The Directorate of Tribal Welfare, A&N Administration proposes to provide 'Grant of additional scholarship to ST students for pursuing higher studies' under UT Scheme for the academic year 2021-22 to the students belonging to Scheduled Tribe community

notified by the A&N Islands. ST student pursuing graduation, post graduation and post matriculation level non-degree courses for which educational qualification is vocational stream, ITI course, 3 year Diploma Course in Polytechnic etc are eligible to avail the scheme. In order to avail this

opportunity, the applicants have been advised to apply online on the website of the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) at www.scholarships.gov.in. Value of additional scholarship is Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) per month which will be paid to the eligible students through NSP/PFMS.

The additional scholarship shall be payable for ten months in an academic session. It shall be normally admissible to the pass-out students of previous academic session.

The last date for submission of online application for scholarship under the scheme is 30.11.2021.

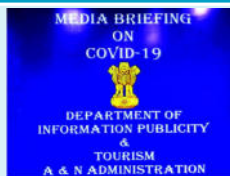
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Media briefed on COVID-19

All samples found negative during test conducted on incoming flight & inter-island bound passengers: Secretary (IP&T)

Port Blair, Sept. 6

The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh briefing media persons on COVID-19 in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening said that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 855 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 4 flights with 686 passengers arrived and the RT-PCR reports are awaited. He further disclosed that RAT was



conducted on 223 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and all were found negative. RAT was also conducted at Phoenix Bay Jetty on 88 ship passengers travelling to Shaheed Dweep and all were found negative. Similarly, 84 passengers

were tested during the return journey and all were negative. At Hope Town, RT-PCR test was conducted on crew members of MV Kalighat and the reports are awaited.

At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, 171 passengers were tested and all the reports were negative. At helipad, 10 passengers were tested and all were negative.

Towards elimination of TB by 2025

District Administration conducting survey in South Andaman District to identify hidden cases of Tuberculosis

Port Blair, Sept. 6

With the objective to eliminate TB by 2025, the Hon'ble Minister of Health and Family Welfare launched a two month long Active Case Finding Campaign and Nikshay Poshan Yojana, Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) Campaign on September 2, 2021. In order to achieve the target of the campaign, the District Administration through District Health Society, South Andaman under National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme, National Health Mission is conducting two month long survey in the entire South Andaman District from Sept. 2 and will continue upto Oct. 29, 2021 to identify the hidden cases of Tuberculosis.



The District Administration is already disbursing the Nikshay Poshan Yojana grant through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode to bank accounts of TB patients and will ensure the target of 100% Nikshay Poshan Yojana

through DBT during the campaign. The ANMs and AHSA workers of respective health facilities will also ensure the survey of their jurisdiction along with various institutions, prison, orphanages, old age homes, construction work sites, auto driver unions and so on in the district.

Shri Suneel Anchipaka, Deputy Commissioner (SA) has urged the general public of South Andaman to cooperate with the field staff during the TB survey and if any, suspected cases found, they may get it tested at the nearest health centres to lend their support to the Administration to eliminate Tuberculosis, a press release from DC (SA) said.

India conquer Oval - their first Test win at the venue since 1971

Beat England by comprehensive margin of 157 runs in fourth Test

London, Sept. 6

India won the fourth Test against England by 157 runs to take a 2-1 lead in the five-match series after the home side collapsed to 210 all out on the final day at Oval today. Set a record 368 to win, England went from 100-0 midway through the first session to getting bowled out 40 minutes after Tea, sparking wild celebrations among India's players and fans inside the south London venue.

Avoiding defeat in the final test at Old Trafford starting on Friday would see India



win a test series in England for just the fourth time, after 1971, 1986, and 2007.

Farmers sensitized on application of biotechnological tools in goat and rural poultry

Port Blair, Sept. 6

The Division of Animal Science, ICAR-Central Island Agricultural Research Institute, Port Blair conducted participatory training for farmers on application of biotechnological tools in goat and rural poultry at Livestock Farm Complex, Garacharmma from August 31 to September 4, 2021. The programme was conducted in commemoration of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav- India@75 and in collaboration with NABARD. A total of 62 farmers including 50 women farmers attended the programme from different villages of South Andaman district viz. New Wandoor, Shoal Bay, Manjery, H a s m a t a b a d, Garacharma and Rangat.

During the inauguration, Dr. D.



Bhattacharya, HoD, Animal Science Division briefed about the occurrence of parasitic diseases in goat and regular deworming. Dr. Jai Sunder, Pr. Scientist & Hub Facilitator, Biotech Kisan Hub described about the multiplier flock concept in goat to establish nucleus breeding farm so as to double their income through sale of superior breeding bucks. Dr. T. Sujatha, demonstrated the preparation of concentrate feed using mini feed mill. During the five days training programme, farmers were given demonstration and hands on training on application of biotechnological tools. Dr. S. K. Zamir Ahmed, Dr. P. A. Bala, Dr. A.K.De, Dr. P.Perumal, Dr.K. Muniswamy and Dr. R. R. Alyethodi delivered talk during the training programme. Genome sequencing, analysis of COVID-19 has progressively increased in country: Govt.

New Delhi, Sept. 6

Union Health Ministry has said that genome sequencing and analysis of the COVID-19 has progressively increased in the country. It said, as many States started witnessing rising trends of COVID-19, the sequencing was enhanced.

The Ministry said, when many States like Maharashtra, Punjab and Delhi started showing rising trends in

the month of February this year, the sequencing was enhanced in four districts of Vidharbha, 10 districts of Maharashtra and 10 districts of Punjab. It said, initial part sequencing aimed at detecting Variants of Concern among incoming international travellers. States have been repeatedly advised to send adequate number of samples for

sequencing. The clarification came in the wake of allegation made in some media report that genome sequencing and analysis of the COVID-19 declined sharply in the country even as cases of the disease continued to rise. The report further claims that the country sequenced very low number of samples till date. (Source: india.gov.in)
