CRC- A&N Islands to organize ADIP aids & appliances distribution camp for Divyangjans on Sept. 17

Port Blair, Sept. 12 : Under ADIP Scheme, the CRC-A&N Islands in coordination with the Social Welfare Department and Education Department will be organising Distribution Camp of Aids and Appliances on Sept. 17, 2022 in the Conference Hall of CRC-A&N Islands, Brookshabad.

During the camp, different ADIP materials such as Teaching learning Materials (TLMs Kits), hearing aids, wheel chair, auxiliary crutches, elbow crutches, smart cane will be distributed. All the Divyangjan (PwDs) have been requested to attend the camp and avail Aids & Appliance, free of cost. Meanwhile, the Divyangjans (PwDs) who have not submitted

the relevant documents as per the revised Guidelines of ADIP Scheme 2022 have been asked to submit 2 passport size photos, 1 Disability certificate or UDID card (both copy & original) and Income Certificate documents before Sept. 15, 2022.

If the total income is up to Rs. 22,500/- per month, he or she shall be eligible for getting assistance with full cost of the Aids and Appliances under ADIP Scheme. If the total income is between Rs. 22,501/- to Rs. 30,000/- per month, he or she shall be eligible for getting 50% subsidy of the cost of Aids/ Appliances under ADIP Scheme.

Income Certificate from Revenue Agencies/ BPL Card/

MGNREGA Card / Disability Pension Card / Certificate by MP/MLA/Councilor/Gram Pradhan, will be accepted, failing which, Notarized Affidavit C/o Implementing Agencies may be accepted for providing aids/appliances to PwDs. Income Certificate of beneficiaries staying in orphanages and half-way homes etc. may be accepted on certification of District Collector or Head of the organization concerned.

Islands' pride - Ms Techa scripts history by becoming first Andamanese tribal girl to clear NEET

Chief Secretary felicitates Ms Techa for her outstanding achievement



Port Blair, Sept. 13 : It is a moment of pride for the A&N Administration, as Miss Techa hailing from the Andamanese tribal community became the first from her tribe to have successfully cleared the National Eligibility cum Entrance Examination (NEET) (UG)-2022. To encourage and congratulate Ms Techa for her outstanding achievement, the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS today felicitated her for the glorious success. She has been awarded

a cash prize of Rs. 10,000/- and a souvenir. The Chief Secretary also assured all support from the A&N Administration for her future endeavors.

The achievement of Techa is a historic moment for Andamanese tribe as this feat has been achieved for the first time by a student of Andamanese tribe. The Andaman Adim Janjati Vikas Samiti, an autonomous body, working under the Directorate of Tribal Welfare provided financial assistance to complete her education from primary level to

Class XII and assisted her in preparing for NEET examination. Miss Techa passed Class XII from Girls Senior Secondary School, Port Blair.

The Chief Secretary also directed the Directorate of Tribal Welfare to extend assistance to all PVTG students for their better future.

The Commissioner-cum-Secretary (TW) and Secretary (TW) were also present during the felicitation ceremony.

Member of Parliament demands seating, drinking water and toilet facilities at the existing VSI Airport Building for all driver brothers and other Tour operator staffs

The Member of Parliament of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma has requested the Airport Director of VSI Airport Port Blair to provide seating, drinking water and toilet facilities at the existing Airport Building for all Driver brothers and other Tour operators staff, who have to visit Airport Daily to pick up guests.

In a letter addressed to the Airport Director, the Member of Parliament added that everyday a large number of Tourists land at Veer Savarkar International Airport and during tourist season this number goes up to several thousands per day.

He added that to pick-up the arriving guests, a large number of local youths, who work as Drivers in Tourism Cabs or Supporting staff of Tourism Agencies have to wait at the arrival gate for a long time. Often in case of flight delay they have to wait for even longer.

The Member of Parliament mentioned that as Tourism is generating a huge number of employment, a large number of youths are buying Tourists vehicles or joining tourism agencies as Drivers or Supporting Staffs.

He added that at the Arrival Section, where usually they have

to wait for guests daily for a long time, no seats have been provided for them.

He pointed out that there is no dedicated toilet block or drinking water arrangement for them for which they are facing huge inconvenience on a daily basis.

