

PM reviews COVID-19 situation

Corona challenge is not fully over & we have to implement the strategy of test, track and treat with efficacy: PM

"Our priority is to vaccinate all eligible children at the earliest; Special campaigns will also be needed in schools"

New Delhi, April 27 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, interacted with the Chief Ministers to review the COVID-19 situation here today. Union Home Minister spoke about the recent increase in COVID cases in some States, and about the need to follow test, track, treat, vaccination and ensure COVID appropriate behaviour. Union Health Secretary gave a presentation in which he discussed the rise of cases across several countries in the world, while also highlighting the rise of cases in some States in India. He spoke about the need for States to regularly monitor and report data, maintain effective surveillance, upgrade infrastructure and utilise funds given by the Centre.

The Chief Ministers thanked the Prime Minister for timely guidance and



support since the start of the pandemic. They said that this review meeting has been called by the Prime Minister at the right time. They gave an overview of the status of COVID cases and vaccination in their States.

The Prime Minister noted the collective efforts of Centre and State in the fight against Corona. He put on record his appreciation for the Chief Ministers, Officers and all Corona Warriors for their efforts. He said that it is clear that Corona challenge is not fully over. Omicron and its sub variants can create problem as evident by the case of many countries of Europe. The sub variants are causing many surges in many countries. He said, India has been able to deal with the situation better than many countries. Still, in last two weeks, increasing cases in some of the States show that we need to stay alert, he said.

The Prime Minister said that the Omicron wave was handled with determination and without panic and in the last two years, all aspects of Corona fight whether, health

infrastructure, oxygen supply or vaccination, have been strengthened. In the third wave, none of the State saw situation going out of control. This, the Prime Minister said, should be seen in the context of the massive vaccination drive. He said vaccine reached each and every person and it is a matter of pride that 96 per cent adult population is vaccinated with at least one dose and about 84 per cent people above 15 years of age have received both the doses. Vaccine, as per experts is the biggest safeguard against corona, he added.

The Prime Minister mentioned that schools have opened after long time and some parents are worried by the increased number of cases in some places. He expressed satisfaction that more and more children are getting the vaccine. He said that in March, campaign to vaccinate 12-14 years of age was started and only yesterday, permission has been granted for Covaxin vaccine for 6-12 years old

Fishing vessels plying bottom trawling gear & shark fishing in A & N Waters closed till May 31

Port Blair, April 27

In accordance with A&N Marine Fishing Rules 2004 (Amendment-2019) the period commencing from 15th day of April to 31st day of May - 2022 (inclusive of the day of commencement and day of expiry) shall be closed season for Fishing Vessels plying bottom trawling gear and for shark fishing in A & N Waters. Fishermen have been advised to strictly comply with the above closed season for bottom trawling gear and for shark fishing in A&N Waters, a press release from Fisheries Department said.

Govt. scraps MP quota for admissions in Kendriya Vidyalayas

New Delhi, April 27

The Union Government has scrapped the quota through which Members of Parliament could recommend names for admissions in Kendriya Vidyalayas (KV), according to the admission guidelines for 2022-23 and beyond. The move comes a week after the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) put admissions under special provisions, including the MP quota, on hold till further orders. Under the

KVS Special Dispensation Admission Scheme, a Member of Parliament had the power to recommend a maximum of 10 students from their respective constituencies in every academic year for admissions in classes 1 to 9.

There has been a long-pending demand from MPs to either do away with the quota, or increase the number of students who can be admitted on the basis of recommendations. According to the revised

guidelines issued by the KVS, several amendments have been made under the special provisions section of the admission policy.

Other than the MP quota, the KVS has also removed other reservations, including 100 children of Education Ministry employees, children and dependent grandchildren of MPs and retired KV employees, and discretionary quota of School Management Committee Chairman, among others. (Source: india.govin)

children. "Our priority is to vaccinate all eligible children at the earliest. For this, as before, special campaigns will also be needed in schools. Teachers and parents should be aware about this", said the Prime Minister. Precautionary dose is available for all adults in the country to strengthen the vaccine protective shield. Teachers, parents, and other eligible people can take precautionary dose, he added.

The Prime Minister said that during the third wave, India witnessed up to 3 lakh cases per day and all states handled the situation and also allowed social and economic activity to continue. This balance should form our strategy in future also, he said. The Prime Minister informed that the situation is being constantly monitored by the scientists and experts and we have to work pro-actively on their suggestions. "Preventing infections at the very beginning was our priority and should remain so even now. We have to implement our strategy of test, track and treat with same efficacy", he said.

The Prime Minister emphasized cent percent testing of serious influenza cases and genome sequencing of the positive cases. Covid appropriate behaviour in the public places and avoiding panic. He also emphasized continued upgradation of health infrastructure and medical manpower.

The Prime Minister said that India fought a long fight against Corona with the spirit of Cooperative Federalism enshrined in the Constitution. The Prime Minister emphasized that, in the current global scenario, for the strength of India's economy, coordination between the Central and State Governments in economic decisions is necessary. He said that in the conditions imposed by global events, this spirit of cooperative federalism becomes all the more important. He explained this in the context of petrol and diesel prices.

