Ban on manufacturing, sale, storage, purchase and use of Chinese Manjha/Nylon/Synthetic Material/ Glass coated thread used for kite flying

Port Blair, Sept. 29
The Principal Bench of the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT), New Delhi in its order dated 11.07.2017 in O.A.No.384/2016 and 442/2016 in the matter of Khalid Ashraf & Anr-Vs-UIO & Ors and People for Ethical Treatment of Animals (PETA) India -Vs -UIO & Ors respectively has directed the prohibition of the use of nylon

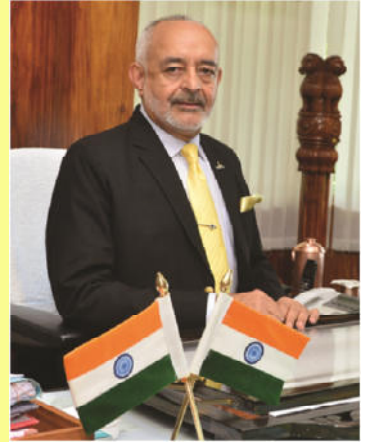
thread, Chinese Dor, and synthetic thread coated with harmful materials for kite flying. As per the directions of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MOEF&CC) and CPCB it is to inform that manufacture, sale, storage, purchase and use of Chinese Manjha or thread used for kite flying which is made of nylon or any synthetic

material and/or coated with synthetic substance and is non-biodegradable is prohibited. Units manufacturing "Synthetic fibre including rayon, tyre cord, polyester filament yarn" shall submit an Annual Self-declaration statement to ANPCC that they are supplying their product only to valid users and not to any entity involved in

manufacturing Chinese Manjha /Nylon/ Synthetic Material/ Glass coated thread for kite-flying. All concerned authority and general public have been advised to abide by the directions and non-compliance, if found, may be intimated to the Member Secretary, ANPCC for necessary action as deemed fit, a Public Notice issued by ANPCC said.

In continuation towards its fight against drugs, the Narcotics Cell, CID and PS CCS jointly succeeded in seizure of 497 nos. of 100 ml bottles of codeine based cough syrup and arrest of one person, said the DIGP (Intelligence), A&N Islands, Shri Sanjay Kumar Tyagi, IPS while interacting with the scribes at the Office of



the SP, CID here today.

The DIGP said that A&N Police is committed towards eradicating the menace of 'Drug Abuse' and making Andaman & Nicobar Islands a 'Drug-

Free' zone and the Police Department is firmly working to achieve this goal. He said, the Police is continuing its intensive drive to combat drug menace and breaking the

syndicate of the drug peddlers.

Giving details of the seizure of the cough syrup, the DIGP said, acting on a specific intelligence input, Police Team from Narcotics Cell, CID and PS CCS arrested one person namely Pushpa Raj Shukla, R/o Garacharma who was in possession of huge quantity of Codeine based Cough Syrup in his house at Garacharma. Indian Ocean Tsunami Mock Communication Exercise to be conducted on Oct. 4; public advised not to panic

Port Blair, Sept. 29
The International Coordination Group for the India Ocean Tsunami Warning and Mitigation System (ICG/IOTWS) of UNESCO in coordination with Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Services, Hyderabad (INCOIS) will be conducting Indian Ocean Wide Tsunami Communication Exercise (IOWave23) on 4th October, 2023 in India and the Andaman & Nicobar Islands will also participate in this exercise. The Indian Tsunami Early Warning System (ITEWS) at the Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Services (INCOIS), Hyderabad, focuses primarily on monitoring and warning of Tsunamis in Indian Ocean.

This exercise will test the current procedures of the Indian Ocean Tsunami Warning and Mitigation System and help identify operational strengths and weaknesses in each State and Country. The exercise is to test disaster management organization's communications protocols organizational SOPs, plans and policies for tsunami warning and emergency response.

During the exercise, the Indian Tsunami Early Warning Centre (ITEWC) at Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Services (INCOIS), Hyderabad will provide simulated tsunami threat information as an occurrence of gigantic Earthquake measuring 9.0 Mw in richter scale near the Andaman Trench on 4th Oct, 2023

at 0930 IST and followed by Tsunami generation and issue alerts/warning in the form of bulletins to all coastal States of India and to other countries in the Indian Ocean region. These alerts/warnings/advice/threat pass will further be disseminated from the State Emergency Operation Centre (SEOC) to all other Emergency Operation Centres situated in other Islands through different means of communication channels to test the communication channels. In this IOWave 23, the Administration is also testing communication & response system of all Emergency Support Functionaries of A & N Islands.

