Officers, Doctors and Nursing Sisters. It is to mention that along with the rest of the State and UTs, three PSA Oxygen Plants for all the three Districts of A&N Islands have also been made operational today.

In order to give further boost to the health infrastructure facilities during the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the Central Government allocated 3 PSA Oxygen Plants for A & N Islands from PM CARES fund. The

civil work for 2000 Litres Per Minute (LPM) plant for GB Pant Hospital was done by NBCC and the Plant was delivered by HITES.

Apart from this, the civil works for the 500 LPM Plant for CHC Diglipur & BJR Hospital, Car Nicobar were carried out by Andaman Public Works Department and the Oxygen Plants were provided by DRDO.

### Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

#### Korangi banana for nutritional security

Banana constitutes a major share in the fruit production of Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Among the varieties being cultivated in the islands, Korangi holds a special place particularly in North and Middle Andaman Islands. Each bunch of this variety contains seven or more hands, each containing about 10 to 14 fruits. The fruits could be easily distinguished from other varieties with their delicious, golden yellow pulp and fibrous, thick peel. Being thick skinned, fruits have good shelf life. In general, banana fruits are not so rich in vitamin A. However, studies at ICAR-CIARI have revealed that its fruits have 12.3 microgram per gram pulp of total carotenoids. In simpler terms, fruits have higher vitamin A content than commercial banana varieties such as Grande Naine. Hence, its fruits will provide additional nutritional benefits to the consumers. Plants come to bearing after 14 to 16 months of planting. Plants grow tall and are amenable for intercropping in both coconut and arecanut gardens. It is suggested to do replanting after taking one main crop and two ratoon crops (subsequent crops from a single mat) to maintain plant vigour and yield of the crop. Removal of male flower after complete opening of female hands is beneficial for improving fruit size.

Benefit: Bringing more area under Korangi cultivation could improve the availability of fruits in local markets, thereby improving the nutritional security of island dwellers.

As the demand increased, India increased the production of medical oxygen by more than 10 times. He added that this was an unimaginable goal for any country in the world, but India has achieved it.

The Prime Minister remarked that it is a matter of pride for every Indian that 93 crore doses of corona vaccine have been administered. Very soon India will cross the 100 crore mark. He said India has shown the way to the whole world by building the Cowin platform that shows how vaccination is done on such a large scale. He said now the Government does not wait for the citizens to come to it with their problems and then take any action. He said that this misconception is being removed from the government mindset and system. Now the Government goes to the citizens.

The Prime Minister noted that till 6-7 years ago, only a few states had the facility of AIIMS, today work is being done to take AIIMS to every state. He said we are moving fast from 6 AIIMS to build a strong network of 22 AIIMS. It is also the goal of the Government that there must be at least one medical college in every district of the country. He recalled that former Prime Minister Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee had fulfilled the dream of the creation of Uttarakhand. Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee believed that connectivity is directly related to development. Due to his inspiration, today work is being done for improving connectivity infrastructure in the country at unprecedented speed and scale, the Prime Minister said.

The Prime Minister said before the launch of the Jal Jeevan Mission in 2019, only 1,30,000 households in Uttarakhand had access to tap water. Today piped drinking water has started reaching more than 7,10,000 houses of Uttarakhand. That is, within just 2 years, about 6 lakh houses in the state have got water connections. The Prime Minister informed that the Government is also working very seriously for the interests of every soldier, every ex-serviceman. He added that it is our Government that fulfilled the 40 years old demand of our brothers from the armed forces by implementing One Rank One Pension.

### MoD proposes to allow girl students to be admitted to Rashtriya Indian Military College & Rashtriya Military Schools

New Delhi, Oct. 7 (PIB)

Following the directive of the Supreme Court, Ministry of Defence (MoD) has proposed to allow girl students to be admitted to Rashtriya Indian Military College (RIMC) and Rashtriya Military Schools (RMS). According to an affidavit filed in the Supreme

Court, there is requirement of authorising additional vacancies along with other associated infrastructure and administrative support. This is proposed to be carried out in two phases.

For entry into RIMC in the first phase, the maximum capacity of students will be increased from 250 to 300 incrementally by inducting five girls for six months. This increase can be affected with some

infrastructure modification and additional staff to support the girl cadets. For this, it is submitted that girls will be allowed to take the RIMC entrance examination scheduled in June 2022 for entry into RIMC for the term starting in January 2023.

Similarly, in Phase-2, the capacity will be increased incrementally from 300 to 350 to induct 10 girls every six months. At the end of this expansion, RIMC will have 250 boys and 100 girls. For this, it is submitted that girls will be allowed to take the RIMC entrance examination scheduled in June 2027 for entry into RIMC for the term starting in January 2028. The RIMC is situated in Dehradun (Uttarakhand). The affidavit points out

the requirement to create girl friendly infrastructure in the school campus to facilitate the living of girls with respect to privacy, safety and security. A Board of officers is examining the issues so that necessary girl friendly infrastructure and support staff is established.

### Vaccination- shield against the virus

### 4,52,904 doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries in Isles so far

Port Blair, Oct. 7

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, 4,52,904 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands. A total of 1911 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. 806 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 125 beneficiaries were in the age group of

18-44 years. Similarly, 705 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 20 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 400 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 5 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. A total of 1,70,811 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.

### MV Kalighat/MV Coral Queen to sail for Swaraj Dweep

In view of the forthcoming festive season, the Directorate of Shipping Services in consultation with District Administration has planned to deploy bigger vessel MV Kalighat/MV Coral Queen to Swaraj Dweep from Oct.8 to 11, 2021. Passenger tickets for Swaraj Dweep will be issued at Haddo Wharf 2 hours prior to the scheduled departure following

latest COVID-19 SOP.

As per the schedule, the vessel MV Kalighat will depart from Haddo Wharf on Oct. 8 at 8 am for Swaraj Dweep and return to Port Blair at 3 pm on the same day. Similarly, MV Coral Queen will depart from Haddo Wharf for Swaraj Dweep on Oct. 9, 10 & 11 at 8 am and return to Port Blair on the same day at 3 pm, a press release from DSS said.

### Heavy rain with thunderstorm likely to occur in Isles

Heavy rain (7- 20 cm) with thunderstorms, lightning is likely to occur at one or two places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands tomorrow (Oct.8). Similarly, on Oct. 9, 10 & 11, heavy rain (7-11 cm) with thunderstorms, lightning and gusty winds (speed reaching 30-40 kmph) is also likely to occur at one or two places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

Meanwhile, in anticipation of formation of Low pressure area, wind

speed is likely to exceed 45 kmph along and off Andaman & Nicobar coast. Fishermen have been advised not to venture into the sea.

patient is on oxygen support. He said, during the RT-PCR test conducted on 797 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 8 flights with 1317 passengers arrived, out of which, 699 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on remaining 618 passengers and the reports are awaited.

The Director further mentioned that RAT was conducted on 249 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and all were found negative. Apart from this, RAT was conducted on 131 passengers travelling to & fro to Shaheed/Swaraj Dweep at Phoenix Bay Jetty during which, one positive case has been detected from Swaraj Dweep on return journey. Similarly, one positive case has been detected during the test conducted on passengers travelling to Hut Bay. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 150 passengers and all were found negative. Apart from this, 10 crew members of MV Makruzz were tested with RT-PCR and the reports are awaited. Till 3 pm, 421 persons were vaccinated today, out of which, 398 were in the age group of 18-44, said the Director. The Deputy Director, GB Pant Hospital, Dr. Amitabha De stated that no COVID patients are there in COVID Care Centres.
