

## Providing social and financial security to girl child under Dulari Scheme

### 26261 beneficiaries registered under the scheme in A&N Islands

Port Blair, Aug. 24

Dulari Scheme was launched on Jan. 26, 2013 in A&N Islands, with the aim to reduce the gap in sex ratio to the replacement level of Net Reproduction Rate (NRR) i.e. 1 by ten years after implementation of the scheme whichever is earlier. The scheme is being implemented as a plan scheme. As per the present scheme, the girl child born on or after 26.01.2013 are eligible to get the benefit under the scheme for birth incentives.

The objective of the scheme is to reduce the gap in sex ratio to a

  - a) Hospital Delivery: Rs. 8,000/- OR
  - b) Home Delivery: Rs. 5,000/-
2. Benefits on passing VIII Standard: Rs. 5,000/-
3. Benefits on passing X Standard: Rs. 10,000/-
4. Benefits on passing XII Standard: Rs. 10,000/-
5. Benefits on getting married at the age of 21 years: Rs. 5,000/-
6. Benefits on getting married after the age of 25 years: Rs. 10,000/-

(The amount will be kept in fixed deposit in the name of the Child)



replacement level of NRR, to encourage birth of girl child in A & N Islands, to provide social security to the newly born girl child, for her education and marriage, to adopt delayed

marriage practices in respect of girl child and to encourage adoption of hospital delivery practices.

All the girl born to either of the parents who are a permanent resident of A &

N Islands are eligible for availing benefit provided under Dulari scheme viz. Benefits at Birth (Hospital Delivery or Home Delivery) Rs.8,000/- & Rs.5,000/- respectively.

Similarly, Rs.5,000/- will be provided to the girl child on passing VIII standard, Rs.10,000/- on passing X standard & Rs.10,000 on passing XII standard, Rs.5,000/- on getting married after the age of 21 years and Rs.10,000/- on getting married after the age of 25 years. A total of 26261 beneficiaries have been registered upto July, 2021 in Isles.

In order to ensure containment measures of isolation and social distancing in the South Andaman District with continuous focus on the fivefold strategy for effective management of COVID-19 i.e. Test-Track-Treat-Vaccination and adherence to COVID appropriate behavior to control any surge of the cases of COVID-19 again and also to prevent any disturbance to the peace and tranquility and taking into consideration the

request of the public representatives and general public, Shri Suneel Anchipaka, District Magistrate, South Andaman District, in exercise of the powers vested U/s 144 of Cr. P.C. has ordered that lockdown/restricted movement shall continue to be in force in the entire District of South Andaman from 25.08.2021 with no movement of men and materials between 10 pm & 6 am except for those specified. Shops selling essential and non-

essential items shall be allowed to open between 6am to 10pm by observing COVID appropriate behavior. 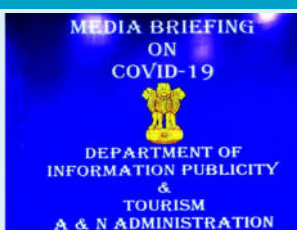
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## Media briefed on COVID-19

### Dy. Director (IP&T) urges people to follow COVID appropriate behaviour to protect themselves from the virus

Port Blair, Aug. 24

The Dy. Director (IP&T), Shri R S Meena briefing the media persons on COVID-19 status in the Islands held in the conference hall of IP&T. There this evening stated that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 668 passengers who arrived here yesterday, one positive case has been detected. Today, 4 flights with 639 passengers arrived and the RT-PCR reports are awaited. He further disclosed that RAT was conducted on 351



passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and all the tests were found negative. During the test conducted at Phoenix Bay Jetty on 80 passengers, all were found negative. During the test conducted on 73 passengers who arrived from Swaraj Dweep, all of them were negative. At helipad, 6 persons were tested and all were negative. Apart from this, RT-PCR

test was conducted on 14 crew members of MV Strait Island and the reports are awaited.

The Dy. Director further informed that at Mohanpura Bus Terminus, 169 passengers were tested and all the reports were negative. About vaccination drive, he said, today till 3.30 pm, 900 beneficiaries were vaccinated, out of which 883 were in the age group of 18-44. He appealed to the people

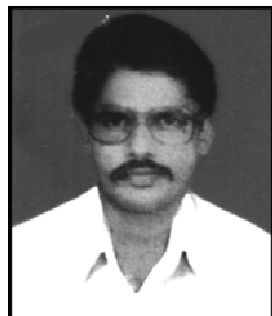

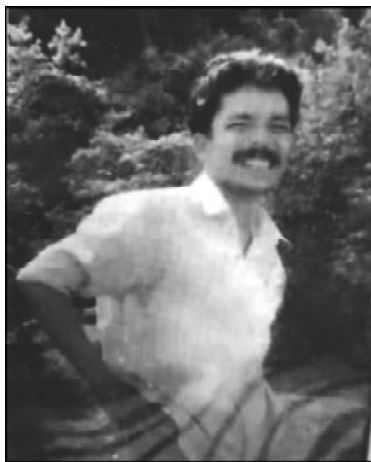
