## Indian Journalists Union and ANMF condemn Police Action on DBRAIT Students, urge Administration to take media and the public into confidence

Port Blair, Sept 30: Indian Journalists Union (IJU) joined its offshore affiliate Andaman & Nicobar Media Federation (ANMF) today to condemn brutal attacks on students of Dr B R Ambedkar Institute of Technology, Port Blair.

In a press statement, the Secretary General, IJU said that the students submit-

ted a memorandum to the Andaman & Nicobar administration and met the Vice Chancellor but no action was taken. They are left with nothing so they were protesting two days ago, but they were illegally detained. Water cannons and even tear gas were used upon them to suppress their voices. Many students have

been admitted to the hospital with broken bones, lacerations, abrasion, and more importantly, mental trauma. ANMF and IJU urged the A&N Administration to hold a press conference and by showing public accountability disclose to the public what action they have taken to save the future of the stu-

Henceforth, passengers can purchase their tickets in advance from STARS Ticketing

Counter, Phoenix Bay for the forthcoming ship schedules to Southern Group of Islands.

The date and time of issue of tickets for the particular sailing will be intimated to the passengers through "Seva Suchnayein".

Further, passengers should be suitably vaccinated and get verified/en-

dorsed their tickets from Covid Testing/Verification Centers before boarding the vessel. Similarly, passengers not fully vaccinated has to undergo RTPCR Test. dents' cause and is taking all measures with fullest vigour and force to ensure that genuine interests of the students' are not affected due to any unilateral actions by any authority, especially PU.

Chief Secretary informed the gathering that many vexatious issues of PU with DBRAIT, which had remained unresolved for the past 3 years, were resolved after the consistent interventions, untiring endeavour and vigorous efforts of the ANA with all stakeholders including Pondicherry University, Ministry of Education, GOI and relevant judicial forums. In this context, it was explained that the ANA has successfully resolved the following niggling issues, to the satisfaction of the affected student community at Port Blair -

1) Conduct of university examination for all students of DBRAIT.

2) Issuance of Timetable for exams of Lateral entry students (batch 2020-21 and

2021-22, including pending papers since 2 years).

3) Re-issuance of timetable for exams of Lateral Entry students in a staggered manner. (batch 2020-21 and 2021-22 including pending papers since 2 years).

4) Clarification pertaining to authenticity of MSBTE (Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education) have been issued. MSBTE have re-confirmed the authenticity of the affiliation accorded to Diploma program of DBRAIT.

Further, the Administration has taken up matter with the Pondicherry University for speedy grant of affiliation to DBRAIT (Degree Program) for the year 2022-23. The ANA is also pursuing the PU to allow students, who could not appear for university exam in the past month due to fear of signing the Undertaking, to re-take the examinations. In addition, it was impressed upon the students and other stakeholder representatives that the ANA will continue to pursue and seek resolution of any other issue or perceived grievance of the students with the relevant authorities, and remain open to all inputs and discussion.

The Chief Secretary also assured the students that ANA is committed to act in an impartial and stern manner on any complaint against any individual and the matter would be dealt under the framework of extant laws and rules. However, complaint against any individual cannot be used as a ruse/stratagem to jeopardise the academic career and future of the students and students are requested not to fall prey to vested interests or rumour-mongers. The students are advised that outstanding issues, if any, can only be resolved through dialogue with the Administration and appropriate authorities like PU, within the contours of the law and rules in force. Administration is keen to engage with all stakeholders, including students, and remain available at any time for early resolution of issues.

For this purpose, a

This kind of unruly and disruptive activity brings disrepute and disgrace to the peace-loving and amiable people of ANI and dents its tourist-friendly image. The entire incident is being enquired into. It is emphasised that dialogue and discussion is the only acceptable route for any resolution in a civilised, cultured and peaceful society like ours. ## Bharatiya Janata...

