Spare a thought for your good ole boss. After all, no less a rebel than Bob Dylan said, "everybody's an, no less a recent and not by supervisors of or't gotta serve somebody". It's not like supervisors don't have people to report to, and targets of their own to meet. When they call, text, mail after hours, it is likely not for the pleasure of conversing. And, given the blurring of lines between office and home, the workday and personal time, after the pandemic struck, it is that much more difficult to know when "office hours" end. It is the complexity of this "new normal" that the well-meaning law passed by Portugal's socialist government seems not to comprehend.

The new law is meant to ensure a healthier work-life healtheap by disable the surface of the properties of the second of the secon

socialist government seems not to comprehend. The new law is meant to ensure a healthier worklife balance by disallowing supervisors from montacting employees after "work hours". It aims to make Portugal an attractive destination for "digital nomads": If you have to work-from-home, why not of it from Portugal, where labour laws favour you? The problem with trying to provide such benefits to "digital nomads" is that they do not really function in a traditional 9-5 setup. A coder for an Indian company living in Lisbon may well want working hours that are very different from "office hours" in both countries. In fact, one of the few advantages for many people working from home during the pandemic has been the flexibility it affords: Make a meal, spend time with the kids, and work around a schedule you set for yourself. Digital nomads move temporally, not just spatially. With all his flexibility and freedom, the notion of "work hours" all but disappears. And, if you can work any hours" all but disappears. SUICIDE BOMBER AMONG THREE MILIT KILLED IN TWO ENCOUNTERS IN KASHMIR

Three militants, including a 'fday een' (suicide bomber), were killed in two separate encourters in Jammu and Kashmir, police said on Friday, taking the number of ultras killed sofar this year to 133.

A 'Muiahideen Gazwatul Hind' A 'Mujahideen Gazwatul Hind' millant who was assigned to carry out a 'fdaysen' (suicide) attack in Srinagar was killed, while a Hizbul Mujahideen (HM) districtommander was among the two ultras slain in an encounter in Kulgam, the police said. As many as 133 militants, including several top commanders, have been killed this yearso far, they said

said. The 'fidayeen' militant was a relative of one of the accused in the February 2019 Pulwama suicide attack in which 40 CRPF personnel were killed, police said.

A police spokesman said acting on a specific input about a possib terrorist attack and the movement of terrorists in the Bernina area of Srinaga checknoint was established on

Thursday b thwart such designs.
In the meantime, terrorists attacked a checkpoint established near Bund Bemina which was retaliated leading to an encounter, he said, adding further reinforcement was rushed to the

In the ensuing gunfight, one terrorist of proscribed terror outfit Mujahideen Gazwatul Hind was kiled and his body was retrieved from the site of the encounter, the spokesman said.

He was also involved in recruiting innocent vouth into terror ranks and in innocenty outh inhoterror ranks and in spreading a reign of terror by killing civilians as well as political workers in Dev sar and Brazloo areas of Kulgam. There are 15 FIRs registered against him for several terror crimes, the spokesman said.

Incrim inating material and arms and ammunition including an AK-rifle and a pis tol were recovered from the Kulgam encounter site. An AK-riflewas also recovered from the Bemina encountersite, he said. The recovered material has been taken into case records for further investigation. Police have registered cases under relevant sections oflaw and investigations have been initiated, he added.

The spokesman said Inspector General of Police (IGP), Kashmir, Vjay Kumarhas congratulated he pintteams forcarry ing out both the operations in a professional manner resulting in elimination of three terrorists including a most wanted terrorist.

While their findings don't identify a microbial species that can immediately be used to help prevent children from developing neuro behaviours such as anxiety or depression, "We think the results do inform future studies that can look a little more deeply at took a little more deeply at some of our specific findings and clarify whether they could be developed as probiotics or other types of interventions such as the promotion of breastfeeding, "says Laue.


