Port Blair, April 23

24th of April is celebrated all over the country as National Panchayati Raj Day (NPRD). It was on this day that the Constitution (73rd Amendment) Act, 1992 came into force across the country has vested constitutional status to Panchayati Raj Institutions. This date thus marks a defining moment in the history of decentralization of

political power to the grassroot level. National Panchayati Raj Day is celebrated every year to thrust on the essence of Local Self Governance. Panchayati Raj is an integral part of the Indian Legislature, and is considered to be the third tier Government in the rural areas.

The National Programme commemorating the historic day is organized

by the Ministry of Panchayati Raj, Govt. of India in Palli Gram Panchayat of Samba district of Jammu and Kashmir. The Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi will be the chief guest and also attend the Special Gram Sabha in the Gram Panchayat. 500 sq. mtrs were restored to its original status. Similar drive was carried out at Bharatpur beach and encroachments in the shape of temporary shed and fencing were removed from land

bearing Sy No. 147 recorded as path.

MV Bharat Seema to sail for Little Andaman on April 26 & 29 DSS issues advisory for passengers

Port Blair, April 23 The Directorate of Shipping Services has announced the sailing programme of MV Bharat Seema for Little Andaman. Accordingly, the vessel will sail for Little Andaman on April 26 at 9 am and will sail back to Port Blair on the same day at 8 pm. Tickets for this voyage will be issued on April 25.

Similarly, the vessel will sail for Little Andaman on April 29 at 9 am and will sail back to Port Blair on the same day at 8 pm. Tickets for the voyage will be issued on April 27.

Further, passengers have been informed that in compliance to the Circular issued by the Deputy Director (Health/ Nodal Officer (COVID-19), the ticketing for Little Andaman will be done on fulfilment of certain conditions viz. passengers who are fully vaccinated (i.e. taken 02 doses) with COVID-19 vaccine are being exempted from RTPCR Test; passengers who are unvaccinated/partially vaccinated/symptomatic passengers above 05 years of age may also purchase their tickets from Stars Ticketing Counters but they have to get their Rapid Antigen Test done before boarding the vessel.

Entry to port and boarding will be allowed only to those passengers having endorsement on the body of the tickets by the approving/ endorsing authority at COVID Testing Center, Phoenix Bay/ Nagar Palika Vidyalaya (near Netaji Stadium). Passengers should report at the Harbour 2 hours prior to departure, as the port gate will be closed half an hour before scheduled departure, a press release from DSS said.

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 11,224 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs vaccinated so far

Port Blair, April 23 The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,71,033 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 17,936.

A total of 1581 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 1024 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 45 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years, 8 beneficiaries were in the age group of 15-18 years, 12 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 443.

515 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 22 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years, 1 beneficiary was in the age group of 15-18 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 129.

42 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 40, a press release from DHS said.

COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Port Blair, April, 23 Eighteen flights with 3055 passengers arrived here today, out of which, 2751 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 216 passengers and the reports are awaited. During RAT conducted on 38 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 29 passengers, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 23 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected. At Helipad, 1 passenger was tested with RAT and was found negative, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.



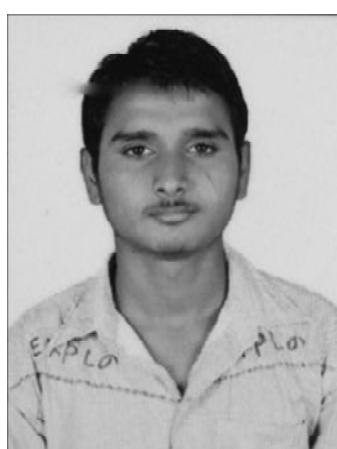

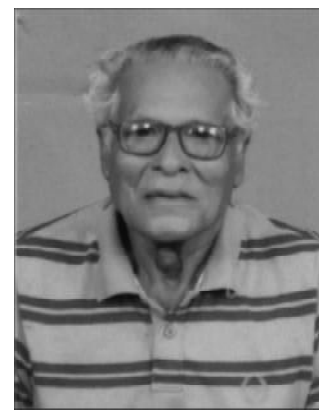
