The Govt. of India will be launching the Nationwide COVID-19 vaccination for the age group of 12-13 years and 13-14 years i.e. born in 2008, 2009 and 2010 (attained above 12 years of age) from March 16 onwards. The beneficiaries will be administered Corbevax COVID-19 vaccine.

Details of TV channels whose permission cancelled for violation of guidelines released in Broadcast Seva Portal: Govt.

New Delhi, Mar. 15

The Government today informed the Lok Sabha that the details of Channels whose permission has been cancelled for violation of the guidelines has been released in the Broadcast Seva Portal of the Information and Broadcasting Ministry. Informing this in the Lok Sabha today, Union Minister for Information and Broadcasting, Shri Anurag Thakur said

that all TV Channels are required to adhere to the Programme Code and the Advertising Code laid down under the Cable Television Networks Regulation Act. He explained that the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology is empowered to issue directions for blocking of content for violation of Section 69 A of the Information Technology Act. The

Minister added that 25 thousand 368 URLs, consisting of Web pages, websites, and pages on social media accounts have been blocked for violation.

He also added that the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting has issued directions for blocking of 56 YouTube based news channels and their social media accounts for public access during 2021-2022. (Source: india.gov.in)

Currently placed third after a morale-boosting 155-run against the West Indies, India would like to keep the winning momentum going and maintain



their stay in the top four especially when they take on table toppers Australia after England.

After an inexplicably slow performance against New Zealand when the Indian batters played out 162 dot balls Smriti

Mandhana (123 off 119) and Harmanpreet Kaur (109 off 107) produce a splendid batting display, slamming twin centuries against the West Indies to power India to their highest total (317/8) in the history of the event.

India administers over 180.40 crore vaccine doses

New Delhi, Mar. 15

Over 180 crore 40 lakh vaccine doses have been administered so far under Nationwide Vaccination Drive. Health Ministry said, over 19 lakh 64 thousand doses were administered yesterday. The

recovery rate is currently at 98.72 percent. Over four thousand people recovered in the last 24 hours. Total Recoveries have reached 4 crore 24 lakh 46 thousand 171. Over two thousand new cases were recorded in the last 24 hours.

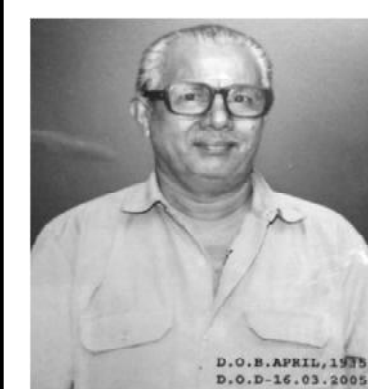
