PM Modi lays foundation stone for redevelopment of 508 Railway Stations under Amrit Bharat Station Scheme across India

New Delhi, Aug 6

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi today laid the foundation stone for the redevelopment of 508 railway stations at a cost of over 24 thousand 470 crore rupees under the Amrit Bharat Station Scheme across the country through video conferencing. Speaking at the event, he said, each Amrit Station will be a symbol of city's modern aspirations and ancient heritage. He informed that around 1300 major railway stations in India will now be developed as Amrit Bharat Railway Stations of which work on the redevelopment of 508 Amrit Bharat Railway Stations has begun today. Shri Modi said around 25,000 crores rupees will be spent on the redevelopment of these Stations which will give a major boost to the Railways infrastructure.



Shri Modi said that the budgetary support for the Railways has been increased by five times as compared to 2014, which is now at 2.40 lakh crore rupees. He said that it is the beginning of a new era of development in the history of Indian Railways, which will benefit all the common citizens of the country. Shri Modi said India's credibility has

increased at the global level and the world's attitude towards India has changed. The Prime Minister said the Government is giving priority to the expansion of the railway network in the northeastern States. He said that the work towards electrification, doubling of the tracks, and the construction of new routes are on the fast track. Criticising the

opposition, the Prime Minister said that they have never appreciated the developmental work, be it the construction of the new Parliament building, the Statue of Unity, or the redevelopment of Kartavya Path. He said that there is a need to rise above negative politics, as India is moving ahead on the path of positive politics as a mission. 

Dr Mandaviya said that India supported South Africa's initiative to strengthen cooperation in the field of Integrated Early Warning systems as it shall enhance preparedness for future health crises. "The collaboration shall play a pivotal role in designing effective interventions to contain cross-border spread of infection while minimizing their impact on BRICS countries' social and economic conditions, in accordance with International Health Regulations (2005)", he noted.

After lunar orbit injection, Chandrayaan-3 spacecraft is slated to orbit the Moon multiple times, gradually approaching the Moon. Once it reaches a 100 km orbit above the lunar surface, the lander and rover will be detached and manoeuvred to soft-land on the surface of the moon. The spacecraft is expected to complete a 40-day journey to make a soft landing near the Moon's south pole around August 23rd. 7. Be cautious of emails, messages, or pop-ups asking for personal information or urging to click on a link. Avoid providing sensitive information unless being certain of the sender's identity and legitimacy.
8. Create strong, unique passwords for your online

accounts and change them periodically. Avoid using easily guessable passwords or reusing passwords across multiple accounts and configure a limit for password attempts.
