

'Aspirational Districts' should be 'Inspirational Districts' of India, Programme should be extended to Block & City Levels: PM

Detailed discussions on Crop Diversification, National Education Policy and Aspirational Districts Programme held on day two of National Conference of Chief Secretaries

Dharamshala, June 16 (PIB)

The three-day-long National Conference of Chief Secretaries, which is being chaired by the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi is currently underway at Dharamshala, Himachal Pradesh. Deliberations were held on 'Crop Diversification and Achieving Self-Sufficiency in Oilseeds, Pulses and other Agri-Commodities' and 'Implementation of National Education Policy-School Education'. There were sessions on 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav: Road to 2047' and the Aspirational Districts Programme.

Lauding the success of the Aspirational

Districts Programme, the Prime Minister said the Government should strive to make these the 'Inspirational Districts' of India and extend the programme to the block and city levels.

The Prime Minister stressed that India's best, young Officers should be posted to the Aspirational Districts to bring about noticeable changes through their creative thinking and fresh ideas. The experience and learnings gained by them while working in these districts would be unparalleled and prove useful for the entire country, he said.

Speaking on education, the Prime

Minister said that teachers' training can be strengthened by leveraging digital technology and learning mobile apps. He stated that award winning retired school teachers could also be roped in for visiting schools and training teachers. He stated that there could be a dedicated TV Channel for teachers' training.

It may be recalled that in the Budget 2022-23, the GoI announced that 200 TV Channels would be launched for improving access to high quality education in the remotest part of the country. Hon'ble Prime Minister suggested organising

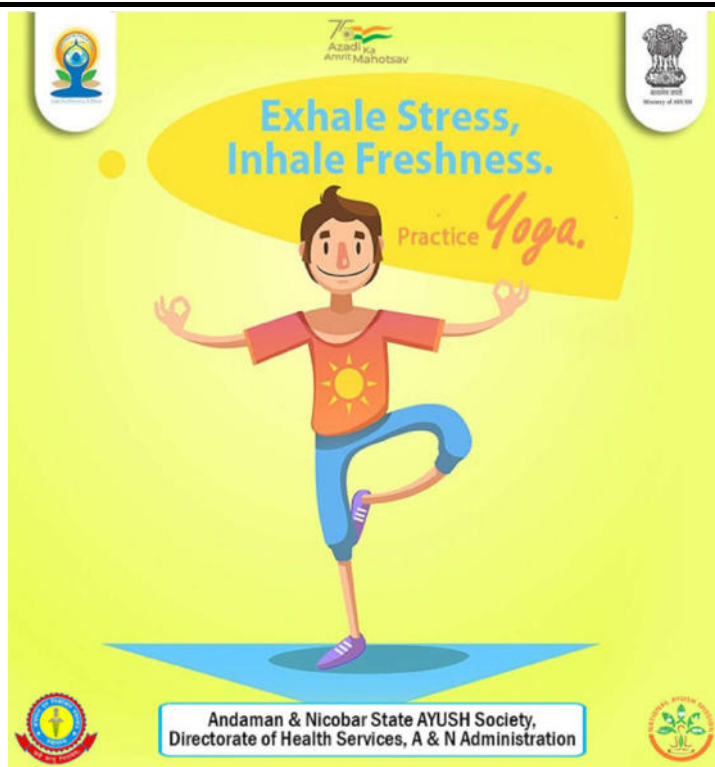

He said, the primary objective of the WTO is to serve as the mechanism through which international trade can become the means for supporting the economic development of Members, particularly the developing countries and the LDCs.

Shri Goyal said, in all such reforms, we must ensure that multilateral rule-making processes are neither bypassed nor diluted. Common Yoga Protocol of International Day of Yoga: Day 3

PĀDA-HASTĀSANA (The Hands to Feet Posture)

Pada means feet, *hasta* means hands. Therefore, *Pāda Hastāsana* means keeping the palms down towards the feet. This is also referred as *Uttānāsana*.

Technique

- Stand straight with feet 2 inches apart.
- Inhale slowly and raise the arms up.
- Stretch up the body from the waist.
- Exhale and bend forward until both palms rest on the ground.
- Stretch the back, to make it straight as much as possible.
- Maintain this final posture for 10-30 seconds with normal breathing.
- Those who are suffering with stiff back should bend according to their capacity.
- Now inhale, come up slowly to the upright position and stretch the arms straight above the head.
- Exhale, slowly return to the starting position in the reverse order.
- Relax in *Samasthiti*.

Benefits

- Makes the spine flexible, improves digestion, and helps in overcoming menstrual problems.

Caution

- Please avoid this practice in case of cardiac disorders, vertebral and disc disorders, abdominal inflammation, hernia and ulcers, glucoma, myopia, vertigo.
