

PM Shri Narendra Modi chairs 13th BRICS Summit BRICS is an influential voice for emerging economies of the world: PM

New Delhi, Sept. 9 (PIB)

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi chaired the 13th BRICS Summit virtually today. The theme of the Summit, chosen by India, was, BRICS@15: Intra-BRICS Cooperation for Continuity, Consolidation and Consensus. The Summit saw the participation of all other BRICS Leaders - President, Mr. Jair Bolsonaro of Brazil, President, Mr. Vladimir Putin of Russia, President, Mr. Xi Jinping of China, and President, Mr. Cyril Ramaphosa of South Africa.

Prime Minister expressed his appreciation for the cooperation received



from BRICS partners during India's Chairship this year, which allowed the achievement of several new initiatives. These included the first BRICS Digital Health Summit; the first BRICS Ministerial Joint Statement on multilateral reforms; a BRICS Counter-Terrorism Action Plan; an Agreement on cooperation in field of remote-sensing satellites; a virtual BRICS vaccine Research & Development Centre; BRICS Alliance

on Green Tourism, etc. Today we are an influential voice for the emerging economies of the world. This platform has also been useful for focusing attention on the priorities of developing nations as well, the Prime Minister said.

Highlighting the leading role that BRICS countries can play in the post-COVID global recovery, Prime Minister called for enhanced BRICS cooperation under the motto of

'Build-back Resiliently, Innovatively, Credibly and Sustainably'.

Elaborating on these themes, Prime Minister stressed the need for accelerating 'build-back' by enhancing speed and accessibility of vaccination, creating 'resilience' by diversifying pharma and vaccine production capacities beyond the developed world, fostering 'innovation' by creatively using digital tools for public good, ensuring reform of multilateral institutions to enhance their 'credibility', and promoting 'sustainable' development by articulating a common BRICS voice on environmental and climate issues.

Vaccination drive in A&N Islands 3,80,151 cumulative doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far

Port Blair, Sept. 9

COVID-19 vaccines have the potential to save lives by reducing the risk of infection among vaccinated individuals. The vaccination drive which started in these Islands on January 16, 2021 is continuing smoothly at the designated vaccination centers spread over the islands and eligible beneficiaries are taking vaccination as per their slot without fail. At the outset, COVISHIELD vaccine was administered to Health Care Workers followed by

vulnerable population with co-morbidities in A&N Islands. Subsequently, the vaccination for 45 and above was initiated followed by 18 to 44 years which is currently underway. Now, after completion of more than eight months since the start of the vaccination drive, the cumulative doses of vaccines administered to beneficiaries so far stands at 3,80,151. The cumulative beneficiaries vaccinated with 1st dose so far stands at 2,68,396, the percentage of which is 95.31 while the

The 2nd week of Rashtriya Poshan Maah focuses on 'Yoga and AYUSH for Nutrition' during which yoga sessions for pregnant

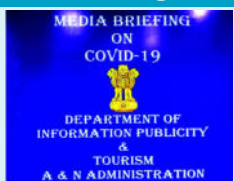

Media briefed on COVID-19 All samples tested on incoming flight & inter-island bound passengers found negative: Secretary (IP&T)

Port Blair, Sept.9

The Secretary (IP&T), Shri Sunil Kumar Singh briefing media persons on COVID-19 in the conference hall of IP&T here this evening said that during the RT-PCR test conducted on 682 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 4 flights with 622 passengers arrived and the RT-PCR reports are awaited. He further disclosed that RAT was conducted on



208 passengers bound for North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj and all were found negative. RAT was conducted at Phoenix Bay Jetty on 102 ship passengers for onward journey to different destinations and all were found negative.

Similarly, during the return journey, test was conducted on 150 passengers and all were negative. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, 193 passengers were tested and all the reports were negative. At helipad, 9 passengers were tested and all were found negative.

The Secretary said, today till 3 pm, 298 beneficiaries were administered vaccines out of which, 231 were in

Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Auck Chang Tall - A promising coconut cultivar

It is a cultivar of Car Nicobar Island. Generally, the palms are orphologically similar to Andaman Ordinary. Tall but with differences in nut characteristics. An accession collected and evaluated at World Coconut Germplasm Centre, ICAR-CIARI, Port Blair has shown that the palms of this cultivar are robust, high yielding with higher copra content. The palms of this variety take about 5-7 years for first flowering. The kernel is thick and recorded higher milk recovery under VCO production process. The fruits are green or light brown, husk thickness is thin (2 to 3 cm), dehusked fruits are oval, good tender nut water quantity (560 ml per fruit), average fruit weight over 1700g with average copra content of about 170g. However, there are palms with copra content of more than 260g recorded in the population. Under the natural habitat of rainfed conditions in Car Nicobar, the palms exhibited large bole, stout stem, good fruit setting with estimated fruit yield of over 140 nuts per palm per year, regular production of bunches and dense crown. Careful mother palm selection followed by seedling selection is important to establish good plantation of Auck Chang Tall considering the variability observed in the natural and conserved population.

Benefit: Although the tender coconuts are also used for drinking purpose, it is mostly preferred for copra making, processed coconut kernel products and VCO production. The kernel oil content is about 65%.

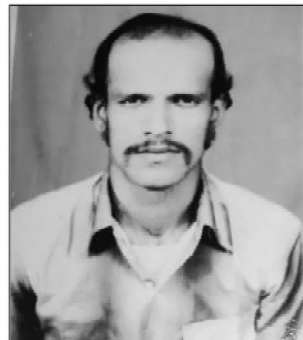
