

India crosses 100 cr COVID vaccine dose landmark, PM Modi says "history scripted"

New Delhi, Oct. 21

India has scripted history, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi said today as the cumulative COVID-19 vaccine doses administered in the country surpassed the 100 crore milestone. The Prime Minister called the vaccination milestone a triumph of Indian science, enterprise and collective spirits of 130 crore

Indians. India's build-up to achieve this historic feat has been monumental and momentous. This is being considered the biggest contribution to the fight against the virus and an even bigger tribute to all the frontline workers, who have worked 24x7 to ensure a smooth and safe process. Under the world's largest vaccination drive, as India

touched the billion vaccination mark, close to 300 million people are fully vaccinated. The double vaccination coverage is more than the entire population of Indonesia, Pakistan or Brazil, the most populous countries in the world after China, India and the United States. In fact, it is close to the entire population of the US as well.

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Jitendra Narain along with Secretary (Education), Dr. Angel Bhati Chauhan, Deputy Commissioner (SA), Shri Suneel Anchipaka and Director (Education), Shri Kamlesh Kumar visited the Govt. Boys Sr. Sec. School, Middle Point in the morning before the commencement of first period classes and interacted with students and teachers.

During the visit, the Chief Secretary noticed that a lot of teachers and some students were coming late to the school and he advised them that in post corona time, schools must be attended on time. While teachers were thanked for their contributions and praised for their work, it was also

made clear that attendance should be on time in this very important task of nation building. The Chief Secretary also discussed about text books and other issues and necessary directions were given on the spot. To promote 'Save the seeds, Plant Trees campaign', the Chief Secretary also encouraged the teachers to get seeds from Agriculture Department and carry out plantation of vegetables and fruit bearing trees in and around the vacant spaces of the school campus. The Chief Secretary also desired that vegetables and

fruits should be grown in sufficient quantity and it must be shared with the students. Further, he directed that there should be School Head for each school and multiple charges needs to be reduced.

The Chief Secretary also directed that keeping COVID protocols in mind, school timings may be extended to catch up with the syllabus, especially for students of classes IX, X, XI & XII so that students may get sufficient time to recover the loss of instructional hours. He also gave necessary

instructions on issuance of uniforms. He also directed that restoration of mid day meals should start in relevant classes besides timely distribution of text books to students. The Chief Secretary also inspected the school campus and issued instructions for proper upkeep of the school campus and to carry out repair works, wherever necessary.

While interacting with the students, the Chief Secretary enquired about their studies and availability of text books and other

facilities like stationery and uniform grants and quality of mid day meals. He also personally interacted with most of the teachers and asked about their subjects of teaching and preparedness of the students for forthcoming examinations and the impact of lockdown on academic progress of students. He also mentioned that these Islands have one of the highest teachers per capita in the country and emphasized that teachers should be more devoted to their work.

The team pointed out the scope to increase screening, identification, treatment & follow up of the TB patients, establishing Cough Corners in all public health facilities and training services providers.



Kawaladhari Yadav, ex-PC who lost their lives during the year were read out by DGP, during the mention of Police personnel who sacrificed their lives during the


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State level programme to mark achievement of 100 crore COVID vaccination doses in the country held

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Facilitating passengers commuting by ship Tickets for Shaheed & Swaraj Dweep, Mayabunder & Diglipur to be issued two days in advance

Port Blair, Oct. 21

To facilitate the commuters of Shaheed Dweep, Swaraj Dweep, Mayabunder & Diglipur, the Directorate of Shipping Services in consultation with District Administration has decided to introduce ship ticketing two days in advance. In this connection, the commuters who intend to travel to the above destinations by availing DSS vessels may purchase their tickets from STARS Ticketing Counter, Phoenix Bay and thereafter get their COVID Test done and endorsed on the ticket at COVID Testing Center, Nagar Palika Vidyalaya (near Netaji Stadium). Those




passengers who have vaccinated with both doses of COVID-19 vaccine and are in possession of the final vaccinated certificate are also required to get verified/endorsed their tickets from COVID Testing Center, Nagar Palika Vidyalaya (near Netaji Stadium).

