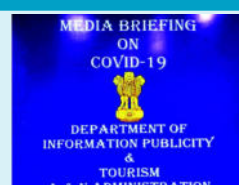

**Media briefed on COVID-19**  
**One positive case detected during RT-PCR test conducted on incoming flight passengers: Secretary (IP&T)**

Port Blair, Sept. 24

The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh briefing media persons on COVID-19 in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening disclosed that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 1003 passengers who arrived here yesterday, one positive case has been detected. Today, 8 flights with 1153



passengers arrived and the RT-PCR test reports are awaited. He further disclosed that RAT was conducted on 281 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj

**AB-PMJAY completes three years**  
**Beneficiary from A&N Islands interacts with Union Health Minister during Arogya Manthan 3.0**  
**Ayushman Bharat Diwas also observed in various health institutions of A&N Islands**

Port Blair, Sept. 24

Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) was launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi on 23.09.2018. The scheme is being implemented in 33 States and Union Territories across the country. AB-PMJAY is the largest state funded health assurance scheme of the world, which covers 50 crore beneficiaries belonging to 10.4 crore poor and vulnerable families. The scheme provides cashless treatment worth Rs. 5 lakhs per family per year for secondary and tertiary care hospitalization to the eligible beneficiaries at more than 23,000 empanelled public and private hospitals across the country. The scheme has recorded more than 2 crore hospital admissions since its implementation in 2018



and PMJAY cards have been issued to 16 crore beneficiaries. In this UT, 37,000 PMJAY cards have been issued to the beneficiaries belonging to 11,200 families and 320 beneficiaries have undergone treatment at empanelled hospitals of mainland under the scheme.

On the occasion of completion of three years of implementation of Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY), a virtual event titled Arogya Manthan 3.0 was held in the Office of National Health Authority at New Delhi, which was chaired by the Hon'ble

Union Minister of Health & Family Welfare, Shri Mansukh Mandaviya. During the event, the Hon'ble Minister interacted with 9 PMJAY beneficiaries from different States

and UTs of the country, which included a beneficiary from Diglipur, North & Middle Andaman. ## Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

### Burma Phal (Garcinia andamanica): an endemic, flavourful fruit of the islands

*Burma phal or Andaman kauphal is an endemic fruit species found distributed mainly in the Little Andaman, Rutland, Baratang and Middle Andaman islands. Trees are of 7 to 8 m height and bear leaves of about a foot long. Fruits are large, attractive, yellow to orange and sour in taste. Burma phal could be easily distinguished from the other similar Garcinia species found in the islands by the typical triangular shape of the mature leaves. The local communities commonly consume them during the fruiting season. Onge tribe uses the trunk of this species for construction of huts.*

*Interestingly, plants of Burma phal flourish well even in the soils with poor to moderate nutrient status and soils with high water table. Studies at ICAR-CIARI suggested that fresh fruits are sources of vitamin A, vitamin C and antioxidants. Further, the peel could be dried and stored for future consumption as an acidulant in culinary preparations. The dried rind possesses aroma akin to raw mango powder (aamchur) and hence, could be utilized for flavouring of dishes. Each fruit contains about five bold seeds, which are rich in unsaturated fatty acids, particularly Oleic acid. Considering the multipurpose uses and endemic nature of Burma phal, it could be popularized as backyard crop in the islands. Home scale processing in the form of dehydrated rind could also serve as a novel source of flavour for the local consumers as well as the tourists.*

*Benefit: Promoting its cultivation and subsequent utilization of Burma phal would not only provide income source to the island farmers but would also contribute in conservation of this endemic heritage of our islands.*

## Vaccination drive in A&N Islands

### 4,33,944 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far

Port Blair, Sept.24

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, 4,33,944 doses of vaccines have been administered to the beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands. Meanwhile, a total of 1938 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. 1399 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 239 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 337 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 35 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 202 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 6 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. A total of 1,69,317 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date.

“The Record of Rights shall be prepared in Form F for each village both urban and non-urban and shall be issued alongwith corresponding map, QR Code capturing village name, survey numbers, total area and name of the tenants.”

(ii) The Form ‘F’ prescribed under Rule 132 of the Principal Rules shall be substituted as appended herewith.

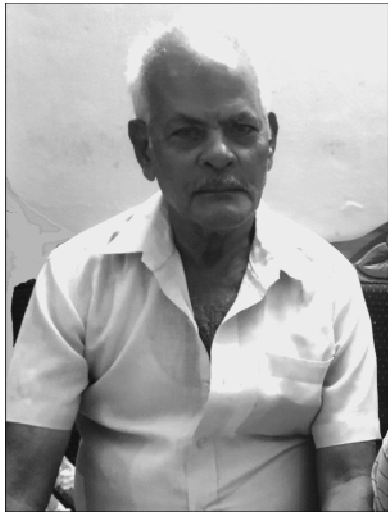
