No positive case detected during test conducted on passengers: Secretary (IP&T)

Port Blair, Oct. 8

The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh briefing media persons on COVID-19 in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening

said that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 618 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 7 flights with 1139 passengers arrived, out

of which, 663 were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on remaining 476 passengers and the reports are awaited. (Contd. on last page)

Interactive session for augmentation of ground water resources in A&N Islands held

NOC is compulsory for all commercial establishments extracting ground water

Port Blair, Oct. 8

An interactive session was held in the District Office conference hall under the chairmanship of Shri Suneel Anchipaka, Deputy Commissioner (SA) for the augmentation of ground water resources in the Islands. Scientists from Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA) and officers from different line Departments were present.

The DC (SA) asked all the owners of commercial organisation to apply for No Objection Certificate (NOC) for their commercial establishments and clarify all their doubts with CGWA. He emphasized that NOC is necessary for maintaining sufficient level of ground water and its quality without affecting the natural aqua-system. Creating awareness about NOC



for extraction of ground water by industries, infrastructure projects and mining projects was the major objective of the session. There were many clarifications asked by bulk water suppliers regarding non availability of form for which the CGWA scientists have assured that for bulk water supply, the NOC certificate form will be uploaded on the

website very soon.

The DC (SA) is designated by CGWA as the authority for enforcement of NOC for ground water extraction in the District. There are more than 45 hotels and resorts which have not taken NOC in South Andaman District. Therefore, DC (SA) emphasized that action will be initiated against those who do not apply for NOC and

violators of the provisions of NOC will be penalized. The DC (SA) and CGWA reiterated that NOC is compulsory for all commercial establishments extracting ground water and requested them to do so by following the rules and procedures established by the Ministry of Jal Shakti, a press release from DC (SA) said.

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Mangifera andamanica - an endemic wild mango species of conservation interest

Mangifera andamanica is a rare and endemic species of the Island. This species is distributed in Chouldhari and forests of Chidiyatapu. This wild mango species is conserved at field gene bank of ICAR-CIARI and also registered with NBPGRI (ICAR- National Bureau of Plant Genetic Resources, New Delhi) with IC No 04060 to receive national identity. The species is characterized by tall trees (9-12 m), spreading tree habit with elliptic oblong leaves and notched apex. Fruits are round, shiny orange yellow peel colour. The fruit weight ranges from 25 -35 g with total soluble solids in the range of 12-18° B. The raw mangoes of this species are used in pickle making as little sour in taste and the pulp is rich in phytochemicals. No serious pest and disease is reported from this species. This endemic mango (*M. andamanica*) can be propagated by seeds and grafting. For conservation of gene pool which is rare, planting can be taken up in gene banks, botanical gardens and in-situ conservation in wild.



Benefit: *M. andamanica* is a rare and endemic species of the Island which is potentially valuable for breeding programmes. Conservation of this species will help in widening the genetic base and as a source of bioactive compounds.

RBI keeps repo rate unchanged at 4 pc, reverse repo rate at 3.35 pc

New Delhi, Oct. 8

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI)'s Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) on Friday kept the repo rate unchanged at 4 per cent and the reverse repo rate at 3.35 per cent. With this, RBI announced some developmental and regulatory decisions which will have an impact on the country's digital transactions and NBFCs customer interface. In its policy statement, RBI

announced digital payment solutions in offline mode also, where internet connectivity is low / not available (offline mode).

RBI said, the success of three pilot projects indicated that there is a scope to introduce such solutions, especially in remote areas. Now it has been proposed to introduce a framework for carrying out retail digital payments in offline mode across the

country. The RBI statement also announced the enhancement of the limit of Immediate Payment Service (IMPS) of National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) per transaction from 2 lakh Rs. To 5 lakh Rs. The internet banking, mobile banking apps, bank branches, ATMs, SMS and IVRS will benefit from this. (Source: india.gov.in)

Similarly, 322 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 16 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 504 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 2 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 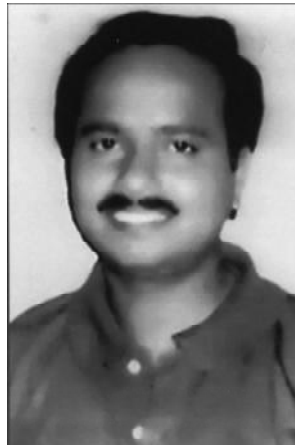