Asian Games: India's medal tally reaches 32 including 8 Gold, 12 Silver & 12 Bronze, Team India currently at 4th place

Hangzhou, Sept. 29

India have so far won a total of 32 medals in the Asian Games 2023 held in Hangzhou, China. These include 8 Gold medals, 12 Silver medals, and 12 Bronze medals. Team India are currently at fourth place. On Day 6 today, Indian contingent added 2 Gold, 4 Silver and 1 Bronze to the overnight tally.

Also, in Squash, Indian men's team have confirmed at least a silver medal by reaching the team final. They face Pakistan tomorrow in the final for the Gold Medal. In Women's boxing, India's Nikhat Zareen beat Jordan to seal her place in the Women's 50 kg Boxing semi-finals and assured herself a medal. She also secured a Paris 2024 Olympics quota in the women's 50kg weight category.

Indian Women's Hockey team won Pool A match against Malaysia by 6-0. Muhammad Ajmal Variyathodi qualified for the final of the Men's 400m after finishing second on Heat 2. India's Aishwarya Mishra finished second in the Women's 400m heats. She sealed a place in the final.

The Indian men's badminton team, featuring Lakshya Sen, Kidambi Srikanth and Mithun Manjunath, won 3-0 against Nepal in the quarter-final tie. In Tennis, mixed

doubles pair, Rutuja Bhosale and Rohan Bopanna proceeded to the finals and also assured of at least a Silver after a 2-1 victory over the Chinese Taipei in the semi-final.

Indian women's squash team bagged bronze after losing to Hong Kong. In table tennis, Manika Batra advances to the quarter-finals with a 4-2 win over Thailand. In women's doubles round of 16, Sutirtha Mukherjee and Ayhika Mukherjee beat Thailand, clinching their spot in Quarter Finals.

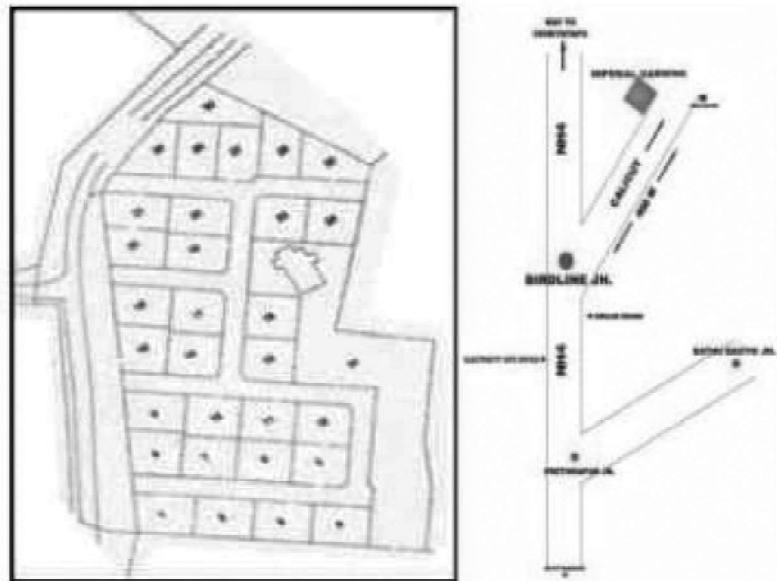

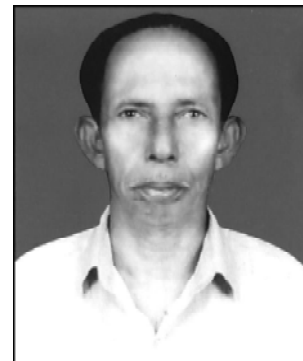

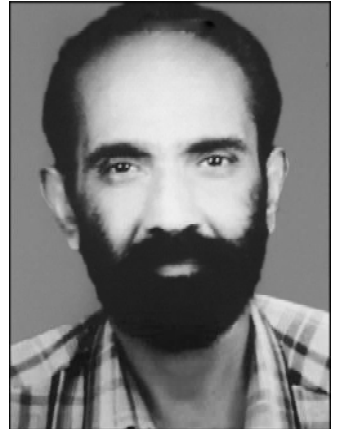
