Country's first Pan-India helpline for senior citizens: Elder Line (Toll Free No- 14567)

New Delhi, Oct. 3

Government has taken a monumental step towards addressing the challenges and problems the elderly population face, through country's first Pan-India toll-free helpline - 14567 -- called 'Elder Line'. The helpline provides free information and guidance on pension issues, legal issues, extends emotional support, and even intervenes on field in cases of abuse, and rescues homeless elderly.

Till date, 17 States have already opened the Elder line and others are in the pipeline to be opened. In the last 4 months alone, over 2 lakh calls have been received, and over 30 thousand seniors have already been serviced. Of these, nearly 40 percent calls were related to guidance and queries related to it and nearly 23 percent of calls were related to pension. India is expected to have nearly 20 percent elderly population which amounts to over 300 million senior citizens by 2050. This age group faces various mental, emotional, financial, legal and physical challenges. The intent of 'Elder Line' is to provide all senior citizens with one platform across the country to connect and share their concerns, get information and guidance on problems that they face on a day-to-day basis. Farmers' Corner- A Knowledge Hub

Kydia mangosteen: a rare flavourful fruit

Kydia mangosteen or Orange kauphal (Garcinia kydia) is a rare fruit species found distributed in the evergreen forests of Andaman Islands and Northeastern states of our country. Trees grow large and bear attractive orange coloured fruits akin to Kauphal (Garcinia cowa), but the ridges on fruits of kydia mangosteen are very light and are mostly present only at one end. Acidic fruits are eaten raw, while peel is employed as an acidulant in curries by settler communities. Fruits are known to have pleasant flavor, thereby making them a suitable candidate for processing into value added products. Studies at ICAR-CIARI have suggested that fruits contain vitamins A and C, and processed products such as dehydrated rind, sweetened rind, beverages etc. could be prepared from these fruits. Studies have also suggested that the trees grows even in soils with low to moderate amounts of nutrients, and hence could be grown with less crop management care. Traditionally, fruits are believed to have medicinal properties and are being used to treat dysentery, constipation, high blood pressure and stomach related ailments for human and pet animals. Under Island conditions, good to prolific bearing has been reported. Planting material of kydia mangosteen is being produced regularly at Horticultural Plants Propagation Unit of ICAR-CIARI and interested stakeholders can get the plants from there.

Benefit: Considering the prolific bearing habit of the tree without much care, cultivation of kydia mangosteen in home gardens and community lands could be promoted. Pooling of produce and preparation of products could be helpful in promotion of cottage industries in the islands.

consideration of their need and view, in decision making in water sector at village level was also discussed. All VWSC members were briefed on their responsibility and roles in management of village water supply network and preservation, conservation of water resources in and around the villages.

As part of Water Quality Testing and Surveillance programme, a demonstration-cum-training on Field Testing Kit (FTK) and updating the report to WQIMIS portal of JJM by Central Water Testing Laboratory CE's Office and Sub-Divisional Laboratory, Garacharma was also held. The process of registration of FTK users and data entry of reported results were also explained in brief along with method of sanitary survey of water source.

The Secretary (PWD), Shri Kishore Kshirsagar Lakshman who was the chief guest on the occasion urged the public for greater participation in water supply management and water quality surveillance to ensure long term welfare of villagers. Village Water and Sanitation Committee (VWSC) for Nayasahar village was also notified. Month long water quality testing and surveillance campaign was launched by handing over FTK to the Chairman VWSC, Special Officer, Guptapara Panchayat and testing of water samples from one of the household of village and Anganwadi Centre. VWSC members and villagers were requested to conduct regular water quality testing and surveillance and report to WQIMS, so that water quality data is available in public domain for appraisal and monitoring by higher authorities of Administration and Ministry of Jal Shakti. Similar programmes were also held at District and Tehsil Headquarters.

It is expected that during month long programme, the UT of A&N Islands will be able to conduct specified number of test on water samples to meet the target set by MoJS, GoI, a press release from ANSWSM said.