He mentioned that this has become a common sight to see local youths, who are associated with the tourism industry, sitting on the ground while waiting for their guests, which leaves a wrong impression about Anadman among other guests. This also makes hard working local youths upset.



संपदकीय

सवाल— मोबाइल या स्मार्टफोन क्यों फटते हैं?

जवाब— बैटरी की वजह से ज्यादातर मोबाइल फोन फटते हैं। बैटरी के फटने का सबसे बड़ा कारण हीट यानी गर्मी है। अब आप सोच रहे होंगे कि बैटरी गर्म होने का रिलेशन मौसम से है, तो ऐसा बिल्कुल भी नहीं है। दरअसल, किसी भी कारण से अगर बैटरी का टेम्प्रेचर बढ़ता है और बैटरी ज्यादा गर्म होती है, तब फोन फटने के चांस होते हैं।

ध्यान देने वाली बात— जब बैटरी का कोई हिस्सा किसी कारण से बहुत ज्यादा गर्म हो जाता है और जल्दी ठंडा नहीं हो पाता है। तब बैटरी के फटने की संभावना ज्यादा होती है। अच्छे फोन में बैटरी को ठंडा करने के इंतजाम होते हैं, लेकिन सभी फोन में नहीं।

सवाल— बैटरी की वजह से मोबाइल कैसे फट जाता है?

जवाब— मुंबई के आईटी एक्सपर्ट मंगलेश एलिया के अनुसार चार्जिंग के समय मोबाइल के आसपास रेडिएशन हाई रहता है। इस कारण बैटरी गर्म हो जाती है। इसलिए यह चार्जिंग के वक्त बात करने पर ब्लास्ट हो सकती है। यूजर्स की गलतियों की वजह से भी बैटरी ओवरहीट होकर फट जाती है। बैटरी के सेल डेड होते रहते हैं, जिससे फोन के अंदर के केमिकल में चेंजेस होते हैं और बैटरी फट जाती है।

सवाल— मोबाइल शॉर्ट सर्किट की वजह से कैसे फट जाता है?

जवाब— मोबाइल में लगी एक बैटरी में कई तरह की लेयर होती है। कई बार इन बैटरी के लेयर टूट जाते है या इनमें गैप हो जाता है तो बैटरी फूल जाती है। इसके बाद शॉर्ट सर्किट होकर वो फट सकती है।

सवाल— प्रोसेसर की वजह से मोबाइल कैसे फटता है?

जवाब— समझिए कैसे प्रोसेसर की वजह से मोबाइल फट सकता है— आजकल ज्यादातर मोबाइल हाई—एंड प्रोसेसर वाले होते हैं, जो ज्यादा गर्म होते है। प्रोसेसर बैटरी के पास लगा होता है, जब फोन पर ज्यादा लोड पड़ता है, तो प्रोसेसर गर्म होता है। प्रोसेसर गर्म होकर बैटरी को भी गर्म कर देता है, इसके बाद मोबाइल फटने की संभावना बढ़ जाती है।

सवाल— प्रोसेसर ठंडा रहे, इसके लिए क्या उपाय है?

जवाब— कुछ स्मार्टफोन बनाने वाली कंपनियां हाई—एंड प्रोसेसर पर हीट सिंक लगा देती है। हीट सिंक प्रोसेसर में पैदा हुई हीट को बैटरी से दूर रखता है और फोन को जल्दी ठंडा कर देता है। जिस मोबाइल फोन पर हीट सिंक नहीं होता, उनमें आग लगने की संभावना ज्यादा होती है।

सवाल— टेम्प्रेचर कंट्रोल करने के अलावा और क्या सावधानी रखें, जिससे फोन फटने की संभावना कम हो जाए?

