Dulari Scheme was launched on Jan. 26, 2013 in A&N Islands, with the aim to reduce the gap in sex ratio to the replacement level of Net Reproduction Rate (NRR) i.e. 1 by ten years after implementation of the scheme whichever is earlier. The scheme is being implemented as a plan scheme. As per the present replacement level of NRR, scheme, the girl child born on or to encourage birth of girl after 26.01.2013 are eligible to get child in A & N Islands, to the benefit under the scheme for birth incentives.

However, the person who intend to pick/drop after 10 pm, should apply for e-pass well in advance with supporting documents and the same shall be issued by the Office of District

Movement of personnel involved in providing Broadcasting, all print and electronic media persons after 10 pm shall be allowed on production of valid movement passes issued by the Office of District Magistrate.

Movement of personnel involved in providing essential/emergency services shall be allowed after 10 pm on production of e-passes to be is sued by the Office of District Magistrate. It shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/In-Charge of the shop/business establishment to the context of the shop-business establishment to the context of tensure its compliance and also if any person attached with such organization is found misusing the e-passes or using the same for purposes other than it is meant for, the owner/in-charge shall be held responsible and he/she shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.25,000/-and shall also be liable for action under DM Act.

All POL outlets shall be opened from 6 am to 10 pm. Movement of private medical personnel such as Doctors, nursing staff, paramedics etc. attached with diagnostic centres and clinics, veterinary clinics shall be allowed after 10 pm on production of e-passes issued by the Office of District Magistrate. Movement of persons from containment zones shall be strictly restricted and shall only be permitted on case to case basis upon approval from the Office of District Magistrate. Port services will continue to operate as usual and both essential and non-essential cargo can be moved in and out of port, as per requirement for loading/unloading/clearing of cargo and the same shall be permitted till 10 pm only. e-Passes for operation of cargo movement after 10 pm needs to be obtained, which shall be strictly permitted on case to case basis by the Office of the District Magistrate.

Construction activities shall be permitted till 10 pm. Construction activities of national importance and strategic projects beyond 10 pm shall be permitted with prior permission of District Magistrate and e-Passes needs to be obtained, which shall be strictly permitted on case to case basis by the Office of the District Magistrate. Movement of persons involved with Hotels/Restaurants and Mess for home delivery of food shall be allowed till 10 pm. Dine-in shall be permitted between 6 am and 10 pm only, subject to 50% of the seating capacity and strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours. However, take away/parcel service and home delivery should be encouraged. It shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/In-Charge of the shop/business establishment to ensure its compliance and he/she shall be held responsible for any violation and shall be liable to be fined to the tune of Rs.50,000/- in addition to sealing of the shop/establishment for a period of 14 days by the Executive Magistrate and shall also be liable for action under DM Act.

Public Transport/Buses shall be allowed to ply with strict adherence to the SOPs issued in this regard by the Transport department. Sale and service of liquor at licensed premises shall be permitted till 10 pm. The parties concerned and management committee of the Hall/ Hotel shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance of the COVID appropriate behaviours and any violations of the directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.50.000/-.

Theatres shall be permitted to function with 50% seating capacity and strict adherence of COVID appropriate behaviours. The owner of the theatre shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.50,000/-, in case of any violations. Academic congregations shall be allowed with maximum 50% seating capacity. Wearing of face masks, maintaining social distancing, provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The Owner/Proprietor of the academic institutions/coaching centre shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance of the COVID appropriate behaviours and any violations of the directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.50,000/-. SOPs in this regard $shall\ be$ issued by concerned Department. Indoor sports activities $shall\ be$ allowed with no spectators. Wearing of face masks, maintaining social distancing, provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash and sanitizers will be mandatory. The management of the indoor facility shall be responsible to ensure strict compliance of the COVID appropriate behaviours and any violations of the directions shall be liable for fine to the tune of Rs.25,000/-.SOPs in this regard shall be issued by concerned department.

In view of the emergent circumstances, this order is being issued ex-parte and is addressed to the public in general. Further, the Superintendent of Police/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Executive Magistrates and all authorities concerned shall ensure strict compliance of this order and shall adequately inform and sensitize the field functionaries to note that these restrictions fundamentally relate to movement of people, but not to that of essential services. Any disobedience of the above orders shall invite penal action u/s 188 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and the relevant provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 against the violator(s) and fine shall also be imposed as per Order issued by this office from time to time.

This order shall come into effect from 25th August 2021 and shall remain in force till 31st August 2021.

followed by frontline workers and vulnerable population with co-morbidities. Subsequently, the vaccination for 45 and above was initiated followed by 18 to 44 years which is currently underway. The cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated with 1st dose so far stood at 240043 while the number of cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated with 2nd dose is 102532.

Meanwhile, the vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands and as per data available, a total of 4034 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. 3229 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 2651 were in the age group of 18-44 years. 784 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 590 were in the age group of 18-44 years. In Nicobar District, 21 beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which, 8 were in the age group of 18-44 years. A total of 1,29,097 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date, a press release from DHS said.




