## Lok Sabha unanimously passes Constitution KCC scheme - providing adequate (127th Amendment) Bill, 2021 allowing States & timely credit support to farmers to make their own OBC lists

New Delhi, Aug. 10 The Lok Sabha today unanimously passed the Constitution (One Hundred and Twenty-Seventh Amendment) Bill, 2021. The bill was passed with more than two third of majority of the House strength as well as the members present in the House. During

division of votes, 385



voted in favour of the bill and none against. The legislation seeks to restore the power of States and Union Territories to make their own OBC lists.

Replying to a debate on the bill, Social Justice members of House and Empowerment Minister, Dr Virendra Kumar (Source:india.gov.in)

said it will empower the States in preparing their own OBC lists. He said, the legislation will also help to strengthen the federal structure of the country. Dr. Kumar reiterated Government's commitment for the welfare of OBC community. He said, the bill will protect the interest of the OBCs community

Movement of persons involved with Hotels/Restaurants and Mess for home delivery of food shall be allowed till 10 pm. Dine-in shall be permitted between 6 am to 10 pm only, subject to 50% of the seating capacity and strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours. However, take away/parcel service and home delivery should be encouraged. It shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/In-Charge of the shop/ business establishment to ensure its compliance and he/she shall be held responsible for any violation and shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.50,000/- in addition to sealing of the shop/establishment for a period of 14 days by the Executive Magistrate and shall also be liable for action under

Public Transport/Buses shall be allowed to ply with strict adherence to the SOPs issued in this regard by the Transport Department. Sale and service of liquor at licensed premises shall be permitted till 10 pm. SOPs and orders regarding the timings for sale and service of liquor at all licensed establishments (C, C1, B1, B2, B3 and B4 category) issued by the Deputy Commissioner (Excise), South Andaman should be strictly adhered to.

All Parks/Playgrounds/Stadiums/Gyms and yoga institutes shall be permitted till 10 pm with 50% capacity and strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours. Any person violating the above directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.1,000/-, whereas the organisation shall be fined to the tune of Rs.25,000/-. Last rites/funerals shall be permitted with a maximum of 20 persons with strict adherence of to COVID appropriate behaviours. No tribal passes will be issued for southern group of islands till further orders except for official purposes/national importance and strategic

All Religious places/places of worship are allowed to open till 10 pm with 25 persons at a time along with priest for offering prayers. Wearing of face masks, maintaining social distancing, provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The Management Committee of the religious places shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance and any violations of the directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.25,000/- payable by the Committee. Religious places/places of worship in containment zones shall remain closed. Only those outside containment zones will be allowed to open up.

e-pass for emergency movement during restricted timings may be submitted online on https://epass.andaman.gov.in. The applicants/organizations submitting applications for epass should invariably submit valid and clear supporting documents, failing which the application will be summarily In view of the emergent circumstances, this order is being

issued ex-parte and is addressed to the public in general. Further, the Superintendent of Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrates and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of this order and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to note that these restrictions fundamentally relate to movement of people, but not to that of essential services.

Any disobedience of the above orders shall invite penal ction u/s 188 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and the relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 against the violator(s) and fine shall also be imposed as per Order issued by this office from time to time. This order shall come into effect from 11th August, 2021 and
