Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

With the objective to create awareness and provide technological inputs to Isles farmers on different varieties of fruits, flowers and other crops which are being maintained / innovated by ICAR-Central Island Agricultural Research Institute (ICAR- CIARI), a Farmers' Corner containing vital inputs for the benefit of farming community has been introduced. As part of this, to begin with, a series on high yielding coconut varieties conducive to Isles climatic condition is published for the information of general public as well as farmers.

Andaman Ordinary Tall - A promising coconut cultivar

nınantıy grown tall Islands. The palms are robust growing with strong and stout stem with a prominent bole at the base of the palms, produce strong dark green leaves. The palms of this variety take about 5-7 years for first flowering. The drooping of leaves is intermediate. The fruits are large, oblong shaped with husk thickness of about 2 to 3 cm. The dehusked fruits are round or oval, thick shell of over 4 mm, kernel thickness over 1.3 cm. The individual palms of this population show variation for fruit colour unless selected for particular colour. The fruit colour varies from dark green to light green or light brown. The palms of Andaman Ordinary are considered drought



hardy, withstand heavy winds but takes longer time for first flowering when compared to other tall cultivars. The copra content ranges from 180 to 250g per nut with oil recovery of about 65%. The fruit yield per palm year ranges from 50 to 150 depending upon the management conditions.

Benefit: The cultivar has reported as having tolerant to nematodes under field conditions. Although the tender coconuts are also used for drinking purpose, it is mostly recommended for copra making, processed coconut kernel products such as desiccated powder and VCO production

He expressed happiness that athletes have accepted his request that every player visit at least 75 schools during Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav. This will inspire the students and many talented students will get encouragement to go forward in the field of sports, he said. The Prime Minister said that for the progress of any country, education should not only be inclusive but should also be equitable. He added that National Digital Architecture i.e. N-DEAR is likely to play a major role in eradicating inequality in education and its modernization. N-DEAR will act as a 'super-connect' between various academic activities in the same way as UPI interface revolutionized the banking sector. The country is making technology like Talking Books and Audio books a part of education, he said.

School Quality Assessment and Assurance Framework (S.Q.A.A.F), which was operationalized today, would address the deficiency of the absence of a common scientific framework for dimensions like curricula, pedagogy, assessment, infrastructure, inclusive practices and governance process. SQAAF will help in bridging this inequality. He added that in this rapidly changing era, our teachers also have to learn about new systems and techniques rapidly. He informed that the country is preparing its teachers for these changes through 'Nishtha' training programs. The Prime Minister said teachers of India not only meet any global standard, but they also have their special capital. This special capital, this special strength is the Indian culture within them. He said our teachers do not consider their work as a mere profession, teaching for them is marked by human empathy, a sacred moral duty. That is why we do not have a mere professional relationship between the teacher and the children, but a family relationship. And this relationship is for life, the Prime Minister added.

According to the vaccination figures of all the three District, in South Andaman, 96193 persons have been vaccinated with first dose in the age group 18-44 years while the number of second dose beneficiaries inoculated as per their vaccine due date is 7151. In North & Middle Andaman, the number beneficiaries administered with first dose of vaccine is 42240 while the number of second dose beneficiaries is 2871. Similarly, in Nicobar District, 13973 have been inoculated with first dose while 282 persons have been vaccinated with second dose.

Meanwhile, a total of 3,76,259 doses of vaccines have been administered to beneficiaries so far in A&N Islands, out of the target beneficiaries of 2, 81, 603 (approx.). A total of 1760 people were vaccinated today in A&N Islands. A total of 1,52,351 eligible people in the age group of 18 to 44 years have been vaccinated till date.

1051 beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which 560 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years. Similarly, 622 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 321 were in the age group of 18-44 years. 