Advance ticketing will be done two days prior to the scheduled departure of the vessel from STARS Ticketing Counter, Phoenix Bay between 0900 hrs to 1200 hrs. Further, it is to inform that, entry to port and boarding will be allowed only to those passengers having endorsement on the tickets by the approving/endorsing

authority at COVID Testing Center, Nagar Palika Vidyalaya (near Netaji Stadium). Passengers should report to the Harbour 2 hours prior to departure, as the port gate will be closed half an hour before scheduled departure.

This advance ticketing is extended only to those passengers whose destinations are North and Middle Andaman, Swaraj Dweep and Shaheed Dweep where RAT is mandatory. The present arrangement of RTPCR tests required in respect of vessels scheduled to Little Andaman and Southern Group of Islands will continue as in force, a press release from DSS said.


At its peak, the country administered 25 million doses in a day making a world record.

This is equivalent to the entire population of Australia. Over the past month, the vaccination has averaged close to seventy lakh doses every day. Again, this rate suggests that a country with a population of 25 million would receive their first doses within three to four days, and be fully vaccinated within a few months. Media briefed on COVID-19 RT-PCR/RAT conducted on incoming flight & inter island bound passengers shows zero positive case: Secretary (IP&T)

Port Blair, Oct. 21

The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh addressing a media briefing on COVID-19 held in the conference hall of IP&T today stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 490 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 8 flights with 1357 passengers arrived, out of which 808 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on remaining 549 passengers and the reports are awaited. RAT was conducted on 221



passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and no positive case has been detected. Similarly, RAT test was conducted on 106 passengers at Phoenix Bay Jetty bound for Swaraj/Shaheed Dweep and all were found negative. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 143 passengers and all were

found negative.

The Secretary further said that the vaccination drive is being conducted in Isles smoothly and till 3 pm today, 342 beneficiaries have been vaccinated out of which, 320 were in the age group of 18-44.

The Director, ANIMS, Dr. AK Mandal informed that two COVID patients are undergoing treatment at GB Pant Hospital and no patient is on oxygen/ventilator. The Deputy Director, GB Pant Hospital, Dr. Amitabha De informed that no COVID patients are there in COVID Care Centres.

Vaccination- shield against the virus 4,74,149 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries in Isles

Port Blair, Oct. 21

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 4,74,149 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2,81,603 (approx.). A total of 3,946 people were

vaccinated today in A&N Islands. 1560 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 105 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 2160 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 18

beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 226 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 1 beneficiary was in the age group of 18-44. A total of 1,72,125 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.

Cabinet approves 3% Dearness Allowance hike for Central Government employees

New Delhi, Oct. 21

The Union Cabinet today has approved to release an additional installment of Dearness Allowance to Central Government employees and Dearness Relief (DR) to pensioners w.e.f. 1.7.2021 representing an increase of 3% over the existing rate of 28% of the Basic Pay / Pension, to compensate for price rise.

This increase is in accordance with the accepted formula, which is based on the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission. The combined impact on the exchequer on account of both Dearness Allowance and Dearness Relief would be Rs.9,488.70 crore per annum. This will benefit about 47.14 lakh Central Government employees and 68.62 lakh pensioners.

No.....F.No.1-67/2019-D-IV-I.-- In exercise of powers conferred by Proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, Notification No. U-14038/2/83-ANL dated 21.02.1985, and in concurrence of the UPSC as communicated vide Letter F.No. 3/30(01)/2021-RR dated 13.04.2021, the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, hereby makes the following Rules regulating to the method of recruitment to the **Group 'A' (Gazetted, Non- Ministerial) post of Assistant Professor (English, Mathematics, Computer Science and Foundation Course), borne in the establishment of Principal, Tagore Govt. College of Education, Port Blair** under the Andaman and Nicobar Administration, namely:-
1. Short title and commencements:
(i) These rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration, (Assistant Professor in Tagore Government College of Education, Port Blair), Recruitment Rules, 2021.
(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazettee.
2. Application:
These Rules shall be applicable for Recruitment to the post as mentioned in the schedule annexed hereto.
3. Number of Posts, Classification and Scale of Pay:-
The number of the said post, its classification and the Pay Level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in Paras 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
4. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc.:-
The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in Paras 5 to 13 of the Schedule I to IV annexed to these rules.
5. Disqualification :-
No person--
(i)Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person having a spouse living or ;
(ii) Who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:
Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under any personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of these rules.
6. Power to relax :-
Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of the opinion that, it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of person.
7. Saving :-
Nothing in these rules shall effect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other specific categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
