

The Periodic Labour Force Survey (2019-20) points towards the steadybuild up of distress in the labour market in India. As the survey pertains to the July 2019 to June 2020 period, it captures both the economic slowdown prior to Covid, and the period after the national lockdown was imposed to restrict the spread of the pandemic. The survey data showsan increasein thelabourforceparticipation in agriculture during thisperiod. This, as some have argued, implies that during this period of stress, agriculture emerged as an "employer of last resort". Equally significant is that much of the increase in the women's labour force participation recorded by the surveyduring this period was in the category of unpaid family workers, and not in more productive forms of employment. These are worrying developments. The PLFS datashows that the share of the labourforce engaged in agriculture rose to 45.6 percent in 2019-20, up from 42.5 per cent in 2018-19 — an abrupt reversal of the decades-long decline in the labour force participation in agriculture. This suggests that the movement of labour out of a griculture, which had gathered pace post 2004-05, seems to have been stymied by the economicslowdown. The reverse migration of labour from cities to villages would have only increased the pressure on agriculture to absorb the workers. The rise in the female labourforceparticipation is also problematic. Under normal circumstances, considering the low rates offemale labour forceparticipation in India —for womenaged 15 and above itstood at 24.5 percent in 2018-19—a rise in participation would be a positive development. However, much of the increase observed in 2019-20 was in the form of unpaid family work in fact, according to the survey the employment rate for unpaid workers in household enterprises in rural and urban areas increased to 15.9 per centin 2019-20, from 13.3 per centin 2018-19. What these numbers also reflect is the failure of the economy in not being able to create enough non-agricultural jobs (even in pre-Covid times) to absorb both those shifting out of agriculture, and the millions entering the labourforce each year. Worryingly, even the jobsthat are being created tend to be largely informalin nature.

A total of 1,211 responses people in the country during the were recorded out of which 1,069 responses were included in the analysis, according to the study published in the International Journal of Mental Health Systems, they said.

The study stated that 44.6 per cent of them met the criteria formild anxiety, 30.1 per cent for moderate anxiety and 25.3 per cent forsevere anxiety.

Also, 26.1 per cent of them met the criteria for mid depression, 16.7 per cent for moderatedepression, and 3.8 per cent for severe depression, it said.

"Data was collected via a self-report questionnaire for a period of four weeks during the lockdown. nationwide Participants were residents of India, with minimum 10 years of education, with basic knowledge of English language and were ofthe age of 18 years and above," thestudy said.

Participants with any existing or previous history of any major psychiatric illnesswere excluded from the analysis, doctors said.

The study was conducted

using a web-based survey that was circulated to the general population. The survey was broadcaston theinternet through email and public platforms of social media and messaging applications such as WhatsApp, hospital authorities said.

"There's a definite risein the cases of anxiety and depression seen across the population in the COVID-19 pandemic, particularlyafter thesecond wave as compared to the first wave. I have seen many people coming to terms with grief, having lost their family members followed by depression and significant anxiety," said Dr Sameer Malhotra, director and head, department of mental health and behavioural sciences, at the hospital.

"As per a study, we conducted lastyear on a sample size of 1,069 individuals of the general population during the first wave of COVID, we found that 55 per cent of thosewho took part in it, had significant anxiety symptoms and more than onefourthof themwere experiencing depressive symptoms, "he added.

Heatwaves have emerged as a deadly



Northwestem, central and south-central India arenew hotspotsof intense heatwave over the past 50 years, a study has said.

The study also highlights the need for developing effectiveheat action plans in the three heatwave hotspotregions with a focus on different vulnerabilities among the inhabitants.

Heatwaves have emerged as a deadly health hazard, claiming thousands of lives across the globe in recent decades, with episodes strengthening in frequency, intensity and duration in the past half-century in India as

This has caused severe impact on health, agriculture, economy and infræstructure. In such a scenario, it is extremely important to identify the most heatwave vulnerable regions of the work culture calls for equitable heat resilient country to prioritise immediate policy intervention mitigation and adaptation strategies covering each and stringent mitigation and adaptation strategies, theDepartment ofScience andTechndogy said.

A team of researchers led by R K Mall, including Saumya Singh and Nidhi Singh from the Department of Science and Technology, Mahamana Centre of Excellence in Climate Change Research (MCECCR) at Banaras Hindu University, studied the change in spatial and temporal trends in Heatwaves (HW) and Severe heatwaves (SHW) over the past seven decades in differentmeteorological subdivisions

This work has been supported under the Climate Change Programme of the Department ofScience andTechnology. Thestudy published inthe journal International Journal of Climatology' links the association of HW and SHW with mortality over India.

'The study showed a shift in the spatiotemporal trend of HW events from the eastern region of Gangetic West Bengal and Bihar to by MRajeevan, formersecretary of Ministry of northwes tem, central and further to the southcentral region of India.

SHW events in the last few decades that may put a greater population at additional risk of heat stress in a region already characterised by low diurnal temperature range (DTR), or the difference between the maximum and minimum temperatures within oneday and high humidity,"

the statement added. Importantly, the HW and SHW events were found to be positively correlated with mortality in Odisha and Andhra Pradesh, highlighting that humanhealth is highly susceptible to severe heatwave disasters.

With an ever-increasing extremetemperature threshold, a heat resilient future is the need of the hour.

Dense population with anintensive outdoor section of the society depending on their vulnerability, it said. The study highlights the need for developing effective heat action plans in the three heatwavehots pot regions. To mitigate future disastrous implications of exacerbated heat ex tremes and frame adequate adaptation measures in the wake of possible emergence of new hots pots, reliable future projections are needed. This will help study the frequency, intensity, and spatial surge of heatwaves in the future. The study found models LMDZ4 and GFDL-ESM2M to be the best-performing ones in simulatingheatwaves over India in the present scenario, which can be reliably used for future projections as well. The two models have laid the grounds for preparation for a heatwave resilient future, it said. In a separate study by meteorologists published earlier this year, heatwaveshave daimedmore than 17,000 lives in 50 years from 1971-2019. The paper, authored Earth Science along with scientists Kamaliit Ray, S S Ray, R K Giri and A P Dimri, said there "The research also observed an alarming were 706 heatwave incidents from 1971-2019. southward expansion and a spatial surge in Kamaljit Ray is the lead author of the paper.

Amazon vs Future Group-Reliance: SC stays Delhi HC proceedings

In a major relief for Future Group, the assets to Reliance Retail. Supreme Court on Thursday stayed for four weeks all proceedings in the Delhi High Court that the emergency arbitrator's award was related to Amazon's dispute with the merger of enforceable in India. The bench comprising Chief Justice N.V. Ramana and Justices Surya Kant and A.S. Bopanna directed the NCLT, Competition Commission of India and SEBI not to pass a final orderon the dispute forfour weeks.

The bench considered the statements of senior advocates Harish Salve and Mukul Rohatgi, appearing for FRL and Future Coupons Private Ltd (FCPL), respectively, that the arbitrator has reserved the final verdict in the case after hearing both sides.