The Prime Minister said that in order to reduce the load of petrol and diesel prices Central Government has reduced the excise duty and had requested the States also to reduce taxes. Some States reduced taxes but some States did not pass on the benefits to the people, leading to higher cost of petrol and diesel in these States.

Standing Committee on Defence visits Defence Establishments under Andaman & Nicobar Command

During the second day of their two-day visit to the Andaman & Nicobar Command, the Standing Committee on Defence (SCOD) visited various defence facilities on 24th April. In the morning, the SCOD visited Birchgunj Military Station and witnessed a Jungle Survival Demonstration. The Hon'ble members were introduced to various survival and adaptability techniques important for Jungle warfare. Highlights of the demonstration included techniques of preparing traps and shelters, the art of



identification of edible plants and fruits, collection and storage of potable water, handling of poisonous snakes and other reptiles in the jungle and various improvised cooking techniques. The demonstration was greatly appreciated by the Committee. Later in the afternoon, the SCOD visited Floating Dock Navy-2 (FDN-2), which is a unique and strategic docking asset of Andaman and Nicobar

Command. The Committee was apprised about the capabilities of FDN-2, which has emerged as a work horse in the field of ship repairs. A lunch was also hosted by the Commander-in-Chief, Andaman and Nicobar Command in honour of the SCOD members.

A participatory Municipal Waste Management Appraisal meeting was held at Junglighat recently in which fisherman community participated. The Ward Councillor, Ward No-14, Shri Joga Rao was also present in the meeting. Door to door pre mobilization and Clean Up-Port Blair activities were also conducted by Swacchta Awareness Team (SAT) and GIZ supported staff at Mazar Pahad area. Similarly, door to door

commercial/shops awareness was also conducted by SAT and GIZ at Junglighat.

Cleanliness drive was conducted at Mazar Pahad drain by PBMC Sanitary Department in collaboration with GIZ on Earth Day during which approximately 9-11 tonnes of waste were excavated by the Municipal Staff. Beach clean-up drive at Mazar Pahad beach area was also conducted by PBMC & GIZ with the support of JNRM students and NCC Cadets and general public. The collected wastes were segregated, quantified and handed over to PBMC. After the clean-up, a rally was organised by the students, communities and trainees.

During the beach clean-up activities, the waste collection from different streams comprised of 44 bags weighing 1755.88 kg (biodegradable-172.88 kg, tin-30 kgs, plastic-144 kgs, clothes-106 kgs, glass-38 kgs, tetra-pack-5 kgs).

Apart from this, awareness programme was organised at community hall, Mazar Pahad, Ward No. 11 under the supervision of SE, PBMC. The Technical Expert briefed about GIZ's cities combatting plastic entering the marine body. Vaccination drive in A&N Islands

11,556 beneficiaries in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs vaccinated so far

Port Blair, April 27

The vaccination drive is continuing smoothly in A&N Islands. As per data available, a total of 6,74,301 doses of vaccine have been administered to beneficiaries in the age group of 18 and above so far. Similarly, 23,421 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 15 to 18 yrs. and 11,556 beneficiaries have been vaccinated in the age group of 12 to 14 yrs. The number

of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine so far stood at 18,902.

A total of 839 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in A&N Islands today. 579 eligible beneficiaries were vaccinated in South Andaman District, out of which, 88 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years, 12 beneficiaries were in the age group of 18-44 years and the number of

beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 186.

250 beneficiaries were vaccinated in North & Middle Andaman District, out of which, 6 beneficiaries were in the age group of 12-14 years and the number of beneficiaries administered precautionary dose of vaccine stood at 48.

10 beneficiaries were administered precautionary dose of vaccine in Nicobar District, a press release from DHS said.

COVID-19 status in A&N Islands

Port Blair, April, 27

During the RT-PCR test conducted on 124 passengers who arrived here yesterday, no positive case has been detected. Today, 9 flights with 1353 passengers arrived, out of which, 1187 passengers were vaccinated with both doses while RT-PCR test was conducted on 109 passengers and the reports are awaited.

During RAT conducted on 53 passengers bound for

North & Middle Andaman at Ferrargunj, no positive case has been detected. At Mohanpura Bus Terminus, test was conducted on 31 passengers, no positive case has been detected. At Phoenix Bay Jetty, 52 passengers were tested with RAT, no positive case has been detected. At Helipad, 3 passengers were tested with RAT and no positive case has been detected, a press release from IP&T said.

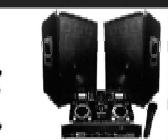
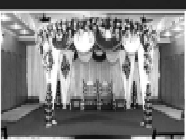
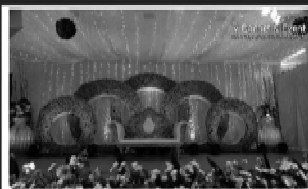
