issues related to regularization of land and diversion of land for dwelling purposes.

Issues related to Civil Supply Department, wherein the villagers requested for organizing a camp

for Aadhaar Card registration and Ration Card. The DC (SA) issued direction to the concerned to organize such camp for the benefit of the villagers. Matters and doubts related to old age pension related schemes were raised by the villagers and the Director (SW) addressed their queries.

The villagers requested for improvement in the functioning of the Sub Centre and requested for engagement of an ambulance to mitigate any emergent situation. The Director (Health) assured to examine the issues on priority basis.

The issues related to Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) and improvement on rural roads was also taken up by the local populace and the doubts and clarifications sought by them were discussed by the Director (RD) and assured early and prompt redressal of their grievances. The issue related to the increase in the number of Non A/c buses in the route was also taken up by the local populace for transportation of agriculture produces, in this regard, the DC (SA) issued on the spot direction to the Director (Transport) to look into the matter and do the needful at the earliest. Further, it was requested that the timing of the private buses plying in the route needs to be modified for the benefit of the residents.

The Pradhan, Gram Panchayat, Beodnabad requested to provide atleast one PCR vehicle on round the clock basis to keep a check on law and order situation on the NH stretch connecting Beodnabad to Chidiyatapu.

The DC (SA) giving a patient hearing to all their grievances, assured them of its early disposal. He gave on the spot directions to the Tehsildar and officers of other line Departments to take up the issues concerning them and to dispose them at the earliest.

The applicants who had applied for various e-Tehsil services like, Income Certificate, Local Certificate and Senior Citizen Certificate, OBC, Family Members, Resident Certificates and Smart Islander cards etc., were handed over the same during the programme. Besides this, specific instructions were also issued to the concerned revenue field functionaries in response to various petitions filed by the residents of the village.

wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 micron, stirrers.

As per Rule 4 (1) of PWM rules, 2016 (as amended), carry bag made of virgin or recycled plastic shall not be less than seventy-five (75) microns in thickness with effect from 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2021 and one hundred twenty (120) microns in thickness with effect from 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2022.

Further, as per the A & N Administration vide Notification No.186 dated 05.09.2019, the manufacture, storage, use, import, transportation, distribution and sale of single use plastic items has been banned in A&N Islands viz. PET Bottles-Water & Beverages, including alcohol, <2L (Less than 2 litres), plastic bodied cigarette lighters, sachets (shampoo, conditioners and similar personal care items, mouth-fresheners, pickle/jam/sauces, spices, condiments, etc.), <15 mL (or equivalent in weight) and single-use, plastic bodied use & throw pens.

Similarly, as per the A&N Administration vide Notification No.225 dated 24.09.2019, the use, manufacture and sale of plastic carry bags irrespective of its thickness, size, color and nature is banned in A&N Islands.

All Producers, Stockiest, Retailers, Shopkeepers, E-commerce Companies, Street Vendors, Commercial Establishments (Malls/ Marketplace/ Shopping Centers/ Cinema Houses/ Tourist Locations/ Schools/ Colleges/ Office Complexes/ Hospitals & other Institutions) and general public have been informed to stop production, stocking, distribution, sale and usage of identified SUP items as per the timelines specified in the said MoEF&CC Notification. Further, necessary action is to be taken by the concerned entities to ensure zero inventories of the aforementioned SUP items by June 30, 2022.

Selling as well as display/advertisement of Single Use Plastic (SUP) items on all E-Commerce website is also prohibited with effect by June 30, 2022.

Action, as deemed fit under Environment Protection Act, 1986 including seizure of goods, closure of operations of Industries/ Commercial Establishments and in case of non-compliance of above Environmental Compensation as per the Guidelines issued by Central Pollution Control Board of Rs. 5,000/- per ton shall be levied against the violators of the said Notification, a press release from Andaman & Nicobar Pollution Control Committee said.
