The Periodic Labour Force Survey (2019-20) points towards the steady build up of distress in the labour market in India. As the survey pertains to the July 2019 to June 2020 period, it applures both the economic slowdown prior to Covid, and the period after the national lockdown was imposed to restrict the spread of the periodic. The survey data shows an increase in the labour force participation in agriculture during this period. This, as some have argued, implies that during this period of stress, agriculture emerged as an 'employer of last resort'. Equally significant is that much of the increase in the women's labour force participation recorded by the survey during this period was in the category. remployer of last resort. Equally significant is that much of the increase in the women's labour force participation recorded by the survey during this period was in the category of urpaid family workers, and not in more productive forms of employment. These are worying developments. The PLFS data shows that the share of the labour force engaged in agriculture rose to 45.6 per cert in 2019-20, up from 42.5 per cert in 2018-19 — an abrupt reversal of the decadesing decline in the labour force participation in agriculture. This suggests that the movement of labour out of agriculture, which had gathered pace post 2004-05, seems to have been stymied by the economic slowdown. The reverse migration of labour from cities to villages would have only increased the stymied by the economic slowdown. The reverse migration of labour from cities to villages would have only increased the interesting the properties of the female labour force participation is also problematic. Under normal circumstances, considering the low rates of female labour force participation in India — for women aged 15 and above it stood at 24.5 per cent in 2018-19 — a rise in participation would be a positive development. However, much of the increase observed in 2019-20 was in the form of unpaid family work. In fact, according to the survey, the employment rate for unpaid workers in household enterprises in rural and urben areas increased to 15.9 per cent in 2019-20, from 13.3 per cent in 2018-19. What these numbers also reflect is the failure of the economy in not being able to create enough non-agricultural jobs (even in pre-Covid times) to absorb both those shifting out of agriculture, and the to absorb both those shifting out of agriculture, and the millions entering the labour force each year. 9/11 anniversary: How the terror strike became a crucial turning point in India-US ties

In 1998, shortly after Atal Bihari Vajpayee became prime minister, India conducted its second set of nuclear tests at Pokhran, Rajasthan. The result was a freeze in tes with the US, which imposed economic sanctions against hdia.

The impact of the sanctions wasn'tmuch, as, apartfrom Japan no other country imposed total economic sanctions. However, economic sanctions. How ever, many countries like Australia, New Zealand, and some European nations also suspended aid and credit lines. But, since big countries like France, the UK and Russia didn't impose sanctions, the US didn't impose sanctions, the Usintent on isolating India wasn't realised. Also, India's newly liberalised economy was in the India Strining' phase. A year later, the Talliban hijacked an Indian Airlines flight, IC-814, with 176 passengers on board, demanding the release of three of its men from the release of three of its men from Indian prisons. After the slay ing of Rupen Katy al, a passenger returning from his honey moon in Kathmandu, Indian authorities had little choice butto accept the demand and release Ahmed Omar Saeed Sheikh, Mushba Ahmed Zargar and Mascord Apart

The two countries formed a joint working group on counter-terrorism in January 2000. Then president Bill Clinton visited India a few months later—an early indicator of a change in heart for the US. It paved way for the subsequent hdia-US Civil Nuclear Deal, which was own headache in the region—

Manmohan Singh and George W. Bush (2007). Since Clinton, every US president has visited India. Barack Obama came twice. Given the wary relationship between the two nations in the past, with India's close Soviet fies and the US's close Pakistanties, the rate of acceleration in the bilateral relations is rather remarkable.

The US supported India in getting members hips into elite nuclear clubs—Australia Group, Wassenar Arrangement and Missile Technology Control Regime. It strongly supports India's strongly supports India's membership into the Nuclear Suppliers Grouptoc. The US stood by Indiain geting Azhar proscribed by the United Nations Security Council, sll China too buckled in 2019.

India has found a new defence and strategic partner in the US, and strategic partner in the Us, having signed all foundational defence pacts—COMCASA, LEMOA, BECA. Now that the US believes India is a responsible player and has accepted Inda's 'no first use' nuclear policy, the US is activally working India ha counter its activally working India have counter its actively wooing India to counter its

Whereas the Central Government constituted the Central Ground Water Authority vide notification Number S.O. 38(E), dated 14th January, 1997, followed by notification number S.O. 1124(F) dated 6th November, 2000 and S.O. 1121 (E) dated 13th May, 2010 of the Government of India in the Ministry of Environment & Forests, for the purposes of regulation and control of ground water development and management in the whole of India and to issue necessary regulatory directions.

And whereas the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, New Dolhi, in its Order dated 15,04,2015 in O.A. No. 204/2014 and connected matters, has directed that "any person operating tubewell or any means to extract groundwater should obtain its permission and should operate the same subject to law in force, even if such unit is existing unit or the unit is still to be established

And whereas, in pursuance to above directions from Hon'ble NGT all existing/new ground water users including Industrial/ Infrastructure/ Mining Projects were directed to submit their applications for No Objection Certificates (NOC) latest by 30.06.2020 vide Public Notice dated 01.04.2020.

And whereas revised CGWA guidelines for NOC for ground water withdrawal have been notified vide Notification No. S.O. 3289(E), dated 24.09.2020, available on CGWA website (http://cgwanoc.gov.in/LandingPage/Guidlines/NewGuidelinesNotified250920.pdf#ZOOM=100).

Now, therefore, all the users including Residential apartments, Group Housing Societies, Government water supply agencies in urban areas and Industrial, Infrastructure and Mining Projects and Swimming Pools whether existing or new (except exempted category as per section 1 of notified guidelines), drawing or proposing to draw ground water are required to obtain NOC as per the guidelines and are hereby directed to submit their applications for NOC through online portal of CGWA (http://egwa-noc.gov.in) or respective State Authorities, as the case may be. The applications received in CGWA shall be processed as per guidelines dated 24.09 2020 and subsequent public notices issued in this regard.

Since, the last date provided for submission of applications is already over, the applicants shall be liable to pay a late fee of Rs. 1 lakh, along with ground water abstraction/restoration charges w.e.f. 24.09.2020. However, such applicants shall be exempted to pay Environmental Compensation till 31,03,2022, All project proponents drawing ground water but fail to apply for NOC by 31,03,2022 are liable to face legal action and pay Environmental Compensation for illegal withdrawal of ground water.

It is hereby also informed that all the ground water users whose applications for grant of NOC have been rejected by CGWA on the ground of non-submission of mandatury documents shall be required to resubmit their applications for grant of NOC by 31.03.2022 through online portal of CGWA or respective State Authorities, as the case may be, failing which legal action as per proviso of the notified vide Notification No.S.O. 3289(E), dated 24.09.2020 shall be initiated.



The second layer is Advanced Air Defence (AAD) Missile for lower altitude interception, which is designed to knock down hostile missiles in the endo-atmosphere at altitudes of 15-40 kilometres. Akash Surface-
