Chief Secretary directs Tourism Department to float EOIs for Tourism activities in Isles

EOIs should be for events and activities like Houseboats, Floating Restaurants & Adventure Sports

Port Blair, April 11

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain directed the Tourism Department to issue Expression of Interests (EOIs) for events and activities related to tourism development.

Interested parties may express their interest to conduct events like music festivals, film festivals etc. and activities like Houseboats, Floating Restaurants, Adventure Sports

(land, air and water) like sea walks, scuba, para sailing, sky diving at existing spots as well as new spots. The entry should be free and transparent, provided all safety measures are in place.

The Chief Secretary mentioned that this is being done to break the monopoly by a few privileged and exorbitant rates being charged currently. Tourism is already

a major source of employment for the Islanders. This EOI is expected to attract private investment in the tourism sector and create new job opportunities for the Islanders. Besides solving above issues, the EOI aims to find out market interest for new activities and events as well as locations to conduct them in the Islands. Tenure of License / Concession will be 3 to 5 yrs for activities and 1

day to 3 month for Events, subject to all compliances. The Chief Secretary stated that the selected vendors will have to pay a certain percentage of revenue to the Government and they will be given preferences so that the monopoly for few is broken and everyone can participate. The EOI for Tourism related events & activities will be a game changer in the development

tourism facilities as it would open up new venues for tourism like sky dining, submersible scooters, bungee jumping etc and new events to enhance tourism engagement and night life in the Islands. The transparent bidding process would allow new activities at fair prices, propelling Andamans to be counted among the most prominent Island destinations in the world.

MP elected to Central Advisory Committee for NCC

No positive case detected during RT-PCR test conducted on incoming flight passengers

Port Blair, April 11

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 251 incoming flight passengers yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 16 flights with 2682 passengers arrived, out of which, 2341 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on

269 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 30 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Helipad, 11 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected. At