Addressing media persons at the party headquarters today, the BJP State President Mr. Ajay Bairagi said that the issue of DBRAIT has taken a big shape. Students studying engineering have been demonstrating continuously for two months for various demands. He said that the Bharatiya Janata Party is fully aware of the problems of the students.

He said that continuous efforts are being made by the party to solve the problems of the students.

Mr Bairagi said that in this regard, a letter was written on behalf of the party to the country's Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan, Lieutenant Governor and Chief Secretary of A & N Administration.

He said that the party leaders had met the Chief Secretary and appealed to take concrete steps to resolve the issues of the students. In the middle of this month, when the Vice-Chancellor of Pondicherry University had visited Port Blair, party leaders even got the Vice-Chancellor to speak directly to the students over phone. After this, the students had withdrawn the protest.

He said that on September 28, the students once again sat on a dharna without

any prior notice by jamming the wheel. Due to this attitude of the students, tourists, mainland travellers, patients, school going students, job going people had to face a lot of difficulties. He said that when the police forcefully removed the children from there in the night, after that the party leaders visited the hospital to know about the condition of children in the hospital. At the same time, the detained children were released after party leaders spoke to the Superintendent of Police.

He said that the Bharatiya Janata Party is with the legitimate demands of the children. But some people are spreading confusion by making children pawns. Mr Bairagi said that the Bharatiya Janata Party thanks the Chief Secretary for coming forward and intervening in this issue.

Former BJP President Vishal Jolly has said that the issue of DBRAIT is not only about the students there, but it has become a matter of the people of the entire archipelago. There is so much corruption happening in this institution but why has the matter not come to the fore even after passing so many years. Now the matter of this institution has taken a very serious form.

Mr. Jolly said that we need a good quality engineering college for our children. Good quality polytechnic college is required. Good quality management college is needed. We have nothing to do with any person. There should be a CBI inquiry into this whole matter and strict action should be taken against whoever is guilty for this. He said that the Bharatiya Janata Party is very concerned about the DBRAIT issue.

For the welfare of the students, the party is continuously working in the interest of the students. He said that on Thursday, for the interests of the students, a meeting was held in the office of the Chief Secretary with the office bearers of various organizations. All the matters of DBRAIT were discussed in the meeting. He said that the meeting condemned the action taken by the police on the students during the Chakka Jam and demanded a magisterial inquiry into it, to which the Chief Secretary agreed. Apart from this, all the issues on which the students were concerned were discussed, he said. The Chief Secretary has assured that the interests of the children have been taken up on priority basis, he added.

Dhanasekaran, President, RJD along with other leaders attended the meeting while Mr. Paritosh Halder, President, A&N Democratic Congress could not attend the meeting as he was attending another meeting and extended support.

Meeting discussed the issues of DBRAIT and decided to issue a joint press statement condemning the police action on students, to send a letter to Govt of India and to meet the Chief Secretary on 30th September.

Later in a joint press statement the leaders observed that the brutal police action on the students which led to sustaining injury to several students and other health issues was violation of the

Fundamental Rights guaranteed by the Constitution of India to assemble peacefully and without arms and freedom of speech and expression.

All leaders have now demanded that a judicial inquiry may be ordered into the issue in order to fix responsibility on the erring officials who ordered and carried out the inhuman attack on the college students.

The leaders also noted with concern that the students are aggrieved over the non-renewal/withdrawal of the affiliation by the Pondicherry University over the non-fulfillment of the shortcomings pointed out by the University. Instead of fulfilling the conditions put for-

ward by the University for restoration of affiliation, the central government and A & N Administration moved Hon'ble High Court against the Pondicherry University. The leaders mentioned that they believe that the issue can be resolved if the central government intervenes in the matter and takes appropriate steps.

All leaders expressed full support for the DBRAIT students who are on agitation during the last few weeks. They called upon the central government to intervene in the issue and take all necessary steps to resolve the issues. The Meeting also decided to take up other public issues jointly in the coming days.
