Lok Sabha unanimously passes Constitution (127th Amendment) Bill, 2021 allowing States to make their own OBC lists

New Delhi, Aug. 10

The Lok Sabha today unanimously passed the Constitution (One Hundred and Twenty-Seventh Amendment) Bill, 2021. The bill was passed with more than two-third of majority of the House strength as well as the members present in the House. During division of votes, 385 members of House



voted in favour of the bill and none against. The legislation seeks to restore the power of States and Union Territories to make their own OBC lists.

Replying to a debate on the bill, Social Justice and Empowerment Minister, Dr Virendra Kumar

said it will empower the States in preparing their own OBC lists. He said, the legislation will also help to strengthen the federal structure of the country. Dr. Kumar reiterated Government's commitment for the welfare of OBC community. He said, the bill will protect the interest of the OBCs community. (Source:india.gov.in)

Lockdown/restricted movement shall continue to be in force in entire District of South Andaman till Aug. 17

Port Blair, Aug. 10

In order to ensure containment measures of isolation and social distancing in the South Andaman District with continuous focus on the fivefold strategy for effective management of COVID-19 i.e. Test-Track-Treat-Vaccination and adherence to COVID appropriate behavior to control any surge in the cases of COVID-19 again and also to prevent any disturbance to the peace and tranquility and taking into consideration the request of the public representatives and general public, Shri Suneel Anchipaka, District Magistrate, South Andaman District, in exercise of the powers vested U/s 144 of Cr.P.C., has ordered that lockdown/restricted movement shall continue to be in force in the entire District of South Andaman from 11.08.2021 with no

movement of men and materials between 10 pm and 6 am except for those specified. Shops selling essential and non-essential items shall be allowed to open between 6 am & 10 pm by observing COVID appropriate behavior. It shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/In-Charge of the shop/business

establishment to ensure its compliance and shall be held responsible for any violation and he/she shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.50,000/- in addition to sealing of the shop/establishment for a period of 14 days by the Executive Magistrate and shall be liable for action under DM Act. No movement of men and material without valid

movement pass/e-pass shall be allowed after 10 pm.

Movement shall be allowed after 10 pm for medical emergency cases. Persons engaged for essential activities for movement of goods on Andaman Trunk road, loading and unloading of essential cargo after 10 pm shall be allowed on

Director of Rural Development & Panchayati Raj, Executive Engineer, APWD and Deputy Director (Family Welfare).

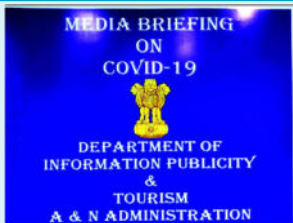
In the meeting, it was decided that August Round of National De-

Media briefed on COVID-19 No positive case detected during tests conducted at Mohanpura Bus Terminus, Ferrargunj & Phoenix Bay Jetty: Secretary (IP&T)

Port Blair, Aug. 10

The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh briefing the media persons on COVID-19 status in the Islands held in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 456 flight passengers, who arrived here yesterday, two positive cases have been detected. RAT test was conducted on 286 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and no



positive case was found. Today, 2 flights with 362 passengers arrived here and the result of RT-PCR reports are awaited. Apart from this, RAT was

conducted on 50 passengers proceeding to Swaraj Dweep at Phoenix Bay Jetty and all were found negative. Similarly, the test was also conducted on 100 passengers sailing from Swaraj Dweep by MV Choudhary and no positive case was found. RAT was conducted at Mohanpura Bus Terminus and here too, no positive case has been detected.

Govt. makes provision for opening of Krishi Vigyan Kendra in every rural district

Aims to provide required infrastructure in remaining KVKs

New Delhi, Aug.10 (PIB)

The Government has made a provision for opening of Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK) in each of the rural districts across the country. A total of 725 KVKs have been established across the country till date. KVKs are mandated for frontline extension which act as a bridge between research organizations and the main extension system operated by different departments of the State Governments. Considering the role and

resources of a KVK, it caters to the requirement of the selected farmers of the district and provide capacity development support to State Departments. The coverage of entire district is the responsibility of departments of State Governments.

As many as 657 KVKs have administrative building and 521 KVKs have Farmers' hostel. The Government aims to provide required infrastructure in the remaining KVKs

expeditiously.

As per requirement, large number of KVKs have been strengthened with other infrastructure facilities like, pulses seed hubs, soil testing kits, micro-irrigation systems, Integrated Farming Systems units, farm machineries and equipment, District Agro-Met Units, etc. This information was given by Union Minister for Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Shri Narendra Singh Tomar in a written reply in Lok Sabha today.

PMEGP scheme- a boon for rural & urban unemployed youth

Chouldari resident sets up her own enterprise on automobile spare parts

The Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) has proved to be a great boon to rural and urban unemployed youth to find a respectable and independent way of life. Even those who have not been able to continue with their formal studies can also go into suitable independent venture. Thousands of aspiring women and men have benefitted from this scheme. One such beneficiary is Deepa Sarkar who hails from Chouldari village of South Andaman District. She had learned about this scheme from a person who has already been benefitted through the captioned scheme.

