Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Mangifera andamanica - an endemic wild mango species of conservation intere

Mangifera andamanica is a rare and endemic species of the Island. This species is distributed in Chouldhari and forests of Chidiyatapu. This wild mango species is conserved at field gene bank of ICAR-CIARI and also registered with NBPGR (ICAR-National Bureau of Plant Genetic Resources. New Delhi) with IC No 04060 to receive national identity. The species is characterized by tall trees (9-12 m), spreading tree habit with elliptic



oblong leaves and notched apex. Fruits are round, sma shining orange yellow peel colour. The fruit weight ranges from 25 -35 g with total soluble solids in the range of 12-18° B. The raw mangoes of this species are used in pickle making as little sour in taste and the pulp is rich in phytochemicals. No serious pest and disease is reported from this species. This endemic mango (M. andamanica) can be propagated by seeds and grafting. For conservation of gene pool which is rare, planting can be taken up in gene banks, botanical gardens and in-situ conservation in wild.

Benefit: M. andamanicais a rare and endemic species of the Islandwhich is potentially valuable for breeding programmes. Conservation of this species will help in widening the genetic base and as a source of bioactive compounds.

beneficiaries by vaccinating them through its designated vaccination centres spread over the Islands to keep the corona virus at bay. As per data available, the cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated with first dose so far is 2,91,066 (101.77%) while cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated with second dose so far is 1,63,420(56.15%).

Meanwhile, 756 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which 137 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 322 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 16 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. 504 beneficiaries were vaccinated in Nicobar District, out of which, 2 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44. A total of 1,70,966 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from


