The scheme is implemented by Department of Financial Services (DFS), Ministry of Finance, Government of India. Stand-Up India Scheme facilitates bank loans between Rs. 10 lakh and Rs. 1 Crore to at least one Scheduled Caste (SC) or Scheduled Tribe (ST) borrower and at least one woman borrower per bank branch for setting up a greenfield enterprise. DoT launches DCIS Scheme for providing ...

recognized by Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India, working towards innovation, development or improvement of products or processes or services, or if it is a scalable business model with a high potential of employment generation or wealth creation. Any Indian company incorporated under the Companies Act 1956/2013, primarily a Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) as defined in the MSME Act, 2006 having over 51% stakes by the Indian Citizen/NRI/OCI and Head Quarter in India.

Individual Innovators will also be encouraged to apply (research & academic institutions can use this category to apply). However, release of funds shall be subjected to compliance of eligibility conditions for either Startup or MSME before agreement signing. More than one organization can jointly submit the application in partnership with consortium, registered societies & Academia. Collaboration with Academia / R&D Organization is highly encouraged.

Under the scheme, financial support will be provided to those projects/ideas who have reached at least 'Proof of Concept (PoC)' level. Financial support will be provided to the beneficiary in the form of grants. Extent of Milestone based Grant in Aid from Proofof-Concept stage for Startup: upto Rs. 50 Lakhs, MSMEs: upto Rs. 2 Crore, Consortium: upto Rs. 10 Crore.

The last date for applying under the Scheme is May 18, 2022 and direct link for application form is dcis.dot.gov.in/registration.aspx and the website is dcis.dot.gov.in, a press release from Directorate of Industries said.

Composite loan (inclusive of term loan and working capital) between 10 lakh and upto 100 lakh is provided for setting up a new enterprise in manufacturing, trading or services sector by SC/ST/Women entrepreneur. The loan is repayable in 7 years with a maximum moratorium period of 18 months. The scheme, which covers all branches of Scheduled Commercial Banks is accessible either directly at the branch or through Stand-Up India portal www.standupmitra.in or through the Lead District Manager (LDM).


