Three positive cases have been detected today in A&N Islands, of which, 2 were from incoming flight passengers who arrived here yesterday. Today, 9 flights with 1378 passengers arrived, out of which, 894 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR

test was conducted on 110 passengers and the reports are awaited. During RAT conducted on 17 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 21 passengers were

following directions maintaining the dignity of the National Flag of India:

- Whenever the National Flag is displayed, it should occupy the position of Honour and should be distinctly placed.
- A damaged or dishevelled Flag shall not be displayed.
- The Flag should not be flown from a single masthead simultaneously with any other flag or flags.
- Where the Flag is displayed in open or displayed on the house of a member of public, it may be flown day and night.

Regarding disposal of the Flag, the Secretary informed that if the National Flag is damaged, it shall be destroyed as a whole in private, preferably by burning or any other method considering the dignity of the National Flag. Also, the National Flag, if made of paper, the Flags should not be discarded on the ground. These Flags should also be discarded in private, keeping in mind the dignity of the National Flag.

He also informed that more details are available on Ministry of Home Affairs' website www.mha.gov.in under the Prevention of Insults to National Honour Act, 1971 and the Flag Code of India, 2002 and may be referred if required. He further urged elected PRI members to make this campaign as janbhagidari with massive people participation, a press release from DC (SA) said.
