On the first day of the session, Farm Laws Repeal Bill 2021 has been listed for introduction and passing in the Lok Sabha. The Bill will repeal the Farmers (Empowerment and Protection) Agreement on Price Assurance and Farm Services Act, 2020, the

Trade and Commerce (Promotion and Facilitation) Act, 2020, the Essential Commodities (Amendment) Act, 2020 and to amend the Essential Commodities Act, 1955.

On the eve of the Winter Session of Parliament, a meeting of the Government all parties was held in New Delhi to ensure the smooth functioning of both Houses of Parliament.

detected. Today, 11 flights with 1927 passengers arrived, out of which, 1508 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 419 passengers and the reports are awaited. During RAT conducted on 160 passengers bound for

North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 67 passengers and all were found negative. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 9 passengers were

Port Blair, Nov. 28 Thunderstorm, lightning with gusty wind (speed 30-40 kmph) is likely to occur at one or two places over A&N Islands on Nov. 29. On Nov. 30, heavy rain (07-11 cm) and thunderstorm, lightning with gusty wind (speed 30-40 kmph) is also likely to occur at one or two places over A&N Islands. Similarly, on Dec. 1 heavy to very heavy rain (07-20 cm) with

thundersquall (wind speed 50-60 kmph) is likely to occur at one or two places over A&N Islands. Meanwhile, in anticipation of a low pressure area over South Andaman Sea around 30th November, 2021, wind speed is likely to exceed 45 Kmph over Andaman Sea & neighbourhood. Fishermen have been advised not to venture into the sea from 29th November