जवाब— बैटरी, शॉर्ट सर्किट और प्रोसेसर के अलावा हार्डवेयर की दिक्कत के चलते भी फोन ब्लास्ट हो सकता है। इसलिए फोन में कोई भी गड़बड़ी नजर आए, तो उसे तुरंत ठीक करवाएं। बैटरी फूल जाए, तो तुरंत बदलवाएं। मोबाइल गिर जाए या टूट जाए, तो बैटरी में लीकेज की समस्या आ जाती है, जिससे वो फूलती है और आग पकड़ने का खतरा रहता है। डुप्लीकेट बैटरी या चार्जर को यूज न करें। मोबाइल की कोई सिक्योरिटी अपडेट आई हो तो जल्द से जल्द उसे इंस्टॉल करें।

मोबाइल का इस्तेमाल करने से रेडियो फ्रिक्वेंसी निकलती हैं, जो आपके मेटाबॉलिज्म और खानपान पर बुरा असर डाल सकती है।

मोबाइल तकिफे के नीचे रखकर सोने से ब्रेन डैमेज होने का खतरा हो सकता है।

इससे निकलने वाले रेडिएशन से कैंसर और ट्यूमर जैसी खतरनाक बीमारियां भी हो सकती हैं।

WAR AGAINST ILLICIT LIQUOR: MORE THAN 1600 LITRES OF LEHAN RECOVERED IN JUNGLE SEARCH AND COMBING OPERATIONS



In a major crackdown against bootlegging activities and menace of illicit liquor, more than 1600 Litres of Lehan (fermented wash to prepare illicit liquor) have been recovered along-with other materials/utensils used for distillation of illicit liquor in PS Car Nicobar, Rangat Sub-division and Ograbraj. To dry up the supplies of illicit liquor, as a part zero tolerance against bootlegging, a strategy of jungle search and combing operation has been adopted. Accordingly, a number of jungle search operations have been carried out in recent past. These operations have yielded excellent results in apprehending and recovery major haul of Lehan. During jungle search and combing operation carried out on 7th and

8th September, 2022 at various places in Car Nicobar, Police trekked deep inside the forest and recovered around 800 liters of Lehan in several plastic drums hidden inside the woods along-with utensils used for distillation. From Rangat Sub-division, in jungle search operations, around 650 litres of Lehan was recovered from the forest areas of Shyam Kund, Bakutala and Profulla nagar, Betapur on 10-11 September, 2022. Similarly, in the jurisdiction of PS Ograbraj, more than 160 litres of lehan was recovered. The recovered lehan was later destroyed on the spot. Local residents highly appreciated the pro-active action of the Police. In addition to strict enforcement, mass public awareness campaign has been

launched to wean away people especially the youth from addiction of alcohol by spreading awareness about ill-effects of alcohol/drug abuse. Awareness programmes on "Alcohol/Drug Abuse" are being conducted in Schools, with Community leaders and other stakeholders. A&N Police is committed to take stern action against bootleggers, illicit liquor, drug peddlers and other illegal activities. In this fight against illicit liquor, bootlegging and drug abuse, public is requested to share information pertaining to any crime or other illegal activities to Police at 100, 112 & 03192-233077. The identity of the informant will be kept secret.

आप सभी यह मलीभांति जानते है कि भारतीय संघ की राजभाषा हिन्दी है। भारत के संविधान को तैयार करने के लिए गठित संविधान सभा ने 14 सितम्बर, 1949 को देवनागरी लिपि में लिखी जाने वाली हिन्दी को भारतीय संघ की राजभाषा के रूप में स्वीकार किया था। उसी दिन की याद में प्रति वर्ष 14 सितम्बर का दिन देश भर में “हिन्दी दिवस” के रूप में मनाया जाता है।

heartening to state that the Administration is in the process of filling up 12800 (approx) posts (NG) under various categories in the near future. Action in this regard has already been initiated by the Administration. This is an

appreciable step by the Administration to provide relief to the local unemployed youth of the territory. The ex-MP has thanked the Administration for initiating the steps & hoped that all vacancies shall be filled soon.

Secretary (Fisheries) visits Dundus Point, Mannarghat & Shoal Bay to take stock of assets created by beneficiaries under PMMSY

Port Blair, Sept. 12

Shri G. Sudhakar, IAS, Secretary (Fisheries), A&N Administration along with Director of Fisheries and officials of Department of Fisheries visited Dundus Point, Mannarghat and Shoal Bay to take stock of assets created by the beneficiaries under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) in South Andaman District. In Dundus Point, the Secretary (Fisheries) inspected the Ice Plant of 18MT constructed by Shri. Dharmalingam, M/s DSN Ice Plant with financial support under PMMSY. He enquired about the local demand and mode of distribution of ice from the unit and advised the beneficiary to provide ice to the local fishermen at reasonable price. It was also directed to encourage more beneficiaries under the programme to meet the growing demand of ice due to increase in fishing activities in the Islands.

