## 5<sup>th</sup> Andaman & Nicobar State Conference of All India Kisan Sabha Held

Port Blair, Oct 11: The 5<sup>th</sup> Andaman & Nicobar State Conference of All India Kisan Sabha was held at Diglipur, North Andaman on 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2022. 71 Delegates and observers including 15 women from different parts of Andaman & Nicobar Islands attended the Conference.

Inaugurating the Conference, Mr. Vijoo Krishnan, All India Joint Secretary of All India Kisan Sabha said that thousands of farmers are committing suicide in the country every year due to anti-farmer policies of the Modi government. He said that none of the promises made by the BJP to the farmers before the Parliament election 2019 has been fulfilled so far. He said that the central government is not ready even to hear the problems of the farmers, but they are helping the corporate led by Adani and Ambani. Corona pandemic was an excuse for speeding up all the anti-farmer and anti-people policies. Referring to the three anti-farmer Laws passed by Parliament, Mr. Vijoo Krishnan, who was in the forefront of leading the one-year massive protest of farmers, said that the BJP



government had to surrender before the farmers and withdrew the legislations. He said that more than 750 farmers had died during the agitation. He said that the double-engine government of Narendra Modi derailed before the united agitation of the farmers. He called upon the farmers of Andaman & Nicobar Islands to strengthen the All India Kisan Sabha to solve their problems and issues.

Speaking on the occasion, D. Ayyappan, Secretary, CPI (M) Andaman & Nicobar State Organising Committee explained in brief the difficulties being faced by farmers in the islands and said that the A&N Administration failed to meet even the minimum requirements of farmers and referred to the non-availability of fertilizers, pesticides, seeds and agriculture implements for farmers from the Administration. Mr. B. Chandrachoodan, General Secretary, CITU A &

N State Committee addressed the Conference and extended CITU's greetings.

A Presidium comprising Mr. Ramjeevan Sarkar, Mr. D. Laxman Rao and Mr. Nikunjo Biswas conducted the Conference. The said training center is one of its kind opened first time in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands for skill development trainings of the rural youth of the Islands.

The said training center is equipped with IT lab facility, Domain & Non-Domain classrooms, Placement & Counseling Units, separate hostel facility for male and female candidates, in-door recreational activities, etc. The TOT certified trainers for Domain and Non-Domain trades are engaged to fulfill the training needs of candidates. The training center has the capacity to train 105 candidates at a time.

tional Society informed that they will commence training on Field Technician Computing and Peripherals for the first batch of 70 candidates from 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2022 against the total target of 488 candidates under DDU-GKY project sanctioned to them and subsequently come up with more training programmes.

## Covid scare in China ahead of Communist party's congress; 196.9mn affected by lockdowns

BEIJING: The Communist Party of China's (CPC) top mouthpiece, People's Daily, has come out in support of the country's "zero-Covid" policy even as large Chinese cities including Shanghai and Xian began new rounds of tests and restrictions after nearly 4,000 new cases were reported in the past two days across China.

The People's Daily opinion piece asking people to "boost their patience" with the policy indicates that there will be no change in it even after the end of the upcoming 20th CPC national congress.

President Xi Jinping set to secure a third term as China's leader at the congress- has himself endorsed the "zero-Covid" policy despite its negative economic impact and people's frustrations. Shanghai, Xian and Shenzhen, among the largest Chinese cities, introduced mass tests, targeted lockdowns and shut down

some schools and tourist places following small cluster outbreaks.

China's national health commission (NHC) reported 427 locally transmitted confirmed Covid-19 cases, including 145 in Inner Mongolia and 82 in Xinjiang for Monday; A total of 1,662 local asymptomatic carriers were also reported.

On Monday, the Chinese mainland reported 373 locally transmitted Covid cases besides 1,566 asymptomatic ones for the day before.

Millions continue to face restrictions across the country. "According to government statistics and our survey, as of 10 October, 36 cities are currently implementing various levels of lockdowns or some kind of district-based control measures," Nomura, investment bank and brokerage, said in a report on Monday. The report estimated that around

196.9mn people are currently affected by the lockdown measures, up from 179.7mn in the previous week.

Lockdown fears returned to Shanghai after three of the city's downtown districts on Monday ordered entertainment venues such as internet cafes to close temporarily.

"Xian, a historic city famous for terra-cotta warriors with the population of more than 13 million people in northwest China's Shaanxi province announced on Tuesday to suspend onsite (offline) classes for some students amid the Covid-19 flare-ups," the state-run tabloid, Global Times reported.

Compared internationally, the Covid numbers for the province and the city were low: Nine local confirmed Covid-19 cases in the province including four in Xian and 15 asymptomatic carriers including seven in Xian.
