

Govt. appoints Lt Gen Manoj C Pande as next Chief of Army Staff

New Delhi, April 18 (PIB)

Government has appointed Lt Gen Manoj C Pande, presently Vice Chief of the Army Staff, as the next Chief of the Army Staff with effect from the afternoon of April 30, 2022. Born on May 06, 1962, Lt Gen Manoj C Pande was commissioned on December 24, 1982 in the Corps of Engineers (The Bombay Sappers) of the Indian Army. During his long and distinguished service spanning over 39 years, he has served in a variety of Command, Staff and Instructional appointments. The Command appointments of Lt Gen Manoj C Pande include Command of an Engineer Brigade in the Western Theatre, as part of Strike Corps and an Infantry Brigade along with Line-of-Control in Jammu & Kashmir. Other important Command appointments include a Mountain Division in the high-altitude area of the Western Ladakh and Command of a Corps, deployed along the LAC and in Counter Insurgency Operations area of Eastern Command.



In the rank of Lt General, the Officer has held important appointments including that of Commander-in-Chief of the Andaman & Nicobar Command and as the GOC-in-C of the Eastern Command at Kolkata before getting appointed

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 10,855 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 years vaccinated so far

Port Blair, April 18

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,12,828 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,409

beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 years, and 10,855 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 12 to 14 years. The number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at

15,795. A total of 946 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 618 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 22 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years.

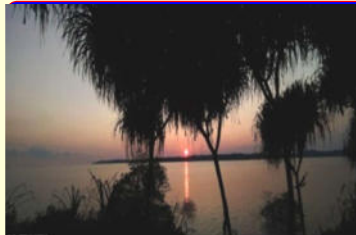

Tourism Department on mission to develop Manjery as scenic spot for sunset view

Port Blair, April 18

Tourism is a major revenue & employment generating sector for A&N Islands. To give further impetus to the tourism industry, the Chief Secretary, Shri Jitendra Narain recently conducted an extensive tour of South Andaman to explore the feasibility of tapping tourism potential areas for its development with the objective of promoting and supporting rural tourism in Isles which will not only add more avenues to

the tourism sector but also provide employment opportunity for many. Under the direction of the Chief Secretary, the Tourism Department is scouting and is in the process of developing a number of unexplored spots as new tourist attractions in the Islands. One such

spot identified to be promoted as an ideal tourist spot is the Sunset Point at Manjery. To enhance the picturesque site and the exotic view of sunset at this spot, the Department has initiated the process to develop the area by setting up sit outs, echo huts and other basic facilities besides beautifying

the whole area with paver blocks and flowering plants.

Apart from this, development of vantage points covering the stretch from Marine Park to Corbyn's Cove besides Chouldari, Swaraj Dweep and other unexplored places are being taken up so that many more activities /

destinations can be added for tourists visiting the Islands.

To identify and develop more tourism sites, the Department has invited the citizens to provide ideas/information on more such unexplored spots/locations which can be developed as new tourism attraction sites which will also simultaneously develop rural tourism and provide gainful livelihood opportunities to the residents of such areas, a press release from Tourism Department said.

No positive case detected during RT-PCR test conducted on incoming flight passengers

Port Blair, April 18

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 220 incoming flight passengers yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 16 flights with 2577 passengers arrived, out of which, 2302 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 204 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 35 passengers bound for North & Middle

Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected.

At Helipad, 11 passengers were tested with RAT and no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 29 passengers and no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 25 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected, a press release from Directorate of IP&T said.

FIRE PRECAUTIONS IN RESIDENTIAL AREA

To make your home fire safe, observe the following safety tips:

Do's

- Keep your home neat and clean.
- Keep matches, lighters and crackers away from the children.
- Paper, clothes and flammable liquids should be kept away from heaters/stoves/open choolas.
- Keep the escape routes/staircases free of any obstructions.
- Use only one electrical appliance in open socket.
- Keep LPG stoves on raised platform never on the floor.
- Turn off the cylinder valve and burner knob of the gas stove after cooking.
- Keep a bucket of water handy, while using fireworks.

Don'ts

- Don't meddle with electrical fixtures like plugs, wire, switches and sockets.
- Don't leave spray cans on or near heaters or in direct sunlight, they could explode.
- Don't throw matches, cigarette ends of pipe ash into waste paper baskets.
- Don't allow the children to play in the kitchen.
- Never place Oil Lamps, Agarbattis or Candles on the floor or near combustible materials.
- Don't wear loose, flowing clothes while cooking specially avoid synthetic clothing.
- Don't keep crackers in your pocket or use fireworks inside the house.
- Never light fireworks under confinement in a metal container.
- Never reach for any article over a fire.
- Don't refill a burning stove and never leave open fire unattended.