Having completed schooling till XII std, she worked under a private firm for few years, but was always desperate to



own an enterprise. She met the officials of A&NI KVIB and discussed with them the support available from Government to start a self-employment venture. They advised her to do a small market survey and find out what she would like to do. Her market survey revealed that there was a scope for setting a trading unit in her area for sale of automobile spare parts.

the proposal and good recommendation by KVIB, she was sanctioned a loan amount of Rs. 2,85,000.00 under PMEGP scheme by SBI, Chouldari for setting up of her automobile spare parts sales unit. She also undertook the EDP training which endowed her with a vision of an entrepreneur.

production of valid movement permit issued by the Office of District Magistrate. Travel of persons who intend to proceed to their destinations at mainland after 10 pm shall be allowed on production of valid travel documents. However, the person (one person) who intend to pick/drop after 10 pm, should apply for e-pass well in advance with supporting documents and the same shall be issued by the Office of District Magistrate on case to case basis.

Movement of officers/officials involved in providing essential services such as District Administration, Police, CISF, Health Services, ICMR, PBMC, Electricity, Shipping Services, Home Guards, Civil Defence, Fire and emergency services, Defence personnel on duty after 10 pm shall be permitted on production of valid Identity Cards issued by their concerned departments.

Movement of Officers/Officials, involved in providing services such as Pay & Accounts, Forest, Banking, Water Supply & Sanitation in Rural Areas, Disaster Management, Port services and related services, Telecommunication shall be allowed after 10 pm on production of movement passes already issued by the Office of District Magistrate.

Movement of personnel involved in providing Broadcasting, all print and electronic media persons after 10 pm shall be allowed on production of valid movement passes issued by the Office of District Magistrate.

Movement of personnel involved in providing essential/emergency services shall be allowed after 10 pm on production of e-passes to be issued by the Office of District Magistrate. It shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/In-Charge of the shop/business establishment to ensure its compliance and also if any person attached with such organisation is found misusing the e-passes or using the same for purposes other than it is meant for, the owner/in-charge shall be held responsible and he/she shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.25,000/- and shall also be liable for action under DM Act. All POL outlets shall be opened from 6 am to 10 pm.

Movement of private medical personnel such as Doctors, nursing staff, paramedics etc. attached with diagnostic centres and clinics, veterinary clinics shall be allowed after 10 pm on production of e-passes issued by the Office of District Magistrate.

Movement of persons from containment zones shall be strictly restricted and shall only be permitted on case to case basis upon approval from the Office of District Magistrate. Port services will continue to operate as usual and both essential and non-essential cargo can be moved in and out of port, as per requirement for loading/unloading/clearing of cargo and the same shall be permitted till 10 pm only. e-Passes for operation of cargo movement after 10 pm needs to be obtained, which shall be strictly permitted on case to case basis by the Office of the District Magistrate. Construction activities shall be permitted till 10 pm. Construction activities of national importance and strategic projects beyond 10 pm shall be permitted with prior permission of District Magistrate and e-Passes needs to be obtained, which shall be strictly permitted on case to case basis by the Office of the District Magistrate.

Movement of persons involved with Hotels/Restaurants and Mess for home delivery of food shall be allowed till 10 pm. Dine-in shall be permitted between 6 am to 10 pm only, subject to 50% of the seating capacity and strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours. However, take away/parcel service and home delivery should be encouraged. It shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/In-Charge of the shop/business establishment to ensure its compliance and he/she shall be held responsible for any violation and shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.50,000/- in addition to sealing of the shop/establishment for a period of 14 days by the Executive Magistrate and shall also be liable for action under DM Act.

Public Transport/Buses shall be allowed to ply with strict adherence to the SOPs issued in this regard by the Transport Department. Sale and service of liquor at licensed premises shall be permitted till 10 pm. SOPs and orders regarding the timings for sale and service of liquor at all licensed establishments (C, C1, B1, B2, B3 and B4 category) issued by the Deputy Commissioner (Excise), South Andaman should be strictly adhered to.

All Parks/Playgrounds/Stadiums/Gyms and yoga institutes shall be permitted till 10 pm with 50% capacity and strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours. Any person violating the above directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.1,000/-, whereas the organisation shall be fined to the tune of Rs.25,000/-. Last rites/funerals shall be permitted with a maximum of 20 persons with strict adherence of to COVID appropriate behaviours. No tribal passes will be issued for southern group of islands till further orders except for official purposes/national importance and strategic projects.

All Religious places/places of worship are allowed to open till 10 pm with 25 persons at a time along with priest for offering prayers. Wearing of face masks, maintaining social distancing, provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The Management Committee of the religious places shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance and any violations of the directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.25,000/- payable by the Committee. Religious places/places of worship in containment zones shall remain closed. Only those outside containment zones will be allowed to open up.

e-pass for emergency movement during restricted timings may be submitted online on <https://epass.andaman.gov.in>. The applicants/organizations submitting applications for e-pass should invariably submit valid and clear supporting documents, failing which the application will be summarily rejected.

In view of the emergent circumstances, this order is being issued ex-parte and is addressed to the public in general. Further, the Superintendent of Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrates and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of this order and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to note that these restrictions fundamentally relate to movement of people, but not to that of essential services.

Any disobedience of the above orders shall invite penal action u/s 188 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and the relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 against the violator(s) and fine shall also be imposed as per Order issued by this office from time to time.

This order shall come into effect from 11th August, 2021 and shall remain in force till 17th August, 2021.
