and IT industry in A&N Islands constituency which has an advantage due to its strategic location and proximity to Southeast Asian countries. In FY2022, the top three Indian IT companies, TCS, Wipro and Infosys, are expected to offer 1.05 lakh job opportunities, due to the increasing demand for talent and skill. India's IT and business services market is projected to reach USD 19.93 billion by 2025. IT spending in India is estimated to reach USD 98.5 billion in 2022. Keeping these upcoming opportunities in mind, the setting up of the IT industry in the Islands will lead to job opportunities for the youth of the Islands and will also lead to the economic development of A&N Islands Parliamentary constituency.

Shipping: The MP pointed out that the Andaman and Nicobar Islands have a unique topography and living system which cannot be seen anywhere else in the country in such dimensions. Shipping is the lifeline of the Islands and Shipping based industries can flourish in the state. He requested the Minister to promote investment in the shipping sector in Andaman & Nicobar Islands. Shri Kuldeep Rai Sharma also demanded for Shipbuilding and ship-repairing dry dock at shore point and Campbell Bay for bigger vessels. These two major dry docks should be developed as in Singapore, Kuala Lumpur and Bangkok models. Major dry docks will enable better business and employment opportunities for the Islanders. This will also benefit the Indian Navy as they have a big fleet of ships. Shri Sharma also requested to construct boat-building yard at Long Island.

Fisheries, high-value fishes and value-added fish products: He mentioned that there is vast potential in the Andaman Sea in the fisheries sector with an estimated potential of 1.48 lakh MT of fish which is 3.8 percent of the country's total fish potential. Shri Sharma stated that the Government of India and Department of Fisheries should chalk out a comprehensive policy that focuses on promoting investment in this sector through policy incentives and promoting exports.

Rural industries based on handicrafts, coir processing, wooden, bamboo, cane and fish pickles: The MP stated that Handicraft Industry can play a major role in the eradication of unemployment. Shri Sharma requested the Government to frame a policy for upliftment of the handicraft industry and also provide a market for it.

Tourism: The tourism sector has been recognized by the A & N Administration as the 'Sun Rise' sector with tremendous opportunities for the private sector to come in. Shri Kuldeep Rai Sharma requested the Government to promote sustainable and eco-friendly projects in the Tourism sector that can be the keystone for the development of the Islands as it has almost limitless potential, a press release from MP Office said.



NOTICE FOR PROHIBITING PRODUCTION, STOCKING, DISTRIBUTION, SALE & USE OF SINGLE USE PLASTIC (SUP) ITEMS AND COMPLIANCE OF PLASTIC WASTE MANAGEMENT (AMENDMENT) RULES-2021

Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change has issued notification G. S. R No.571 (E) dated 12th August, 2021 as Plastic Waste Management (Amendment) Rules-2021.

As per Rule 4(2) of PWM Rules, 2016 (as amended), "The manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of following single use plastic (SUP), including polystyrene and expanded polystyrene, commodities shall be prohibited with effect from the 1st July, 2022:

(a) Ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, plastic flags, candy sticks, ice cream sticks, polystyrene [Thermocol] for decoration;

(b) Plates, cups, glasses, cutlery such as forks, spoons, knives, straw, trays, wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards, and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 micron, stirrers;

As per Rule 4(1) of PWM rules, 2016 (as amended) "Carry bag made of virgin or recycled plastic shall not be less than seventy-five (75) microns in thickness with effect from 30th September, 2021 and one hundred twenty (120) microns in thickness with effect from 31st December, 2022.

(c) Sachets (Shampoo, Conditioners and similar personal care items, Mouth-fresheners, Pickle/Jam/Sauces, Spices, condiments, etc.), <15 mL (or equivalent in weight)

(d) Single-use, plastic bodied use & throw Pens

And as per the A& N Administration vide Notification No.225 dated 24.09.2019, the use, manufacture and sale of plastic carry bags irrespective of its thickness, size, color and nature is banned in A&N Islands.

This Notice is being issued to inform all Producers, Stockiest, Retailers, Shopkeepers, E-commerce Companies, Street Vendors, Commercial Establishments (Malls/ Marketplace/ Shopping Centers/ Cinema Houses/ Tourist Locations/ Schools/ Colleges/ Office Complexes/ Hospitals 7 other Institutions) and general public to stop production, stocking, distribution, sale and usage of identified SUP items as per the timelines specified in the said MoEF&CC Notification. Further, necessary action is to be taken by the concerned entities to ensure zero inventories of the aforementioned SUP items by June 30, 2022.

Selling as well as display/advertisement of Single Use Plastic (SUP) items on all E-Commerce website is also prohibited with effect by June 30, 2022.

Action, as deemed fit under Environment Protection Act, 1986 including seizure of goods, closure of operations of Industries/Commercial Establishments and in case of non-compliance of above Environmental Compensation as per the Guidelines issued by Central Pollution Control Board of Rs.5,000/- per ton shall be levied against the violators of the said Notification.

The GST, as applicable shall be charged extra. The Concerned Agency / Firm availing the services of Dry Docks/ Slipways should comply with the following Terms & Conditions:

- The Dry Dock/Slipway slot shall be allotted to Govt./ Private Agencies for a specified period only and extension of slot shall not be considered at any cost. If the allotted slot could not be utilized for completion of repair work, the vessel would have to vacate the Dry Dock/Slipway as per the Vacation Notice issued by this Directorate and the vessel shall be un-docked on 'as is where is' condition at the cost and risk of the Agency.
- In case the Agency so desires, they may apply afresh for the next slot to complete the remaining work. The same shall be considered based on the availability of spare slot and as per priority in the list of vessels awaiting Dry Dock/ Slipway allocation.
- In the event of requirement of Dry Dock/ Slipway on an **emergent** basis, the Directorate shall consider such allotment **out of turn** for which the Agency has to raise requirements with proper justification.
- The Dry Dock/ Slipway allotment to the other Govt./ Private Agencies will be subject to **payment of advance** Dry-docking/ Slipping charges as prescribed by the A&N Administration, as applicable on date.
- In case of any **delay** in Un-docking/ Un-slipping, per day charges of Docking/ Slipping will be **twice** the normal charges.
- An amount of **Rs. 50,000/-** (or as applicable as on date) shall be deposited by the user Agency in advance as **security** to ensure that the Dry-Dock/ Slipway is **cleaned** by the Agency after its use. The security deposit shall be returned after satisfactory cleaning up of dust, garbage and scrap metal generated during the repair of the vessel.
- The department shall charge **Rs. 5,799/- per hour plus applicable GST** for providing the services of **mobile crane** and **Rs. 1,697/- per ton plus applicable GST** (as applicable on date) for providing **electric connections for Hot Work**.
- In case the booking of Dry-Dock/ Slipway is cancelled without **48 hours advance** notice, **50%** of the Dry-Dock/ Slipway charges will be deducted from the advance deposit.

- If the vessel discharges oil, other debris and harmful pollutants in the Dry-Dock/ Slipway, the concerned Agency will be levied **cleaning charges** of **Rs. 50,000/-** in addition to charges prescribed above and an additional fine of **Rs. 5,000/-** will be levied.
