The tremors were felt around 11:45 pm at the depth of 10 kilometres. "Earthquake of Magnitude: 3.9. Occurred on 21-Magnitude: 3.9, Occurred on 21-09-2021, 23:44:57 IST, Lat: 9.99 & Long: 93.54, Depth: 10 Km, Location: 202km SSE of Portblair, Andaman and Nicobar island," said the NCS in a tweet. UK recognises Covishield as COVID-19 vaccine; grants no respite to Indian travelers from 10-day quarantine

London, Sept 22: Days after it drew severe diplomatic flak from India for 'discriminating' against Covishield by not including it in the list of approved COVID-19 vaccines, the UK government, on Wednesday revised its travel advisory said that Covishield qualifies as an approved vaccine. India had threatened that it will reciprocate the same

indictiminatory protocols if the British government did not recognise the Covisheld vaccine.

Despite the approval of Covishield, however, the UK government has denied imparting validity to the Indian vaccine certificate, keeping India in the amber list of countries. This necessarily means that the

ist of counters. In the Recessarily means that the mandatory 10-day quarantine rule stays for Indians travelling to UK.

"We are engaging with the Government of India to explore how we could expand UK recognition of vaccine certification to people vaccinated by a relevant public health body in India. Indian travellers to the UK. must follow the 'non-vaccinated rules'," a British High Commission spokesperson in New Delhi said.