The Secretary (Fy.) also inspected the Shrimp Farm at Mannarghat constructed by Shri. D. Potaiah and appreciated the efforts of the beneficiary in taking commercial shrimp farming which is first of its kind in A&N Islands. The farm has been established in an area of approx. 0.50 Ha with financial assistance under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana for culture of shrimp (Penaeus vannamei). The beneficiary explained in detail about the management of the farm and economics of operation to the visiting team. The Secretary (Fy.)



directed the Fisheries Department to encourage more beneficiaries to take up shrimp farming in the Islands and conduct exposure visit to the beneficiary farm for creating awareness among the interested farmers. Later, a grow out fresh water fish pond constructed under PMMSY by

beneficiary at Shoal Bay was also inspected by the Secretary (Fy.) along with the team. During the inspection, the beneficiary was advised to take up mud crab culture in his field considering its suitability and also adopt scientific methods for taking up freshwater fish culture in the remaining land.

It is regrettable that the Andaman & Nicobar Administration and the Indian Oil Corporation did not take the issue seriously to make sufficient quantity of LPG cylinders available in the islands despite the shortage experienced for quite a long time. The present shortage of cylinders is not a sudden phenomena, it was going on for the last several weeks and the Administration and IOC failed to take effective measures to contain the shortage.

I would, therefore, request you kindly to look into this issue seriously and take immediate effective steps to ensure that the people get the LPG cylinders without any long queue before the LPG vehicles and on demand by the customers. If the shortage of LPG cylinders is not resolved within a week, the CPI (M) will be forced to resort to agitation by organizing the people.

Member of Parliament Demands another LPG Bottling Plant at Mayabunder to cater to the present and future LPG cylinder demands of Islanders

The Member of Parliament of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Shri. Kuldeep Rai Sharma has requested the Hon'ble Lt. Governor to set up another LPG Bottling Plant at Mayabunder to cater to the present and future LPG cylinder demands of Islanders.

In a letter addressed to the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, the Member of Parliament mentioned that on 20 April 2003 a LPG Bottling plant was set up at Hoptown area of South Andaman for the people of Andaman and Nicobar Islands and since last 19 years LPG cylinders are being supplied to all the Islands through the same LPG bottling plant.

In his letter he added that together with growing population and tourist footfall has also increased considerably since 2003 and similarly the number of hotels and restaurants have also increased significantly in most of the regions of Andaman and Nicobar

Islands, especially in South Andaman region. This has created a heavy pressure on the lone LPG bottling plant of Hope Town.

He mentioned that logistically it is very expensive and difficult to transport LPG cylinders from Port Blair to North and Middle Andaman Islands considering the Convoy restrictions, poor condition of NH4 and weather conditions.

The Member of Parliament added that once the Middle Strait Bridge as well as the VSI Airport's new terminal is completed, North and Middle Andaman will also witness a massive boom in tourism, which will put more pressure on the existing Hope Town LPG bottling plant.

He said that setting up of another bottling plant at Mayabunder will not only take some pressure off from the lone bottling plant of Hope Town but will also contribute heavily in fast pace development of the entire North

and Middle Andaman.

He said that once the second LPG bottling plant is set up, it can cater to the present and future needs of North and Middle Andaman while the existing LPG bottling plant at Hope Town will be able to cater to the needs of the entire South Andaman and Nicobar Districts.

He pointed out that Mayabunder already has a port, where an LPG container ship can berth and easily supply LPG to the proposed LPG bottling plant.

The Member of Parliament mentioned that once the International flights start operating from Veer Savarkar International Airport, Tourism industry of these Islands will witness a massive boom and then more hotel and restaurants will open in all over North, Middle and South Andaman region, which will double the demand for LPG cylinders and hence planning for a second LPG bottling plant is crucial at this point of time.

He added that in July 2019 the traffic unit of Andaman and Nicobar Police had installed many new facilities inside the traffic park but as per reports since COVID-19 lockdown the park has been kept closed.

Considering the high demand for such a facility among children the Member of Parliament requested the Chief Secretary to reopen the Children's Traffic Park for the children so that even while playing they can learn basic tips about Road Safety.
